ANNEXURE.

APPOINTMENT OF BRANCH DETENTION BARRACKS.

1. Notwithstanding anything in any law contained in the Officer Commanding an Area, Command or Fortress Command Area, may establish in suitable premises a Branch Detention Barrack provided that no person shall be committed to or detained under any one sentence in such a Branch Detention Barrack for any period in excess of twenty-eight days.

2. All Branch Detention Barracks already established shall be deemed to have been established in terms hereof.

BYLAE.

- Vir die toepassing van hierdie regulasies beteken „raad”, die Raad van Beheer oor die Koringnywerheid waarna in artikel 2 van die Koringreëlingskema, gepubliseer by Proklamasie No. 212 van 1938, soos gewysig, verwys word;
- „menelaar”, 'n persoon wat geregistreer is kragtens paragraaf (a) van subartikel (1) van artikel 24 van die Koringreëlingskema, gepubliseer by Proklamasie No. 212 van 1938, soos gewysig;
- „minister”, die Minister van Landbou en Bosbou of 'n ander Staatsminister wat namens hom optree.

2. Every miller shall within fourteen days after the publication hereof pay to the board an amount calculated at the rate of two shillings and five pence per 200 lb. net weight on—

- (a) a quantity of wheat equal to one-twelfth of the quantity sold to him by the board for grinding, crushing, gristing or otherwise processing during the period 1st December, 1941, to 30th November, 1942; and
- (b) all wheat which the board has on or before the 31st October, 1942, delivered or despatched to him, or to any person on his behalf, for grinding, crushing, gristing or otherwise processing after 30th November, 1942.

3. Any moneys paid to the board under regulation 2, shall be dealt with in such manner as the Minister may direct.

4. (1) Any person who fails to comply with the requirements of regulation 2 shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months or to both such fine and such imprisonment.

(2) Whenever a person is convicted of an offence under sub-regulation (1), the court convicting him shall summarily inquire into and assess the monetary equivalent of any advantage he may have gained in consequence of that offence and impose on him an additional fine equal to twice the amount so assessed or, in default of payment of such fine, imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months.

(3) A magistrate's court shall have jurisdiction to impose any penalty prescribed by this regulation even though such penalty may exceed the ordinary punitive jurisdiction of a magistrate's court.

PROHIBITED AREA.—SOUTHERN CAPE PENINSULA.

The Cape Peninsula south of a line as described hereunder: From the low water mark of False Bay on a line at right angles to the Cape Town-Simonstown Main Road at the barrier erected over this road near Glencairn quarries; thence in a straight line in a north-westerly direction to the survey beacon known as Brakkloof; thence in a straight line in a westerly direction to the survey beacon known as Rooikrans; thence in a straight line in a south-westerly direction to the highest point of the hill known as Kleinberg; thence in a straight line in a north-westerly direction to the south-western corner of Lot No. 1058A, Kommetjie Estate owned by Mr. W. H. NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 3 OF WAR MEASURE
No. 100 OF 1942.

MAXIMUM PRICES OF CIGARETTES.

In terms of regulation 3 of War Measure No. 100 of 1942, I, ALEXANDER BUTTER McDONALD, Price Controller, do hereby throughout the Union—

- (a) fix the prices specified in the Schedule hereto as the maximum prices at which cigarettes of the brands specified in the said Schedule may be sold by a retail dealer to any other person;
- (b) direct that with effect from 15th November, 1942, every retail dealer who sells the said cigarettes, shall display the prices specified in the said Schedule in both official languages, in clearly legible form and at a place in his shop which is prominent and easily accessible to members of the public when purchasing cigarettes.

For the purposes of this notice "Union" excludes the Mandated Territory of South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay.

CONTROL OF INDUSTRIAL CHEMICALS.

It is notified for general information that many persons have failed to comply with the requirements of Government Notice No. 1648, published in *Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 3087 of the 14th August, 1942, which called for the rendition of certain returns, as set out in the Annexure thereto, from all persons owning or having power to dispose of or being in possession or control of any industrial chemical of which the amount held or handled is not less than 200 lb. or 20 gallons per annum.

Attention is invited to the footnote to the notice which states that no certificate of essentiality or import or export facilities can be extended to persons failing to make a return. It is further pointed out that under War Measure No. 7 of 1942, published in *Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 2989 of the 26th January, 1942, regulation 8 (b) read in conjunction with regulation 5 (c) provides that any person failing to submit any return called for by a Controller shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to the penalty of a fine not exceeding £200 and/or imprisonment during a period not exceeding one year.

Although the prescribed period allowed for the submission of returns for the quarter ended 30th September, 1942, has expired, the Controller of Industrial Chemicals is prepared to accept returns reaching his office (30 De Villiers Buildings, Bureau Lane, Pretoria) on or before the 12th November, 1942, as having complied with the requirements of Government Notice No. 1648.
