ANNEXURE.

NATIONAL EMERGENCY REGULATIONS.—AMENDMENT OF REGULATION 15.

Regulation 15 of the regulations promulgated by Proclamation No. 201 of 1939, as amended by Proclamations No. 205 of 1939, 279 of 1939 and No. 20 of 1941, is hereby further amended by the insertion in sub-regulation 3(bis) of the words "who has been released from a place of detention as provided in sub-regulation (3), or " between the words "person" and "who" in line 4.

Under the powers vested in me by section one bis of the War Measures Act, 1940 (Act No. 13 of 1940), as inserted by section one of the War Measures (Amendment) Act, 1940 (No. 32 of 1940), I do hereby make the regulations set forth in the Annexure to this Proclamation.

This Proclamation shall be called War Measure No. 43 of 1943.

ANNEXURE.

NATIONAL EMERGENCY REGULATIONS.—DEFINITION OF ENEMY SUBJECT.

Regulation 1 of the Annexure to Proclamation No. 201 of 1939, of the 14th September, 1939, published in *Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 2679 of the 14th September, 1939, is hereby amended by the addition of the following definition:—

"Enemy subject" means a national of any State with which the Union may be at war, and includes any person who,

## MAXIMUM PRICES OF MOTOR VEHICLE LUBRICATING OILS AND MAXIMUM CHARGES FOR GARAGE SERVICES.

1. In terms of regulation 3 of War Measure No. 100 of 1942, I, EDWARD JAMES CREAN, Price Controller, do hereby throughout the Union—

(1) prescribe that the prices specified in the First Schedule hereto, shall be the maximum prices at which the motor vehicle lubricating oils specified in the said Schedule may, except in the case of a sale by a dealer to another dealer, be sold by any person to any other person;

(2) prescribe that the maximum price at which any motor vehicle-lubricating oil not specified in the said Schedule, may be sold by a dealer to any other person shall not exceed the cost thereof to the seller plus *50 per cent.* of such cost, provided that the provisions of this sub-paragraph shall not be construed as modifying or affecting in any way the provisions of regulation 6 of the above-quoted War Measure in any transaction to which the provisions of the said regulation may be applicable;

(3) fix the charges specified in the Second Schedule hereto as the maximum charges, which a dealer may make to any other person for the services specified in the said Schedule; and

(4) direct that every retail dealer who sells any of the oils specified in the First Schedule hereto, and every dealer who renders any of the services specified in the Second Schedule hereto, shall display the said prices and charges in both official languages, in clearly legible form and at a place in his shop or garage which is prominent and easily accessible to the public.

2. For the purposes of this notice—

“cost” means cost as defined in paragraph (4) of the Schedule to Government Notice No. 284 of the 12th of February, 1943, as amended by Government Notice No. 691 of the 9th of April, 1943;

“dealer” includes a motor garage-keeper; and

“Union” excludes the Mandated Territory of South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay.

3. Government Notice No. 1493 of 24th October, 1941, is hereby amended by the deletion of the items specified in the Schedule thereto, other than the items:—

“Parking only, of motor vehicles”; and

“Parking only, including wiping down, of motor vehicles”;

In terms of regulation 3 of War Measure No. 100 of 1942, I, EDWARD JAMES CREAN, Price Controller, do hereby throughout the Union—

(1) fix as the maximum price at which the agricultural implement specified in the Schedule hereto may be sold by a dealer to any person other than a dealer the price specified in the Schedule hereto, plus the cost of transportation actually and necessarily incurred by the seller in transporting such agricultural implement by Rail and/or Road Motor Service from his warehouse or from the warehouse of the distributor or wholesaler from whom he acquired such agricultural implement, to the purchaser;

(2) direct that for the purpose of this Notice—

“Union” includes the Mandated Territory of South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay.
