WYSIGINGSWET OP BEDRYFSIEKTES IN MYNE EN BEDRYWE,  
1980**WET**

**Tot wysiging van die bepalings van die Wet op Bedryfsiektes in Myne en Bedrywe, 1973, ten einde voorsiening te maak vir die verdere verhoging van voordele en spesiale toekenning.**

**D**AAR WORD BEPAAL deur die Staatspresident, die Senaat en die Volksraad van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, soos volg:—

Verhoging van voordele en spesiale toekenning.

1. (1) Behoudens die bepalings van subartikel (2) word 'n voordeel soos omskryf in artikel 1, en 'n spesiale toekenning bedoel in artikel 101 of 115, van die Wet op Bedryfsiektes in Myne en Bedrywe, 1973 (Wet No. 78 van 1973) (hieronder die Hoofwet genoem), wat ingevolge die Hoofwet betaalbaar is maar nog nie betaal is nie, en wat by die Wysigingswet op Bedryfsiektes in Myne en Bedrywe, 1974 (Wet No. 67 van 1974), 10 die Wysigingswet op Bedryfsiektes in Myne en Bedrywe, 1975 (Wet No. 45 van 1975), die Wysigingswet op Bedryfsiektes in Myne en Bedrywe, 1977 (Wet No. 117 van 1977), en die Wysigingswet op Bedryfsiektes in Myne en Bedrywe, 1979 (Wet No. 83 van 1979), verhoog is, met ingang van 1 Julie 1980 verder 15 verhoog—

- (a) in die geval van so 'n voordeel, met tien persent;
- (b) in die geval van 'n spesiale toekenning bedoel in artikel 101 van die Hoofwet, met 'n bedrag wat die kommissaris na goeddunke kan bepaal, maar wat nie tien 20 persent van so 'n spesiale toekenning wat onmiddellik voor 1 Julie 1980 betaalbaar was, oorskry nie; en
- (c) in die geval van 'n spesiale toekenning bedoel in artikel 115 van die Hoofwet, met 'n bedrag wat die owerheid in daardie artikel vermeld na goeddunke kan bepaal 25 volgens die beskikbaarheid van geld in die Fonds in daardie artikel vermeld wat nie vir die betaling van voordele ingevolge die Hoofwet of hierdie Wet nodig is nie:

Met dien verstande dat so 'n voordeel of spesiale toekenning wat aldus verhoog is, tot die volgende volle rand bereken word.

(2) Die bepalings van hierdie artikel is nie van toepassing nie met betrekking tot 'n enkelbedragvoordeel, soos omskryf in artikel 1 van die Hoofwet, waarop iemand voor 1 Julie 1980 geregtig geword het.

OCCUPATIONAL DISEASES IN MINES AND WORKS  
AMENDMENT ACT, 1980

Act No. 83, 1980

**ACT**

**To amend the provisions of the Occupational Diseases in Mines and Works Act, 1973, so as to provide for the further increase of benefits and special awards.**

*(Afrikaans text signed by the State President.)  
(Assented to 12 June 1980.)*

**B**E IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. (1) Subject to the provisions of subsection (2), a benefit as defined in section 1, and a special award referred to in section 101 or 115, of the Occupational Diseases in Mines and Works Act, 1973 (Act No. 78 of 1973) (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), which are payable in terms of the principal Act but have not yet been paid, and which were increased by the Occupational Diseases in Mines and Works Amendment Act, 1974 (Act No. 67 of 1974), the Occupational Diseases in Mines and Works Amendment Act, 1975 (Act No. 45 of 1975), the Occupational Diseases in Mines and Works Amendment Act, 1977 (Act No. 117 of 1977), and the Occupational Diseases in Mines and Works Amendment Act, 1979 (Act No. 83 of 1979), shall be further increased with effect from 1 July 1980—

Increase of  
benefits and  
special awards.

- (a) in the case of any such benefit, by ten per cent;
- (b) in the case of a special award referred to in section 101 of the principal Act, by an amount which the commissioner may in his discretion determine, but not exceeding ten per cent of any such special award payable immediately prior to 1 July 1980; and
- (c) in the case of a special award referred to in section 115 of the principal Act, by an amount which the authority referred to in that section may in its discretion determine in accordance with the availability of moneys in the Fund referred to in that section not required for the payment of benefits under the principal Act or this Act:

Provided that any such benefit or special award so increased shall 30 be calculated to the next complete rand.

(2) The provisions of this section shall not apply with reference to any one-sum benefit, as defined in section 1 of the principal Act, to which a person became entitled before 1 July 1980.

2. This Act shall be called the Occupational Diseases in Mines Short title.
