PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCE THE HONOURABLE ERNEST GEORGE JANSEN, DOCTOR OF LAWS, GOVERNOR-GENERAL OF THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA.

PROHIBITION ON THE SALE OF CERTAIN MEALIE PRODUCTS UNLESS MARKED AND PACKED ACCORDING TO GRADE IN THE MANNER PRESCRIBED.

Under the powers vested in me by section thirty-six of the Marketing Act, 1937 (Act No. 26 of 1937), as amended, I do hereby declare that no person shall sell sifted granulated mealie meal, unsifted granulated mealie meal, unsifted non-granulated mealie meal, undergrade mealie meal, mealie flour, bakers' cones, mealie grits, mealie rice, samp, undergrade degermed product, unsifted crushed mealies, sifted crushed mealies, fine sifted crushed mealies, mealie germ feed, fine mealie bran or coarse mealie bran in the Union, unless it is marked and packed according to grade in a manner prescribed by regulation under the said Act.

For the purpose of the foregoing prohibition the word "sell" shall have the meaning assigned thereto in the said Act.

Proclamation No. 105 of 1955 is hereby repealed.

In terms of War Measure No. 49 of 1946, I, Harry de Lacy Burnham, Price Controller, hereby prescribe as follows:—

1. Subject to the provisions of paragraphs 2 and 3 hereof, the maximum price at which throughout the Union, excluding South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay, lucerne, dried, in bales

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel ses-en-dertig van die Bemarkingswet, 1937 (Wet No. 26 van 1937), soos gewysig, verklaar ek hierby dat niemand gesifte gegranuleerde mielie-meel, ongesifte gegranuleerde mielie-meel, ongesifte nie-gegranuleerde mielie-meel, ondergraadse mielie-meel, mielie-meelblom, bakkerstrooisel, mieliegruis, mieliers, stampmielies, ondergraadse kiemlose produk, ongesifte gebroke mielies, gesifte gebroke mielies, gesifte fyngebroke mielies, mieliekiemvoer, fyn mieliesemels of groewe mieliesemels in die Unie mag verkoop nie, tensy dit volgens graad gemerk en verpak is op 'n wyse soos voorgeskryf by regulasie kragtens genoemde Wet.

Vir die toepassing van die voorafgaande verbod, het die woord „verkoop” die betekenis wat in genoemde Wet daarvan geheg word.
