The Director of Civil Aviation intends, in terms of section 163 of the Civil Aviation Act and on the recommendation of CARCom, to amend the Technical Standards by the amendment of the following parts set out in the Schedules below:

Schedule 5:	SA CATS 93	(Corporate Operations)
Schedule 6:	SA CATS 121	(Air Transport Operations: Carriage on Aeroplanes of More than 19 Passengers or Cargo)
Schedule 7:	SA CATS 127	(Commercial Helicopter Operations: Passengers, Cargo and Mail)
Schedule 8:	SA CATS 135	(Air Transport Operations: Carriage on Aeroplanes of More than 19 Passengers or Cargo)
