KENNISGEWING INGEVOLGE REGULASIE 3 VAN DIE AANHANGSEL VAN PROKLAMASIE NO. 201 VAN 1939.

Kragtens die bepalings van regulasie 3 van die Landsnoodtoestand-regulasies, uiteengesit in die Aanhangsel van Proklamasie No. 201 van 1939, en op aanbeveling van die Raad van Beheer van Landsvoorrade, bepaal ek, RICHARD STUTTAFORD, Minister van Handel en Nywerheid, hierby dat—

- (a) die prysvasstelling van sigarette uiteengesit in paragraaf (4) van artikel 2 van die Aanhangsel van Goewermentskennisgewing No. 74 van 12 Januarie 1940, uitgerek ingevolge gemelde regulasie, ingetrek word; en
- (b) die maksimum prys waarteen sigarette op enige plek binne die Unie of die Mandaatgebied Suidwes-Afrika verkoop mag word, die prys is waarteen sodanige goedere gewoonlik op daardie plek op 26 Augustus 1940 verkoop is plus een half-pennie vir elke tien sodanige sigarette.

NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 3 OF THE ANNEXURE TO PROCLAMATION No. 201 OF 1939.

I, RICHARD STUTTAFORD, Minister of Commerce and Industries, acting in terms of Regulation 3 of the National Emergency Regulations set forth in the Annexure to Proclamation No. 201 of 1939 and on the recommendation of the National Supplies Control Board, do hereby

- (a) withdraw the price fixation for cigarettes set forth in paragraph (4) of Section 2 of the Annexure to Government Notice No. 74 of the 12th January, 1940, issued in terms of the said regulation; and
- (b) throughout the Union and the Mandated Territory of South West Africa fix as the maximum price, at which cigarettes may be sold in any particular place, the price at which such cigarettes were ordinarily sold at that place on the 26th August, 1940, plus one half penny for every ten such cigarettes.
