PRICE CONTROL.

MAXIMUM PRICES OF SUGAR.

I, Heinrich Rudolph Philip August Kotzenberg, Price Controller, acting under the powers vested in me by section four of the Price Control Act, 1964 (Act No. 25 of 1964), do hereby prescribe as follows:

1. Subject to the provisions of the First Schedule hereto, the maximum prices at which the sugar specified in the Second Schedule hereto may be sold by any person, other than the manufacturer of such sugar, to a dealer, are the prices specified in, or determinable in accordance with relevant provisions of, the said Second Schedule.

2. Subject to the provisions of the First Schedule hereto, the maximum prices at which the sugar specified in the Third Schedule hereto may, except in the case of a sale to which the provisions of paragraph 1 hereof are applicable, be sold by any person to any other person, are the prices specified in, or determinable in accordance with the relevant provisions of the said Third Schedule.

3. Subject to the provisions of the First Schedule hereto, the maximum prices at which mill-packed sugar in containers of less than 25 lb., may be sold by any person to any other person, are the prices specified in, or determinable in accordance with the provisions of, the Third Schedule hereto, plus half a cent per lb., on condition that mill white, refined or golden brown sugar not thus packed shall be stocked and sold in terms of the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 to any person who wishes to purchase it.

4. These regulations apply in the Republic.

5. Government Notices Nos. R. 726 of 4 May, 1966 and R. 1342 of 1 September, 1966, are hereby withdrawn.

MAKSIMUM PRYSE VAN SUIKER.

Ek, Heinrich Rudolph Philip August Kotzenberg, Pryskontroleur, handelende kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel vier van die Wet op Prysbeheer, 1964 (Wet No. 25 van 1964), bepaal hierby soos volg:

1. Behoudens die bepalings van die Eerste Bylae hiervan, is die maksimum prys waarteen die suiker gespesifiseer in die Tweede Bylae hiervan deur enigeen, uitgesondert die fabrikant van sodanige suiker, aan 'n handelaar verkoop mag word, die prys wat gespesifiseer word in, of berekenbaar is ooreenkomsdig die betrokke bepalings van, genoemde Tweede Bylae.

2. Behoudens die bepalings van die Eerste Bylae hiervan, is die maksimum prys waarteen die suiker gespesifiseer in die Derde Bylae hiervan, uitgesondert in die geval van 'n verkoop waarop die bepalings van paragraaf 1 hiervan van toepassing is, deur enigeen aan enigiemand anders verkoop mag word, die prys wat gespesifiseer word in, of berekenbaar is ooreenkomsdig die betrokke bepalings van, genoemde Derde Bylae.

3. Behoudens die bepalings van die Eerste Bylae hiervan, is die maksimum prys waarteen meulverpakte suiker in houers van minder as 25 lb. deur enigeen aan iemand anders verkoop mag word, die prys wat gespesifiseer word in, of berekenbaar is ooreenkomsdig die bepalings van, die Derde Bylae hiervan, plus 'n halfsent per lb., op voorwaarde dat meulwit, geraffineerde of goudbruin suiker wat nie aldus verpak is nie, in voorraad gehou word en ingevolge die bepalings van paragrawe 1 en 2 aan enigiemand wat dit wil koop, verkoop word.

4. Hierdie regulasies is in die Republiek van toepassing.

5. Goewermentskennisgewings Nos. R. 726 van 4 Mei 1966 en R. 1342 van 1 September 1966 word hierby herroep.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

Definitions and Interpretations.

Unless otherwise stated, the following definitions and interpretations apply in the determination of maximum prices in accordance with the provisions of the Second and Third Schedules:—

1. A place specifically named means the area falling under the jurisdiction of the local authority at such place and includes all places within five miles of the boundary of such area.

2. "Witwatersrand" means the area falling under the jurisdiction of the local authorities of Alberton, Alexandra Township, Bank, Benoni, Boksburg, Brakpan, Carletonville, Edenvale, Germiston, Johannesburg, Kempton Park, Krugersdorp, Meyerton, Nigel, Randfontein, Roodepoort-Maraisburg, Springs and Vereeniging and includes all places within five miles of the boundary of the areas just mentioned.

"Pretoria" means the area falling under the jurisdiction of the local authorities of Pretoria and Lyttelton.

3. (a) Distances must be calculated by taking the mileage of the shortest railway route from the named railway station at the nearest port from which the sugar can be obtained to the railway station or siding to which it can be consigned, plus the mileage of the shortest distance by road from the last-mentioned railway station or siding to the place of sale; provided that, where sugar is transported by pont and/or subject to a charge for such service the road distance thus determinable may be increased by 50 miles.

(b) The mileage of the shortest railway route shall be determined in accordance with the supplement to the *Official Railway Tariff Book* (Fifth impression).

(c) Wherever in the Third Schedule hereto provision is made for allowances in respect of road transportation costs, the distances specified are determinable by reference to the nearest station or siding and shall in no case exceed the distance from such railway station or siding to the place of sale.

4. The expression "nearest railway station or siding" means the station or siding to which sugar can be consigned situated nearest to the place of sale irrespective of whether it has been consigned to such station or siding or not, but excludes Road motor Service stations or halts.

5. The expression "wholesale price" refers to a price determinable in accordance with the provisions of the second Schedule, and the expression "retail price" means a price determinable in accordance with the provisions of the Third Schedule.

6. Except where otherwise provided, any fraction of a cent in the maximum price for a sale, at any one time, of sugar to which this notice relates whether it be the price of a single unit in the case of a sale of such single unit or the total price resulting from the computation of the price applicable to any number of such units in the case of a sale of more than one unit, shall, if less than a half-cent be regarded as a half-cent, and if more than a half-cent be regarded as a cent.

7. The maximum wholesale prices specified in, or determinable in accordance with the provisions of, the Second Schedule relate to unbroken packages of 25, 50 and 100 lb. as supplied by the manufacturer.

8. The provisions in the Third Schedule relating to allowances for road transportation shall not apply in Zululand. The allowance for road transport that may be added to the maximum retail prices of sugar sold in Zululand at places that are more than five miles but not exceeding fifty miles from the nearest railway station or siding, shall be calculated at the rate of a half-cent per lb., and one cent per lb. in the case of places that are more than fifty miles from such railway station or siding.

EERSTE BYLAE.

Woordbepaling en vertolkings.

Tensy anders vermeld, is die volgende omskrywings en vertolkings van toepassing by die berekening van maksimum prys ooreenkomsdig die bepalings van die Tweede en Derde Bylaes:—

1. 'n Plek wat uitdruklik genoem word, beteken die gebied onder die regsvvoegheid van die plaaslike bestuur op dié plek en omvat alle plekke binne vyf myl van die grens van dié gebied.

2. „Witwatersrand" beteken die gebied onder die regsvvoegheid van die plaaslike besture van Alberton, Alexandradorp, Bank, Benoni, Boksburg, Brakpan, Carletonville, Edenvale, Germiston, Johannesburg, Kempton Park, Krugersdorp, Meyerton, Nigel, Randfontein, Roodepoort-Maraisburg, Springs en Vereeniging en omvat alle plekke binne vyf myl van die grens van die so pas genoemde gebiede.

„Pretoria" beteken die gebied onder die regsvvoegheid van die plaaslike besture van Pretoria en Lyttelton.

3. (a) Afstande moet bereken word deur die mylafstand te neem van die kortste spoorwegroete vanaf die aangegewe spoorwegstasie in die naaste hawestad vanwaar die suiker verkry kan word na die spoorwegstasie of -halte waarheen dit versend kan word, plus die kortste mylafstand per pad van laasgenoemde spoorwegstasie of -halte af na die plek van verkoop; met dien verstande dat, waar suiker per pont en/of onderworpe aan 'n vordering vir so 'n diens vervoer word, die afstand per pad aldus berekenbaar met 50 myl vermeerder kan word.

(b) Die mylafstand van die kortste spoorwegroete word bereken ooreenkomsdig die byvoegsel tot die *Offisiële Spoorwegtariefboek* (Vyfde druk).

(c) Waar in die Derde Bylae hiervan voorsiening gemaak word vir toelaes ten opsigte van padvervoerkoste, is die afstande wat gespesifieer word, berekenbaar met verwysing na die naaste spoorwegstasie of -halte en mag in geen geval die afstand van sodanige spoorwegstasie of -halte af na die plek van verkoop te bove gaan nie.

4. Die uitdrukking „naaste spoorwegstasie of -halte" beteken die spoorwegstasie of -halte naaste aan die plek van verkoop geleë, waarheen suiker versend kan word, ongeag of dit na sodanige spoorwegstasie of -halte versend is al dan nie, maar sluit padmotordiensstasies of -haltes uit.

5. Die uitdrukking „groothandelprys" het betrekking op 'n prys berekenbaar ooreenkomsdig die bepalings van die Tweede Bylae, en die uitdrukking „kleinhandelprys" beteken 'n prys berekenbaar ooreenkomsdig die bepalings van die Derde Bylae.

6. Behalwe waar anders bepaal, word 'n breuk van 'n sent in die maksimum prys by die verkoop op een en diezelfde tydstip van suiker waarop hierdie kennisgewing betrekking het, hetsy dit die prys van 'n enkele eenheid is in die geval van 'n verkoop van dié enkele eenheid, of die totale prys verkry by die berekening van die prys wat van toepassing is op enige getal van sulke eenhede in die geval van 'n verkoop van meer as een eenheid, as dit minder as 'n halfsent is, as 'n halfsent, en as dit meer as 'n halfsent is, as 'n sent beskou.

7. Die maksimum groothandelpryse gespesifieer in, of berekenbaar ooreenkomsdig die bepalings van, die Tweede Bylae het betrekking op onoogpamedaakte verpakings van 25 lb., 50 lb. en 100 lb. soos deur die fabrikant gelewer.

8. Die bepalings van die Derde Bylae met betrekking tot toelaes vir padvervoer, is nie in Zoeloeland van toepassing nie. Die toelaes vir padvervoer wat bygevoeg mag word by die maksimum kleinhandelpryse van suiker in Zoeloeland verkoop op plekke wat meer as vyf myl maar hoogstens vyftig myl vanaf die naaste spoorwegstasie of -halte geleë is, moet bereken word teen 'n halfsent per lb., en teen een sent per lb. in die geval van plekke wat meer as vyftig myl vanaf sodanige stasie of -halte geleë is.

Column A applies when the quantity sold is less than 500 lb.; column B when it is 500 lb. or more but less than 1,000 lb.; column C when it is 1,000 lb. or more but less than 5,000 lb.; column D when it is 5,000 lb. or more but less than 15,000 lb.; and column E when it is 15,000 lb. or more.

When the sale is against a fifty-day draft, the foregoing cash prices may be increased by 7·5 cents per 100 lb. When the sale is on open account, the foregoing cash prices may be increased by 10 cents per 100 lb.

In addition, when 25 lb. unbroken mill-packed pockets as supplied by the manufacturers are sold, the foregoing prices may be increased by 4 cents per 100 lb.

Delivery Charges.

(i) Durban.—2·5 cents per 100 lb. may be added for deliveries in the following areas:—

Main North Coast Road—up to and including Avoca.

North Coast (Coastal) Road—up to and including Umhlanga Rocks.

South Coast—up to the Durban bank of the Umhlanga River.

Main Road—up to the old Westville Town Office at the junction of the Main Road, Westville and New Germany.

Main Road through Rossburgh—up to and including Hillary.

(ii) Cape Town.—2·5 cents per 100 lb. may be added for deliveries within zone 1, 5 cents within zone 2 and 7·5 cents within zone 3, the zones referred to being those described in a circular, dated 13th June, 1960, issued by the Cape Town Sugar Exchange, Ltd. When the sale is on the basis of delivery ex seller's store, a further 3·9 cents per 100 lb. may be added.

Wanneer die verkoop op ope rekening is, mag die voorafgaande prys t.o.v. kontantverkope met 10 sent per 100 lb. verhoog word.

Hierbenewens mag, wanneer onooggemakte meulverpakte sakkies van 25 lb., soos deur die vervaardigers voorseen, verkoop word, die voorafgaande prys met 4 sent per 100 lb. verhoog word.

Afleweringskoste.

(i) Durban.—2·5 sent per 100 lb. mag vir aflewing in die volgende gebiede bygevoeg word:—

Hoof-noordkusroete—tot en met inbegrip van Avoca.

Noordkus(kus)-roete—tot en met inbegrip van Umhlanga Rocks.

Suidkus—tot by die Durbanoewer van die Umiasrivier.

Hoofweg—tot by die ou Westville-dorpskantoor by die aansluiting van die Hoofweg, Westville en New Germany.

Hoofroete deur Rossburgh—tot en met inbegrip van Hillary.

(ii) Kaapstad.—2·5 sent per 100 lb. mag bygevoeg word vir aflewing binne sone 1, 5 sent binne sone 2 en 7·5 sent binne sone 3. Die sones waarna verwys word, is dié omskryf in 'n omsendbrief gedateer 13 Junie 1960 uitgereik deur die Kaapstadse Suikerbeurs, Bpk. Wanneer die verkoop op die basis van aflewing ex verkoper se magasyn geskied, mag 'n verdere 3·9 sent per 100 lb. bygevoeg word.

(iii) *East London*.—2·5 cents per 100 lb. may be added for deliveries within a six-mile radius of the East London Railway Station.

When the sale is on the basis of delivery *ex* seller's store a further 3·9 cents per 100 lb. may be added.

(iv) *Port Elizabeth*.—2·5 cents per 100 lb. may be added for deliveries within zone 1 covering all points within a six-mile radius of the port and 5 cents per 100 lb. for deliveries within zone 2 covering all points more than 6 miles from the port.

When the sale is on the basis of delivery *ex* seller's store a further 3·9 cents per 100 lb. may be added.

(v) *Mossel Bay*.—2·5 cents per 100 lb. may be added for deliveries within a six-mile radius of the Mossel Bay Railway Station.

When the sale is on the basis of delivery *ex* seller's store a further 3·9 cents per 100 lb. may be added.

(b) Elsewhere in the Republic, excluding Pretoria and the Witwatersrand, the maximum prices applicable, when the sale is on the basis of *ex* seller's store, are those specified in paragraph 1 (a) (except that the 50-day draft price may be charged in respect of a sale against a 40-day draft), plus railage and cartage from the nearest port where sugar is obtainable. When the S.A.R. & H. Administration does not provide a cartage service between the station and the seller's store a cartage charge of 3 cents per 100 lb. may be added. When the sale is *ex* the seller's store and the sugar is railed on to the purchaser, the prices determinable in accordance herewith are f.o.r. seller's station. For example, a dealer in Pietersburg sells *ex* his store for cash 25 pockets of Gledhow Protea refined white sugar to a dealer in Louis Trichardt, the said sugar having originally been railed from Stanger to the dealer at Pietersburg. The dealer's maximum price per pocket, free-on-rail Pietersburg, is R5.293, plus railage and cartage from Durban and not from Stanger.

Delivery Charges.

A seller, who makes a delivery from a place where the railage and cartage charges from the nearest port from which sugar is obtained, are less than the railage and cartage charges from the same port to the place of delivery, may make a delivery charge equivalent to the difference between the railage and cartage charges from the port to the two places concerned.

2. At Pretoria and on the Witwatersrand the maximum prices for cash sales in pockets of 50 lb. or more *ex* seller's store are as follows:—

When the sale is against a forty-day draft the foregoing cash prices may be increased by 7·5 cents per 100 lb.

When the sale is on open account, the foregoing cash prices may be increased by 10 cents per 100 lb.

(iii) *Oos-Londen*.—2·5 sent per 100 lb. mag vir aflewering binne 'n ses-mylnstraal vanaf die Oos-Londense spoorwegstasie bygevoeg word.

Wanneer die verkoop op die basis van aflewering *ex* verkoper se magasyn geskied, mag 'n verdere 3·9 sent per 100 lb. bygevoeg word.

(iv) *Port Elizabeth*.—2·5 sent per 100 lb. mag bygevoeg word vir aflewering binne sone 1 wat alle plekke binne 'n ses-mylnstraal vanaf die hawe insluit en 5 sent per 100 lb. vir aflewering binne sone 2 wat alle plekke verder as 6 myl van die hawe insluit.

Wanneer die verkoop op die basis van aflewering *ex* verkoper se magasyn geskied, mag 'n verdere 3·9 sent per 100 lb. bygevoeg word.

(v) *Mosselbaai*.—2·5 sent per 100 lb. mag vir aflewering binne 'n ses-mylnstraal vanaf die Mosselbaaise spoorwegstasie bygevoeg word.

Wanneer die verkoop op die basis van aflewering *ex* verkoper se magasyn geskied, mag 'n verdere 3·9 sent per 100 lb. bygevoeg word.

(b) Elders in die Republiek, met uitsondering van Pretoria en die Witwatersrand, is die maksimum prys wat van toepassing is wanneer die verkoop op die basis van *ex* verkoper se magasyn geskied, dié wat in paragraaf 1 (a) gespesifieer is (behalwe dat vir 'n verkoop teen 'n veertig-daewissel, die prys soos teen 'n vyftig-daewissel gevra mag word), plus spoorvrag en vervoerkoste vanaf die naaste hawestad vanwaar suiker verkry kan word. Wanneer die Administrasie van die S.A.S. en H. nie 'n aflewingsdiens tussen die stasie en die verkoper se magasyn verskaf nie, mag vervoerkoste teen 3 sent per 100 lb. bygevoeg word. Wanneer die verkoop *ex* verkoper se magasyn geskied en die suiker per spoor aan die koper gestuur word, is die prys wat ooreenkomsdig hiermee berekenbaar is, v.o.s. verkoper se stasie. 'n Handelaar te Pietersburg, byvoorbeeld, verkoop teen kontant *ex* sy magasyn 25 sakkies geraffineerde wit Gledhow Proteasuiker wat oorspronklik per spoor vanaf Stanger na die handelaar in Pietersburg gestuur is, aan 'n handelaar te Louis Trichardt. Die handelaar se maksimum prys per sakkie v.o.s. Pietersburg is R5.293, plus spoorvrag en vervoerkoste vanaf Durban en nie vanaf Stanger nie.

Aflewingskoste.
