**Tot wysiging van die Wet op Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, 1969,  
om vir die onteiening van sekere grond voorsiening te maak.**

(Goedgekeur op 3 Maart 1970.)*

**DAAR WORD BEPAAL** deur die Staatspresident, die Senaat  
en die Volksraad van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, soos  
volg:—

Invoeging van  
artikel 14A in Wet  
28 van 1969.

**1.** Die volgende artikel word hierby in die Wet op Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, 1969, na artikel 14 ingevoeg:

„Onteiing van grond. **14A.** (1) Ondanks andersluidende wetsbepalings, kan die Minister van Landbou op versoek van die raad en in oorleg met die Minister, grond wat kragtens hierdie Wet tot nasionale gedenkwaardigheid verklaar is of op die punt staan om aldus verklaar te word, ten bate van die raad onteien, mits die raad die Minister oortuig het dat hy bedoelde grond nie op redelike voorwaardes kan verkry nie.

(2) Die bepalings van die Onteiingswet, 1965 (Wet No. 55 van 1965), is *mutatis mutandis* ten opsigte van die onteiening van grond ingevolge sub-artikel (1) van toepassing.

(3) Indien die Minister van Landbou grond ten bate van die raad soos voormeld onteien, word die raad eienaar daarvan en word die onteieningskennisgewing van die Minister van Landbou geag 'n magtiging aan die betrokke registrator van aktes te wees om oordrag van bedoelde grond aan die raad te registreer.

(4) Alle koste wettiglik deur genoemde Ministers by die uitvoering van hul pligte ingevolge hierdie artikel aangegaan, word deur die raad aan hulle vergoed.”.

## NATIONAL MONUMENTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1970.

Act No. 22, 1970

# ACT

To amend the National Monuments Act, 1969, in order to provide  
for the expropriation of certain land.

(*English text signed by the State President.*)  
(Assented to 3rd March, 1970.)

**B**E IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. The following section is hereby inserted in the National Monuments Act, 1969, after section 14: Insertion of section 14A in Act 28 of 1969.

"Expropriation of land. **14A.** (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any law contained, the Minister of Agriculture may, at the request of the council, and in consultation with the Minister, expropriate for the benefit of the council any land declared or about to be declared under this Act to be a national monument, provided the council has satisfied the Minister that it is unable to acquire such land on reasonable terms.

(2) The provisions of the Expropriation Act, 1965 (Act No. 55 of 1965), shall *mutatis mutandis* apply in respect of the expropriation of any land in terms of subsection (1).

(3) If the Minister of Agriculture expropriates land as aforesaid for the benefit of the council, the council shall become the owner thereof and the expropriation notice of the Minister of Agriculture shall be deemed to authorize the registrar of deeds concerned to register the transfer of such land to the council.

(4) All costs lawfully incurred by the said Ministers in the execution of their duties in terms of this section, shall be refunded to them by the council.".

2. This Act shall be called the National Monuments Amendment Act, 1970. Short title.
