ADHESIVE REVENUE STAMPS OF SWAZILAND.— ISSUE OF NEW SERIES AND DEMONETISATION OF OLD SERIES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in view of the issue of a new series of combined postage and revenue stamps of the following denominations, viz.: ½d., 1d., 2d., 3d., 4d., 6d., 1s., 2s. 6d., 5s. and 10s., as specified in the Notice dated the 20th December, 1932, which was published in the High Commissioner's Gazette, dated the 30th December, 1932, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased, in terms of section thirty-one (1) (e) of the Stamp Duties and Fees (Swaziland) Proclamation No. 38 of 1931, to make the subjoined regulations for the demonetisation of the series of revenue stamps the use of which was authorized by Government Notice No. 9 (Swaziland), 1904, as amended Commissioner's Notice No. 87 of 1917.

Government Notice No. 9 (Swaziland), 1904, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 87 of 1917, shall be repealed with effect from the 1st January, 1934.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. In these Regulations the series of Union of South Africa 1. In these Regulations the series of Union of South Africa revenue stamps specially appropriated for Swaziland revenue purposes [see Government Notice No. 9 (Swaziland) 1904, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 87 of 1917], is referred to as the "old series", and the series of combined revenue and postage stamps specified in the Notice dated the 20th December, 1932, which was published in the High Commissioner's Gazette, dated the 30th December, 1932, is referred to as the "new series".
- 2. All revenue stamps of the old series shall be demonetised with effect from the 1st January, 1934. On and after that date such stamps shall not be valid or available for the payment of stamp duties or fees or for any purpose other than the purpose of exchange as hereinafter provided.
- 3. Unused and unspoilt stamps of the old series may be exchanged as follows:—
 - (a) The holder may apply to the Financial Secretary, Mbabane, Swaziland;
 (b) the application must be in writing;

(b) the application must be in writing;
(c) the stamps must in every case accompany the application. They must be surrendered intact with face and gum undamaged and must not be pasted on the application form or on any other paper or material;
(d) application must be made within the period prescribed in proviso (a) to section four of the Stamp Duties and Fees (Swaziland) Proclamation No. 38 of 1931, viz.: Twelve months from the date of demonetisation. The said period will expire on the 31st December, 1934, and applications made after that date will not be granted;

(e) the Financial Secretary, if satisfied that applications are in order and that the stamps are genuine and unused and were lawfully acquired by the applicants, will issue stamps of an equivalent value of the new series in

exchange;

(f) the Financial Secretary may for the purpose of satisfying himself that the stamps offered for exchange have been lawfully acquired and that statements made in connection with applications are correct, require any applicant to furnish, in the form of affidavit or otherwise, such evidence as the said officer may deem necessary
