BYLAE

1. Die Regulasies afgekondig by Proklamasie R. 109 van 12 Junie 1986, word hierby gewysig—

(a) deur in regulasie 1—

(i) die omskrywing van "Mag" deur die volgende omskrywing te vervang:

" 'Mag' die Suid-Afrikaanse Polisie bedoel in die omskrywing van 'die Mag' in artikel 1 van die Polisiewet, 1958 (Wet 7 van 1958), en ook enige deel van genoemde Polisie waarvan die beheer, organisasie en administrasie deur die Minister aan die Regering van 'n selfregerende gebied oorgedra is; 'n polisiemag ingestel kragtens 'n wet van die wetgewende vergadering van 'n selfregerende gebied; die Suid-Afrikaanse Spoorwegpolisiemag ingestel kragtens artikel 43 van die Suid-Afrikaanse Vervoerdienstewet, 1981 (Wet 65 van 1981); die Suid-Afrikaanse Weermag bedoel in artikel 5 van die Verdedigingswet, 1957 (Wet 44 van 1957), of

REGULATIONS IN TERMS OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY
ACT, 1953

Under the powers vested in me by section 3 (1) (a) of the Public Safety Act, 1953 (Act 3 of 1953), I hereby make the regulations contained in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

1. The Regulations promulgated by Proclamation R. 109 of 12 June 1986, are hereby amended—

(a) in regulation 1—

(i) by the substitution for the definition of "Force" of the following definition:

" 'Force' means the South African Police referred to in the definition of 'the Force' in section 1 of the Police Act, 1958 (Act 7 of 1958), and includes any part of the said Police of which the control, organisation and administration have been transferred by the Minister to the Government of a self-governing territory; a police force established under any law of the legislative assembly of a self-governing territory; the South African Railways Police Force established under section 43 of the South African Transport Services Act, 1981 (Act 65 of 1981); the South African Defence Force referred to in section 5 of the Defence Act, 1957

- die Gevangenisdiens ingestel by artikel 2 (1) van die Wet op Gevangenis, 1959 (Wet 8 van 1959);";
- (ii) in paragraaf (c) van die omskrywing van "ondermynende verklaring", na die woord "Republiek" die woorde "of van 'n selfregerende gebied" in te voeg;
- (iii) na die omskrywing van "publikasie" die volgende omskrywing in te voeg:
- "'selfregerende gebied' 'n gebied wat kragtens artikel 26 van die Grondwet van die Nasionale State, 1971 (Wet 21 van 1971), tot 'n selfregerende gebied binne die Republiek verklaar is;";
- (b) deur in subregulasie (10) van regulasie 3 na die woord "Staat" die woorde "of van die Regering van 'n selfregerende gebied" in te voeg;
- (c) deur paragraaf (a) van regulasie 8 deur die volgende paragraaf te vervang:
- "(a) by kennisgewing in die *Staatskoerant* of, waar van toepassing, die *Amptelike Koerant* van 'n selfregerende gebied te publiseer;";
- (d) deur aan die einde van regulasie 11 die volgende woorde by te voeg:
- "en met enige eksemplare waarop kragtens hierdie regulasie beslag gelê is, word gehandel ooreenkomstig opdragte wat van tyd tot tyd, in die algemeen of met verwysing na 'n bepaalde geval, deur die Minister of iemand deur hom daartoe gemagtig, uitgereik word.";
- (e) deur in subregulasie (1) van regulasie 16—
- (i) paragraaf (a) deur die volgende paragraaf te vervang:
- "(a) die Staat of die Regering van 'n selfregerende gebied;";
- (ii) paragraaf (c) deur die volgende paragraaf te vervang:
- "(c) 'n lid van die Kabinet van die Republiek of die Kabinet van 'n selfregerende gebied;"; en
- (iii) paragraaf (e) deur die volgende paragraaf te vervang:
- "(e) iemand wat in diens van die Staat of van die Regering van 'n selfregerende gebied is; of"; en
- (f) deur in subregulasie (4) van regulasie 16 na die woord "Staat" die volgende woorde in te voeg:
- "of die Regering van 'n selfregerende gebied".
2. Regulasie 1 word geag op 12 Junie 1986 in werking te getree het.

- (Act 44 of 1957), or the Prisons Service established by section 2 (1) of the Prisons Act, 1959 (Act 8 of 1959);";
- (ii) by the insertion after the definition of "publication" of the following definition:
- "'self-governing territory' means a territory which has, under section 26 of the National States Constitution Act, 1971 (Act 21 of 1971), been declared to be a self-governing territory within the Republic;";
- (iii) by the insertion, in paragraph (c) of the definition of "subversive statement", after the word "Republic" of the words "or of a self-governing territory";
- (b) by the insertion in subregulation (10) of regulation 3, after the word "State", of the words "or of the Government of a self-governing territory";
- (c) by the substitution for paragraph (a) of regulation 8 of the following paragraph:
- "(a) publication of the order by notice in the *Government Gazette* or, where applicable, the *Official Gazette* of a self-governing territory;";
- (d) by the addition at the end of regulation 11 of the following words:
- "and any copies which have been seized under this regulation shall be dealt with in accordance with directions issued from time to time, either generally or with reference to any particular case, by the Minister or a person authorized thereto by him.";
- (e) by the substitution in subregulation (1) of regulation 16—
- (i) for paragraph (a) of the following paragraph:
- "(a) the State or the Government of a self-governing territory;";
- (ii) for paragraph (c) of the following paragraph:
- "(c) any member of the Cabinet of the Republic or the Cabinet of a self-governing territory;"; and
- (iii) for paragraph (e) of the following paragraph:
- "(e) any person in the service of the State or of the Government of a self-governing territory; or"; and
- (f) by the insertion after the word "State" in subregulation (4) of regulation 16, of the words:
- "or the Government of a self-governing territory".
2. Regulation 1 shall be deemed to have come into operation on 12 June 1986.
