It is hereby notified that the State President has assented to the following Act which is hereby published for general information:—

No. 82 of 1972: Motor Carrier Transportation Amendment Act, 1972.

### ACT

To amend the Motor Carrier Transportation Act, 1930, so as to regulate the period of validity of motor carrier certificates and exemptions issued under the said Act and authorizing the conveyance of more than seven persons.

> (Afrikaans text signed by the State President.) (Assented to 14th June, 1972.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:-

1. Section 7 of the Motor Carrier Transportation Act, 1930, Amendment of is hereby amended-

by the substitution for subsection (3) of the following as amended by

subsection:

"(3) (a) The Board or a local board may issue a Act 31 of 1932, motor carrier certificate or exemption, other than section 6 of a certificate or exemption authorizing the conveyance of more than seven persons (including Act 44 of 1955, the driver), for an indefinite period or for such section 3 of fixed period as it may determine, and may in its Act 42 of 1959, discretion from time to time renew any motor section 2 of carrier certificate or exemption which has been Act 15 of 1966 carrier certificate or exemption which has been and section 2 of issued for a fixed period.

(b) The Board or a local board shall issue a motor carrier transport certificate or exemption authorizing the conveyance of more than seven persons (including the driver) for a period not exceeding twelve months, and may in its discretion from time to time renew any such certificate or exemp-

(c) Any such certificate or exemption, including a certificate or exemption issued prior to the commencement of this paragraph, shall, subject to the provisions of subsection (3)bis, not continue in force-

(i) if it is still in force on the thirtieth of June,

1972, after that date;

(ii) if the issue or renewal thereof comes into force on the thirtieth of June in any other year, after that date; or

(iii) in any other case, after the thirtieth of June immediately following on the date on which the issue or renewal thereof came into force.";

(b) by the substitution for the proviso to subsection (3)bis of the following proviso:

"Provided that no such certificate shall continue in force for a longer period than ninety days.".

2. This Act shall be called the Motor Carrier Transportation Short title. Amendment Act, 1972.
