### **PROCLAMATION**

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Whereas it is desirable to amend Proclamation No. 8 of 1920 by enabling the Administrator to make regulations providing for the confiscation of any gold or silver which any person may attempt to export in contravention of regulations made under the said Proclamation;

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section two of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the addition of the following words at the end

"Such regulations may further provide for the confiscation of any gold or silver which any person may attempt to export in contravention thereof."

2. This Proclamation shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the Gazette.
