AMENDMENT OF MAIN AGREEMENT.

I, MARAIS VILJOEN, Minister of Labour, hereby—

- (a) in terms of section 48 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation Act, 1956, declare that all the provisions of the Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the Amending Agreement) which appears in the Schedule hereto and which relates to the Iron, Steel, Engineering and Metallurgical Industry, shall be binding from the second Monday after the date of publication of this notice and for the period ending the 29th August, 1967, upon the employers' organisations and the trade unions which entered into the Amending Agreement and upon the employers and employees who are members of the said organisations or unions;
- (b) in terms of section 48 (1) (b) of the said Act, declare that the provisions of the Amending Agreement shall be binding from the second Monday after the date of publication of this notice and for the period ending the 29th August, 1967, upon all employers and employees other than those referred to in paragraph (a) of this notice who are engaged or employed in the said Industry in the Republic of South Africa; and
- (c) in terms of section 48 (3) (a) of the said Act, declare that in the Republic of South Africa and from the second Monday after the date of publication of this notice and for the period ending the 29th August, 1967, the provisions of the Amending Agreement shall *mutatis mutandis* be binding upon all Bantu employed in the said Industry by the employers upon whom any of the said provisions are binding in respect of employees and upon those employers in respect of Bantu in their employ.

“Region E” means the Province of the Transvaal excluding the Magisterial Districts of Bloemhof, Christiana, Delareyville, Klerksdorp, Lichtenburg, Potchefstroom, Schweizer-Reneke, Ventersdorp and Wolmaransstad and includes the Magisterial Districts of Parys and Sasolburg, and for the purposes of these particular areas the address of the Council shall be the National Industrial Council for the Iron, Steel, Engineering and Metallurgical Industries (Transvaal Regional Council), P.O. Box 3998, Johannesburg;

“Region F” means the Province of the Orange Free State excluding the Magisterial Districts of Parys and Sasolburg and includes the Magisterial Districts of Bloemhof, Christiana, Delareyville, Klerksdorp, Lichtenburg, Potchefstroom, Schweizer-Reneke, Ventersdorp and Wolmaransstad, in the Province of the Transvaal, and the Magisterial Districts of Barkly West, Britstown, De Aar, Gordonia, Hartswater, Herbert, Hay, Hopetown, Kenhardt, Kimberley, Kuruman, Mafeking, Postmasburg, Philipstown, Prieska, Taung, Vryburg and Warrenton, and for the purposes of these particular areas the address of the Council shall be the National Industrial Council for the Iron, Steel, Engineering and Metallurgical Industries (Orange Free State and Northern Cape Regional Council), P.O. Box 95, Welkom;”.

“Unforeseen contingencies and/or circumstances beyond the control of the employer referred to in this paragraph shall not include inclement weather.”

3. Section 12 of Part I of the Main Agreement is hereby amended by the deletion of provisos (i) and (ii) to sub-paragraph (bb) of subsection (7) (b) and the substitution of the following provisos after “provided” in sub-paragraph (bb):—

“(i) that any amounts accruing to the Council in terms of paragraph (b) of this sub-section as the Council may regard as being in excess of a sufficient reserve in the Trust Fund Advances Fund may be accrued to the Council funds, but shall not be accrued to the Trust Fund Advances Fund or to Council funds until a further period of six months has elapsed after the expiration of the two-year period and any claims presented during such six-month period shall be paid by the Council; and

(ii) the Council shall consider any claim that may be made by any employee after the expiration of such six-month period, and may in its discretion make *ex-gratia* payment from the Trust Fund Advances Fund (or from such amounts accrued to Council funds in the event of the depletion of the Trust Fund Advances Fund) to such employees as are referred to herein.”

4. Division D/15 (Plastics Manufacturing Division) in Schedule D of Part III of the Main Agreement is hereby amended by the substitution for the operation under Rate 3 reading:—

“Attaching and/or removing preset plastic moulds in moulding machine”

of the following operation:—

“Attaching and/or removing of dies and/or bolsters and/or moulds and/or forming inserts on plastic moulding machine”

5. Division E/2, applicable to the “Electrical Engineering Industry in Schedule E of Part III of the Main Agreement is hereby amended—

(a) by the deletion of the following operations at Rate 9, viz.—

“Cutting and/or cropping and/or shearing to templets and/or stops and/or length gauges (8 gauge and thinner) excluding oxy-acetylene cutting”; and “Operating nibbling machine to jigs and/or stops not exceeding 10 gauge”;

(b) by the insertion of the following operations at the rates specified, viz.—

Rate 1A.—“High potential testing when performed by persons normally engaged in operative processes.”

Rate 5.—“Changing of self-located mandrels on coil winding machine.”

Rate 8.—“Taping by hand of current transformer cores (excluding repair work).”

“Winding by hand of secondary coils for current transformers (excluding repair work).”

Rate 9.—“Cutting and/or cropping and/or shearing to templets and/or stops and/or length gauges ( $\frac{3}{8}$  inch plate or thinner) excluding oxy-acetylene cutting.”

“Filing of laminations using fixed go and/or no-go gauges (excluding traction motors).”

Box 3998, Johannesburg;

'Region F' means the Province of the Orange Free State excluding the Magisterial Districts of Parys and Sasolburg and includes the Magisterial Districts of Bloemhof, Christiana, Delareyville, Klerksdorp, Lichtenburg, Potchefstroom, Schweizer-Reneke, Ventersdorp and Wolmaransstad, in the Province of the Transvaal and the Magisterial Districts of Barkly West, Britstown, De Aar, Gordonia, Hartswater, Herbert, Hay, Hopetown, Kenhardt, Kimberley, Kuruman, Mafeking, Postmasburg, Philipstown, Prieska, Taung, Vryburg and Warrenton and for the purposes of these particular areas the address of the Council shall be the National Industrial Council for the Iron, Steel, Engineering and Metallurgical Industries (Orange Free State and Northern Cape Regional Council), P.O. Box 95, Welkom;".
