MAXIMUM PRICE OF TIN.

In terms of regulation 3 of War Measure No. 49 of 1946, I, Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Price Controller, do hereby, throughout the Union excluding the Mandated Territory of South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay—

1. Fix the maximum price at which any tin metal as ingots, strip, bar, rod or any other shape or form may be sold to any person by any person other than the Zaaiplaats Tin Mining Co. Ltd., at the cost of such tin to the seller plus 4½d. per pound; and
2. Withdraw Government Notice No. 1644 of 29th June 1951 (Maximum Price of Tin).

MAXIMUM CHARGES FOR THRESHING OF MEALIES.

In terms of regulation 3 of War Measure No. 49 of 1946, I, Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Price Controller, do hereby throughout the Union, excluding the Mandated Territory of South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay—

1. Prescribe that the maximum charge that may be made by any person for the threshing of mealies shall be—
(1) if the quantity threshed does not exceed 300 bags—
(a) 9d. per bag if at the time of threshing the mealie-cobs are unhusked; and
(b) 7d. per bag if at the time of threshing the mealie-cobs are husked;

- (2) wanneer die hoeveelheid wat gedors word meer as 300 sak is—
 (a) 8d. per sak as die mielies wat gedors word blaarkoppe is; en
 (b) 6d. per sak as die mielies wat gedors word skoonkoppe is.

PRICE CONTROL.

MAXIMUM PRICES OF EGGS.—FINAL SEASONAL DECREASE.

In terms of regulations 3 and 9 of War Measure No. 49 of 1946, I, Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Price Controller, do hereby:—

1. Fix the maximum prices at which, throughout the controlled area, eggs may be sold by a dealer to another dealer at the prices specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto.

2. Fix the maximum prices at which, throughout the controlled area, eggs may, except in the case of a sale by a dealer to another dealer, be sold by any person to any other person at the prices specified in column 2 of the First Schedule hereto.

3. Fix the maximum prices at which, elsewhere than in the controlled area, eggs may be sold by any person to any other person at the prices specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

4. Direct that every retail dealer in eggs shall display under the heading “Maximum Retail Prices of Eggs—Maksimum Kleinhandelprys van Eiers” in both official languages, in clearly legible form and at the place in his shop or other place of business which is prominent and easily accessible to the public, the maximum prices at which, in terms of paragraph 2 or 3 hereof, he may sell eggs.

5. Direct that for the purposes of Government Notice No. 1640 of 20th July, 1950, relating to the issue of invoices, an agent selling eggs on behalf of a producer shall be regarded as a wholesale dealer selling such eggs on his own account.

6. Direct that for the purposes of this notice, any expression to which in the regulations contained in the Annexure to War Measure No. 3 of 1945 (Proclamation No. 28 of 1945), as amended, a meaning has been assigned, bears, when used in this notice, the same meaning, and “eggs” means eggs other than “chilled eggs” or “liquid eggs”.
