Under section 107(1) of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (Act No. 28 of 2002), the Minister of Mineral Resources hereby make the regulations in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

DEFINITIONS

1. In these regulations "the Regulations " means the regulations published under Government Notice No. R.527 of 23 April 2004, as amended by Government Notice No. R1288 of 29 October 2004.

Amendment of regulation 2 of the Regulations

- 2. Regulation 2 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for regulation 2(1) of the following regulation:
 - "(1) An application for any permission, right or permit made in terms of the Act must be lodged by submitting an appropriate compatible electronic completed form contained in Annexure I, together with the prescribed Annexures in compatible electronic format with the Regional Manager in whose region the land Is situated or to the designated agency, as the case may be --
 - (a) by hand;
 - (b) registered post; or
 - (c) <u>electronically on the Department's official website</u> address or the relevant address specified in the appropriate form."

Commencement

These regulations shall come into operation on the date of publication thereof.
