PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE RIGHT HONOURABLE SIR PATRICK DUNCAN, A MEMBER OF HIS MAJESTY'S MOST HONOURABLE PRIVY COUNCIL, KNIGHT GRAND CROSS OF THE MOST DISTINGUISHED ORDER OF SAINT MICHAEL AND SAINT GEORGE, ONE OF HIS MAJESTY'S COUNSEL LEARNED IN THE LAW, DOCTOR OF LAWS, GOVERNOR-GENERAL OF THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA.

Whereas the National Emergency Regulations set forth in the Annexure to Proclamation No. 201 of 1939, dated the 14th day of September, 1939, were brought into operation by the said Proclamation;

And whereas it is expedient to amend the said Regulations to make provision to enable persons, who are not citizens, to serve in the Coast Garrison and Active Citizen Force; and further to make provision for the carrying out by the Secretary for Defence of the duties and functions of the Civil Aviation Board;

Now, therefore, I do hereby proclaim, declare and make known that the said Regulations are hereby amended as set out in the Annexure to this Proclamation.

ANNEXURE.

The following new regulations are added after regulation 26:—

ENGAGEMENT OF ALIENS FOR SERVICE.

27. During the continuance of the present war—

 - (a) any person who is not a citizen within the meaning of section *one hundred and twenty-four* of the South Africa Defence Act, 1912, may apply to serve with the Coast Garrison or Active Citizen Force, and may be engaged so to serve on the same terms and conditions as if he were a citizen;
 - (b) the Governor-General may establish and organize a unit of the Active Citizen Force consisting of persons who are not citizens, and that unit shall be styled the Foreign Legion.

SUSPENSION OF CIVIL AIR BOARD.

28. During the continuance of the present war the Civil Air Board established under the provisions of section four of the Aviation Act, 1923, shall not function and all powers of the said Board shall be vested in, and all functions and duties of the said Board shall be performed by the Secretary for Defence.
