1. TITEL VAN HIERDIE REGULASIES.

Hierdie regulasies heet die Vorms-regulasies in verband met Veiligheid, Aanhouding en Verbeuring van Skepe, 1968.

2. UITLEG.

9. PLAASLIKE VEILIGHEIDSERTIFICAAT.

Elke plaaslike veiligheidsertifikaat wat kragtens artikel 194(1) van die Wet uitgereik word, moet in die vorm wees soos in Aanhangsel 12, 13, 14 of 15 uiteengesit, watter een ook al van toepassing is.

1. TITLE OF THESE REGULATIONS.

These regulations are called the Forms Regulations relating to Safety, Detention and Forfeiture of Ships, 1968.

2. INTERPRETATION.

In these regulations the expression "the Act" means the Merchant Shipping Act, 1951 (Act No. 57 of 1951), and unless the context otherwise indicates, any expression used in these regulations to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act, bears the meaning so assigned.

3. SURVEYOR'S REPORT OF INSPECTION OF A SHIP UNDER SECTION 191 OF THE ACT.

Every surveyor's report of inspection under Section 191 of the Act shall be in the form set forth in Annex 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 whichever is applicable.

4. PASSENGER SHIP SAFETY CERTIFICATE FOR AN INTERNATIONAL VOYAGE OR A SHORT INTERNATIONAL VOYAGE.

Every passenger ship safety certificate for an international voyage or a short international voyage shall be in the form set forth in Annex 6.

5. CARGO SHIP SAFETY CONSTRUCTION CERTIFICATE.

Every cargo ship safety construction certificate shall be in the form set forth in Annex 7 or in such other form substantially to the like effect as the Minister may from time to time direct.

6. CARGO SHIP SAFETY EQUIPMENT CERTIFICATE.

Every cargo ship safety equipment certificate shall be in the form set forth in Annex 8.

7. CARGO SHIP SAFETY RADIO CERTIFICATES.

Every cargo ship safety radiotelegraphy certificate shall be in the form set forth in Annex 9 and every cargo ship safety radiotelephony certificate shall be in the form set forth in Annex 10.

8. EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE.

Every exemption certificate shall be in the form set forth in Annex 11.

9. LOCAL SAFETY CERTIFICATE.

Every local safety certificate issued under Section 194 (1) of the Act shall be in the form set forth in Annex 12, 13, 14 or 15 whichever is applicable.

10. NOTICE OF DETENTION OF A VESSEL OR GOODS.

Every notice of detention of a vessel or share therein or of goods served under Section 335 of the Act, shall be in the form set forth in Annex 16 or 17 whichever is applicable.

11. NOTICE OF RELEASE OF A VESSEL OR GOODS.

Every notice of release of a vessel or share therein or goods detained, served under Section 335 of the Act, shall be in the form set forth in Annex 18 or 19 whichever is applicable.

12. NOTICE OF FORFEITURE OF A SHIP, SHARE OR INTEREST IN A SHIP, OR OF GOODS.

Every notice of forfeiture of a ship, share or interest in a ship, or of goods, served under Section 336 of the Act, shall be in the form set forth in Annex 20 or 21 whichever is applicable.

13. WITHDRAWAL OF NOTICE OF FORFEITURE IN RESPECT OF A SHIP, SHARE OR INTEREST IN A SHIP, OR OF GOODS.
