

JUDGES' REMUNERATION AND PENSIONS

Act No. 54, 1974

ACT

To amend the Judges' Remuneration and Pensions Act, 1959,
to increase the salaries payable to judges.

(Afrikaans text signed by the State President.)
(Assented to 9 October 1974.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. The following Schedule is hereby substituted for the First Schedule to the Judges' Remuneration and Pensions Act, 1959:

2. This Act shall be called the Judges' Remuneration and Pensions Amendment Act, 1974, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 July 1974.

AN ACT TO REUNITE AND REORGANISE THE GOVERNMENT OF SOUTH AFRICA.

TCA

To unite the Transvaal Government and the Union of South Africa
to increase the efficiency of both.

(Commence first day of the month following)
(Commence 1st October 1928.)

THE FIRST ENACTED by the State Legislature, the Senate and the
House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as
follows:
