WETSONTWERP

Om voorsiening te maak vir die toepassing van die Wet op Reëling van Monopolistiese Toestande, 1955, in die gebied Suidwes-Afrika; en vir bykomstige aangeleenthede.

DAAR WORD BEPAAL deur die Staatspresident, die Senaat en die Volksraad van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, soos volg:—

Invoeging van artikel 9A in Wet 24 van 1955.

1. Die volgende artikel word hierby na artikel 9 van die Wet op Reëling van Monopolistiese Toestande, 1955, ingevoeg:

„Toepassing van Wet in van Wet in Suidwes-Afrika. 9A. Hierdie Wet en enige wysiging daarvan is ook van toepassing in die gebied Suidwes-Afrika, met inbegrip van die Oostelike Caprivi Zipfel.”

Kort titel.

2. Hierdie Wet heet die Wysigingswet op Reëling van Monopolistiese Toestande, 1976.

BILL

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. The following section is hereby inserted in the Regulation of Monopolistic Conditions Act, 1955, after section 9:

 9A. This Act and any amendment thereof shall apply also in the territory of South West Africa, including the Eastern Cape.
