PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner.

Whereas it is desirable to make further provision out of the public revenue or other funds of the Bechuanaland Protectorate to meet certain additional expenditure incurred during the year ended on the 31st day of March, 1939:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

Additional Appropriation.
1. The public revenue or other funds of the Bechuanaland Protectorate are hereby charged with a further sum of £11,967. 5s. 8d. (Eleven thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven pounds five shillings and eightpence) to meet expenditure incurred during the year which ended on the 31st day of March, 1939, in excess of the amount appropriated for the purpose according to the particulars set forth in the Schedule to this Proclamation.

Short title and commencement.
2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Further Appropriation (1938-39) Proclamation, 1940, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.





ADVERTISEMENT RATES.

LEGAL NOTICES, Lost Deeds, Certificates, Policies, etc., Messengers' Notices, Trade Marks, Orders of Court, Surrenders, Tenders and Sales, Company Notices, etc.

Rates of advertising are as follows:—

- 5s. per inch single column; repeats 3s.
