PROCLAMATION

BY LIEUTENANT-COLONEL HIS EXCELLENCY THE RIGHT HONOURABLE THE EARL OF CLARENDON, A MEMBER OF HIS MAJESTY'S MOST HONOURABLE PRIVY COUNCIL, KNIGHT GRAND CROSS OF THE MOST DISTINGUISHED ORDER OF SAINT MICHAEL AND SAINT GEORGE, GOVERNOR-GENERAL AND COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF IN AND OVER THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA.

Under and by virtue of the powers vested in me by section four of the Diseases of Stock Act, 1911 (Act No. 14 of 1911), I do hereby proclaim, declare and make known that from and after the date of this Proclamation it shall not be lawful to introduce any species of live stock defined in section two of the said Act and Proclamation No. 260 of 1927, into the Union from the territories mentioned in the Schedule to this Proclamation.

Proclamations Nos. 290 of the 10th August, 1931, and 116 of the 21st July, 1932, are hereby repealed.
