SOUTH AFRICAN CITRUS SCHEME.

WITHDRAWAL OF PROHIBITION ON SALE OF LEMONS OTHER THAN LEMONS EXPORTED IN CASES.

In terms of section twenty-nine of the Marketing Act, 1937 (Act No. 26 of 1937), as amended, I, STEPHANUS PETRUS LE ROUX, Minister of Agriculture, hereby make known that the Citrus Board, referred to in section 2 of South African Citrus Scheme, published by Proclamation No. 44 of 1947, has, in terms of section 19 of the said scheme and with my approval, withdrawn the prohibition imposed on the sale of lemons other than lemons packed for export, which prohibitions were made known by Government Notice No. 1878 of 10th September, 1954, which is hereby amended as set out in the Schedule hereto.

And I do further make known that this withdrawal of the said prohibitions shall become operative upon the date of publication hereof.
