PROCLAMATION

BY HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Whereas it is desirable to make further provision out of the public revenue and other funds of Basutoland to meet certain additional expenditure incurred during the year which ended the 31st day of March, 1922;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows.:—

1. The public revenue or other funds of Basutoland are hereby charged with a further sum of £7,310. 4s. 3d. (seven thousand three hundred and ten pounds four shillings and threepence) to meet expenditure incurred during the year which ended the 31st day of March, 1922, in excess of the amounts appropriated for that purpose according to the particulars set forth in the schedule to this Proclamation.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Basutoland Further Appropriation (1921-1922) Proclamation, 1923, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the Gazette.

Whereas it is desirable to make further provision out of the public revenue or other funds of the Bechuanaland Protectorate to meet certain additional expenditure incurred during the year which ended the 31st day of March, 1922;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The public revenue or other funds of the Bechuanaland Protectorate are hereby charged with a further sum of £3,141. 11s. (three thousand one hundred and forty-one pounds eleven shillings) to meet expenditure incurred during the year which ended the 31st day of March, 1922, in excess of the amounts appropriated for that purpose according to the particulars set forth in the schedule to this Proclamation.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Additional Appropriation (1921-22) Proclamation, 1923, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the Gazette.
