

NATIONAL HERITAGE COUNCIL ACT, 1999 (ACT No. 11 OF 1999)

REGULATIONS RELATING TO APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF COUNCIL

The Minister of Arts, Culture, Science and Technology has, in terms of section 15 of the National Heritage Council Act, 1999 (Act No. 11 of 1999), made the regulations in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In these regulations any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the National Heritage Council Act, 1999, has the meaning so assigned and—

"the Act" means the National Heritage Council Act, 1999 (Act No. 11 of 1999).

Appointment of members of Council

- 2. (1) For a person to be appointed a member of the Council in terms of section 5 (2) and (3) of the Act he or she must have special competence, experience or interest in the field of heritage.
- (2) For the purpose of appointing members to the Council in terms of section 5 (1) (c) of the Act the chairpersons of all the other cultural institutions declared under the Cultural Institutions Act, 1998 (Act No. 119 of 1998), will also be included in the Council of the National Heritage Council.
 - (3) Members of the Council contemplated in section 5 (1) (a) of the Act must be appointed in the following manner:
 - (a) The Minister must, by means of advertisements in nationally circulated media, invite bodies or persons to nominate individuals who comply with the requirements of regulation 2 (1), for appointment as members of the Council within 30 days from the date of the advertisement;
 - (b) the advertisements must stipulate the requirements for membership of the Council laid down in regulation 2 (1);
 - (c) the Minister must establish a selection panel consisting of not fewer than six and not more than 10 experts in the field of heritage;
 - (d) the selection panel must reflect broadly the race and gender composition of the Republic;
 - the selection panel must in a transparent manner consider all nominations and from among the nominees compile a list of 15 candidates, having due regard to regulation 2 (1); and
 - (f) the Minister must appoint at least five persons from the list.
 - (4) Members of the Council contemplated in section 5 (1) (b) of the Act must be appointed in the following manner:
 - (a) The Minister will inform the members of the executive council responsible for cultural matters of the various provinces of the envisaged process and prescriptions in the Act;
 - (b) the members of the executive council must, by means of advertisements in provincially circulating media, invite bodies or persons to nominate individuals who comply with the requirements of regulation 2 (1), for nomination as members of the Council within 30 days from the date of the advertisement;
 - (c) the advertisements must stipulate the requirements for membership of the Council laid down in regulation 2 (1);
 - the members of the executive council must establish a selection panel consisting of not fewer than three and not more than six experts in the field of heritage;
 - (e) the selection panel must reflect broadly the race and gender composition of the province concerned;
 - (g) the selection panel must in a transparent manner consider all nominations and from among the nominees compile a list of six candidates, having due regard to regulation 2 (1); and
 - (h) the members of the executive council must nominate one person from the list to the Minister for inclusion in the Council.

Procedures to fill vacancies on the Council

- 3. (1) In cases where a member dies, or otherwise vacates his or her office, the Minister will fill the vacancy by choosing a person on the relevant list compiled by the panel for the remaining part of the term of the member vacating the office.
- (2) In cases where a member representing a province dies, or otherwise vacates his or her office, the Member of the Executive Council will nominate another person from the original list compiled by the panel to serve on the Council for the remaining part of the term of the member vacating the office.
