

INFORMATION NOTE: IMPLEMENTATION OF NATIONAL ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1996, AND EXTENT TO WHICH ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1989, REMAINS IN FORCE

## **BACKGROUND**

National Road Traffic Act, 1996 (Act No. 93 of 1996)

The National Road Traffic Act, 1996, was drafted and adopted by Parliament as a result of the findings of the Department of Transport's Constitutional Transformation Project ("the Project") initiated in response to the entry into force of the interim Constitution on 27 April 1994. The main aim of the Project was to identify how the Constitution would affect the future administration of transport functions.

The findings of the Project concerning road traffic legislation were that new national legislation should be adopted to give effect to the consultative process and the national government's residual powers on the basis of section 126(3) of the interim Constitution. This implied that the former Road Traffic Act, 1989 (Act No. 29 of 1989), would become provincial law capable of amendment by provincial legislatures, and that national legislation would have to be adopted to provide the required degree of uniformity.

## Road Traffic Management Corporation Act, 1999 (Act No. 20 of 1999)

The Ministerial Committee, consisting of the 9 Members of the Executive Council (MECs) responsible for traffic and transport matters in the provinces and the Minister of Transport, commissioned a study into the current service standards, efficiency and effectiveness of the functions pertaining to road traffic management.

The findings of the study culminated in the adoption by Parliament of the Road Traffic Management Corporation Act, 1999 (Act No. 20 of 1999). The aim of the Act is to establish the Road Traffic Management Corporation to effect co-operative and co-ordinated strategic planning, regulation, facilitation and law enforcement in respect of road traffic matters within the national, provincial and local spheres of government, the regulation of the contracting out of road traffic services and the provision of the phasing in of private investment in road traffic.

Once established, the Road Traffic Management Corporation ("the Corporation") will be directed by a Shareholders Committee consisting of the MECs, the Minister of Transport and two members of the South African Local Government Association, and will be managed and controlled by a chief executive officer. In the light of these fundamental changes in road traffic management, several related amendments to the National Road Traffic Act, 1996, became necessary. These amendments, which were effected by the National Road Traffic Amendment Act, 1999 (Act No. 21 of 1999), replaced certain references to the Minister and MEC with references to the Shareholders Committee and

Chief Executive Officer, and inserted in the principal Act provisions that were previously envisaged to become part of provincial road traffic laws.

## **IMPLEMENTATION**

- The National Road Traffic, 1996, will be implemented on 1 June 2000. The Road Traffic Management Corporation Act, 1999, will not be implemented on the same date, resulting in certain parts of the Road Traffic Act, 1989, remaining in force along with the National Road Traffic Act, 1996, in accordance with section 93(3) of the latter Act.
- The sections in the National Road Traffic Act, 1996, that make provision for the regulation of the transportation of dangerous goods by road will not be put into operation for a period of 12 months from 1 June 2000.
- Tables A to E below describe the status of those provisions of the road traffic legislation mentioned above that are affected by this phase of the implementation of the National Road Traffic Act, 1996.
