MAXIMUM CHARGES FOR MOTOR VEHICLE REPAIR SERVICES AND CERTAIN GARAGE SERVICES ("FLAT RATES").

In terms of regulation 3 of War Measure No. 49 of 1946, I, Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Price Controller, do hereby amend Government Notice No. 605 of 28th March, 1952 (Maximum Charges for Motor Vehicle Repair Services and Certain Garage Services):—

1. By the deletion of paragraph 4 thereof, and substitution therefor of the following paragraph:—

4. Direct that, subject to the provisions of paragraph 5 and with effect from 1st July, 1952, the Fourth Schedule to the aforesaid Government Notice No. 605 of 28th March, 1952, shall be applicable to repair services rendered in connection with the motor vehicles referred to in the Fifth Schedule hereto.

1. Deur paragraaf 4 daarvan te skrap en dit te vervang deur die volgende paragraaf:—

In terms of regulation 3 of War Measure No. 49 of 1946, I, Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Price Controller, do hereby, throughout the Union, excluding the Mandated Territory of South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay—

1. Fix the maximum prices at which new trek chains specified in the Schedule hereto may be sold by any person to any other person at the prices specified in the said Schedule.

2. Deur die woorde „Vvfde Bylae” in paragraaf 9 daarvan te vervang deur die woorde „Sesde Bylae”.

3. Deur subparagraaf (c) in die Derde Bylae daarvan te skrap en dit te vervang deur die volgende:—

PRICE CONTROL.

MAXIMUM PRICES OF FIREWOOD.

In terms of regulation 3 of War Measure No. 49 of 1946, I, Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Price Controller, do hereby, throughout the Union, excluding the Mandated Territory of South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay:—

1. Fix the maximum price at which a producer may sell any firewood to a dealer in a major urban area at twenty-seven shillings and six pence per short ton (2,000 lb.); provided that where the firewood is railed to or to the order of the buyer, the maximum price fixed herein shall be free on rail, producer's station or siding.

2. Fix the maximum price at which a dealer in a major urban area may sell firewood to any person at the price referred to in paragraph 1 hereof plus the actual cost of railage, plus one shilling and three-pence per bag of 100 lb., delivered at the premises of the consumer.

3. Direct that for the purpose of this notice—

"producer" means any person who cuts and/or loads firewood;

"firewood" includes any type of firewood whatsoever whether split or in logs;

"major urban area" means Bloemfontein, Durban, East London, Kimberley, Pietermaritzburg, Port Elizabeth, Pretoria or the Witwatersrand;

"Bloemfontein, Durban, East London, Kimberley and Pietermaritzburg" mean the municipal areas of Bloemfontein, Durban, East London, Kimberley and Pietermaritzburg respectively;

"Port Elizabeth" means the municipal area of Port Elizabeth and Walmer;

"Pretoria" means the municipal area of Pretoria including the township of Menlo Park, Waterkloof and Waverley;

"Witwatersrand" means the areas under the jurisdiction of the local authorities at Alberton, Alexandra Township, Benoni, Boksburg, Brakpan, Edenvale, Germiston, Johannesburg, Kempton Park, Krugersdorp, Nigel, Randfontein, Roodepoort-Maraisburg, Springs and Vereeniging together with the township of Vanderbijl Park.

Ek, Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Pryskontroleur, handelende kragtens regulasie 3 van Oorlogsmaatreël No. 49 van 1946, bepaal hierby vir die hele Unie, met uitsondering van die Mandaatgebied Suidwes-Afrika en die hawe en nedersetting Walvisbaai as volg:—

1. Die maksimum prys waarteen 'n produsent brandhout aan 'n handelaar in 'n groot stedelike gebied mag verkoop, is sewe-en-twintig sjielings en ses pennies per kort ton (2,000 pond), met dien verstande dat wanneer brandhout per spoor aan of aan die order van die koper gestuur word, die maksimum prys hierby vastgestel vry op spoor produsente se stasie of sylyn is.

Fix the maximum price at which any porcelain enamelled cast iron rectangular topper bath manufactured in the Union may be sold by any person, other than the manufacturer thereof, to any other person at £16. 5s. each for a 6-foot overall size and £15. 2s. for a 5 foot 6 inch overall size, provided that the actual railage and/or road motor transport costs incurred in transporting the baths to the dealers' premises may be added to the above prices.

PRICE CONTROL.

MAXIMUM PRICES OF CLOCKS AND WATCHES.

In terms of regulation 3 of War Measure No. 49 of 1946, I, Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Price Controller, do hereby, throughout the Union, excluding the Mandated Territory of South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay:—

1. Subject to the provisions of paragraph 2 hereof—

(1) fix the maximum price at which any clock or watch may be sold to a dealer by the importer thereof at the cost of such clock or watch to the importer plus 30 per cent. thereof;

(2) fix the maximum price—

(a) at which any striking and/or chiming clock (excluding an alarm clock that does not also strike or chime), or any clock or watch of seven jewels or more may be sold to any person by any person other than the importer thereof at the cost of such clock or watch to the seller plus 70 per cent. thereof;

(b) at which any clock other than a clock referred to in subparagraph (a) hereof, may be sold to any person by any person other than the importer thereof at the cost of such clock to the seller plus 50 per cent. thereof;

(c) at which any watch other than a watch referred to in subparagraph (a) hereof, may be sold to any person by any person other than the importer thereof at the cost of such watch to the seller plus 65 per cent. thereof;

(3) fix the maximum price—

(a) at which any clock or watch of seven jewels or more may be sold to any person other than a dealer by the importer thereof at the cost of such clock or watch to such importer plus 95 per cent. thereof;

(b) at which any clock or watch other than a clock or watch to which subparagraph (a) applies may be sold to any person other than a dealer by the importer thereof at the cost of such clock or watch to such importer plus 90 per cent. thereof.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in paragraph 1 hereof fix the maximum prices at which "Westclox" watches and alarm clocks of the descriptions specified in the First Schedule hereto—

(1) may be sold by a dealer to another dealer at the prices specified in column 2 of the said Schedule; and

(2) may, except in a sale to which subparagraph (1) hereof applies, be sold by any person to any other person at the prices specified in column 3 of the said Schedule.

3. Direct that any dealer shall, at the time of the sale by him of any clock or watch in terms of subparagraph (2) (a) or subparagraph (3) (a) of paragraph 1 hereof, give to the purchaser a written and signed guarantee in the form prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto.

4. Withdraw Government Notice No. 830 of 10th April, 1952, relating to the maximum prices of clocks and watches.

TO IMPORTERS OF RAW MATERIALS, CONSUMABLE STORES AND MAINTENANCE SPARES FOR INDUSTRY.

1. The Director of Imports and Exports, acting in accordance with the decision of the Minister of Economic Affairs, hereby notifies importers that no further automatic issues of import facilities for raw materials, consumable stores and maintenance spares will be made for shipment during 1952.

2. In view of the undermentioned factors, it is considered that the requirements of the majority of industrial concerns have already been covered; these factors are—

- (i) the substantial importations during 1951 which have enabled an improvement in inventories;
- (ii) the fall in the prices of many commodities, particularly basic raw materials;
- (iii) the falling off in many instances of the internal demand;
- (iv) the carry-over of 1951 permits up to 31st March, 1952;
- (v) in some cases, increased local production of raw materials.

3. Any industrial concerns who consider that their requirements for shipment up to 31st December, 1952, have not been fully catered for may submit applications to the appropriate section of the Directorate for further consideration. Additional allocations will, however, only be granted in exceptional circumstances and where the products to be manufactured, are highly essential.

4. Such applications must be fully analysed for each Department of the applicant's factory and should indicate, *inter alia*—

- (i) the *quantities* and f.o.b. values of the *major* raw materials—
 - (a) imported during 1951;
 - (b) consumed during 1951 (direct imports only);
 - (c) held in stock at 31st December, 1951;
 - (d) covered by outstanding orders on 1951 permits and not received into stock by 31st December, 1951;
 - (e) total further requirements for shipment up to 31st December, 1952, including 1952 allocations already received, with due and proper allowance for (i) (c) and (d) above and necessary stocks at 31st December, 1952. Allowance should also be properly made for any alteration in price levels since 1951, and for any additional local sources of supply becoming available;
- (ii) f.o.b. values only of *minor* raw materials, consumable stores and maintenance spares—
 - (a) imported during 1951;
 - (b) consumed during 1951 (direct imports only);
 - (c) held in stock at 31st December, 1951;
 - (d) covered by outstanding orders on 1951 permits and not received into stock by 31st December, 1951;
 - (e) total further requirements for shipment up to 31st December, 1952, including 1952 allocations already received;

AAN INVOERDERS VAN GRONDSTOWWE, VERBRUIKBARE GOEDERE EN INSTANDHOUDINGSONDERDELE VIR DIE NYWERHEID.

1. Die Direkteur van Invoer en Uitvoer, handelende ooreenkomsdig die beslissing van die Minister van Ekonomiese Sake, stel invoerders hierby in kennis dat daar geen verdere *automatiese* uitrekings van invoerfasilitete vir grondstowwe, verbruikbare goedere en instandhoudingsonderdele vir verskaping gedurende 1952 sal geskied nie.

2. Met die oog op ondergemelde faktore word gemeen dat daar reeds aan die vereistes van die meeste nywerheidsondernemings voldoen is; hierdie faktore is—

- (i) die aansienlike hoeveelheid goedere gedurende 1951 ingevoer, wat 'n verbetering in inventaris bewerkstellig het;
- (ii) die daling in die pryse van baie handelsartikels, vernaamlik basiese grondstowwe;
- (iii) die afname, in baie gevalle, van die interne aanvraag;
- (iv) die oordrag van 1951-permitte tot 31 Maart 1952;
- (v) in sommige gevalle die verhoogde plaaslike produksie van grondstowwe.

3. Enige nywerheidsonderneming wat van mening is dat daar nie vir sy behoeftes vir verskaping tot 31 Desember 1952 voldoende voorsiening gemaak is nie, kan aansoek om verdere oorweging tot die betrokke afdeling van die Direktoraat rig. Bykomstige toekenning sal egter slegs onder buitengewone omstandighede toegestaan word, en wanneer die produkte wat vervaardig moet word, hoogsnoodaanklik is.

4. Scdanige aansoek moet volledig ontleed word vir elke afdeling van die applikant se fabriek en moet, onder andere, die volgende aandui:—

- (i) Die *hoeveelhede* en v.a.b.-waardes van die *belangriker* grondstowwe—
 - (a) gedurende 1951 ingevoer;
 - (b) gedurende 1951 verbruik (slegs regstreeks ingevoerde goedere);
 - (c) op 31 Desember 1951 in voorraad gehou;
 - (d) gedek deur uitstaande bestellings op 1951-permitte en nie op 31 Desember 1951 in voorraad ontvang nie;
 - (e) totale verdere benodigdhede vir verskaping tot 31 Desember, 1952, insluitende 1952-toekenning reeds ontvang, met behoorlike inagneming van (i) (c) en (d) hierbo en nodige voorrade op 31 Desember 1952. Daar moet ook behoorlik rekening gehou word met enige verandering in prysvlakte sedert 1951, en met enige plaaslike bronre van voorsiening wat beskikbaar word.
- (ii) Slegs v.a.b.-waardes van *minder belangrike* grondstowwe, verbruikbare goedere en instandhoudingsonderdele—
 - (a) gedurende 1951 ingevoer;
 - (b) gedurende 1951 verbruik (slegs regstreeks ingevoerde goedere);
 - (c) op 31 Desember 1951 in voorraad gehou;
 - (d) gedek deur uitstaande bestellings op 1951-permitte en nie op 31 Desember 1951 in voorraad ontvang nie;
 - (e) totale verdere benodigdhede vir verskaping tot 31 Desember 1952, insluitende 1952-toekenning reeds ontvang.

(iii) total f.o.b. value of further requirements of major and minor items required for shipment up to 31st December, 1952 [i.e., total of (i) (e) and (ii) (e) above], less letters of authority and/or direct permits for 1952 already received.

5. In the event of further requirements from hard currency countries which cannot be covered by 1952 letters of authority and/or direct permits already received, applicants are required to submit full and separate particulars in respect thereof on lines similar to those called for in paragraph 4 above, and must in addition indicate full reasons (including price and availability), why such requirements cannot be obtained from soft currency countries.

SURRENDER OF LETTERS OF AUTHORITY AND/OR DIRECT PERMITS.

6. Any importer who has already received 1952 letters of authority and/or direct permits which, for reasons set out in paragraph 2 above, may be in excess of his requirements for shipment up to 31st December, 1952, is requested to advise the appropriate section of the Directorate and to surrender such portions of his letters of authority and/or direct permits as are in excess of his requirements.

7. Any importer so surrendering a portion of his 1952 letters of authority or direct permits shall have the right at a later date to apply for the reinstatement thereof provided he can reasonably demonstrate that he requires such a reinstatement for the maintenance of his own industry. The co-operation of importers is sought and no importer who acts bona fide in this matter will be prejudiced.

8. During the 1951 permit period a number of raw material importers did not utilise the whole or a major portion of the import facilities made available to them. The Directorate requests the co-operation of importers to avoid a repetition of this situation in 1952, and the records of individual firms will be watched and cognisance taken in the 1953 issues of any firm manifestly failing to comply with the request set out in paragraph 6 above.

RETURN OF 1951 PERMITS.

9. Attention is drawn to condition 3 appearing on the reverse of all import permits, and importers are required to return to the Directorate all permits held by them which are no longer valid either because they have been fully utilised or because the validity period has expired.

5. In geval van verdere benodigdhede ten opsigte van artikels uit hardemuntlande wat nie deur magtigingsbriewe en/of regstreekse permitte reeds vir 1952 ontvang, gedeck kan word nie, word van applikante verlang om volledige en afsonderlike besonderhede in verband daarmee op diéselfde wyse as dié waarom in paragraaf 4 hierbo gevra word, te verstrek, en om daarbenewens volledige redes (insluitende prys en beskikbaarheid), te verstrek waarom sodanige benodigdhede nie van sagtemuntlande verkry kan word nie.

AFSTAND VAN MAGTIGINGSBRIEWE EN/OF REGSTREEKSE PERMITTE.

6. Enige invoerder wat reeds 1952-magtigingsbriewe en/of regstreekse permitte vir 1952 ontvang het, wat om redes in paragraaf 2 hierbo uiteengesit, sy benodigdhede vir verskeping tot 31 Desember 1952 mag oorskry, word versoek om die betrokke afdeling van die Direksie daarvan te verwittig en om afstand te doen van sodanige gedeeltes van sy magtigingsbriewe en/of regstreekse permitte as wat sy benodigdhede oorskry.

7. Enige invoerder wat aldus afstand doen van 'n gedeelte van sy 1952-magtigingsbriewe en/of regstreekse permitte vir 1952, sal die reg hê om op 'n later datum aansoek te doen om teruggawe daarvan, mits hy redelike bewys kan lewer dat sodanige teruggawe noodsaaklik is vir die instandhouding van sy eie nywerheid. Die same-werking van invoerders word verlang en geen invoerder wat in goeie trou in hierdie saak optree, sal benadeel word nie.

8. Gedurende die 1951-permittydperk het 'n aantal invoerders van grondstowwe nie al die invoerfasiliteite wat toegestaan is, of 'n groot gedeelte daarvan, gebruik nie. Die Direksie vra die samewerking van invorderers om 'n herhaling van hierdie toestand in 1952 te voorkom, en die registers van individuele firmas sal dopgehou word en daar sal in die 1953-uitrekkings-kennis gencem word van enige firma wat klaarblyklik in gebreke bly om aan die versoek in paragraaf 6 hierbo uiteengesit, te voldoen.

TERUGSTUUR VAN 1951-PERMITTE.

9. Die aandag word gevestig op voorwaarde No. 3 wat op die keersy van alle invorderpermitte verskyn en invorderers word versoek om alle permitte in hul besit wat nie langer geldig is nie, hetby omdat hulle ten volle gebruik is of omdat hul geldigheidstydperk verstryk het, aan die Direksie terug te stuur.

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
