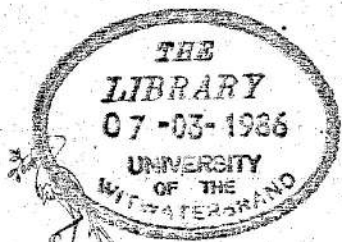

NATIONAL SECURITY SECOND AMENDMENT ACT, 1985

ACT

To amend the National Security Act, 1982.

(English text signed by the President. Assented to on 13 January 1986)

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Republic of Ciskei, as follows:—

*Substitution
of section 29
of Act 13 of 1982.*

1. The following section is hereby substituted for section 29 of the National Security Act, 1982:

*"Powers of
Attorney-
General in
regard to
bail.*

29. (1) Whenever any person is in custody in respect of any offence referred to in Schedule 2, the Attorney-General may, if he considers it necessary in the interest of the security of the State or the maintenance of law and order, issue an order that such person shall not be released on bail or otherwise before sentence has been passed or he has been discharged.
- (2) Notwithstanding anything in any other law contained but subject to the provisions of subsection (4), no person shall be released on bail or otherwise contrary to the terms of an order issued under subsection (1).
- (3) Whenever any person in custody in respect of an offence referred to in Schedule 2 applies to be released on bail or otherwise and the public prosecutor informs the court to which the application is made that the matter has been referred to the Attorney-General with a view to the issuing of an order under subsection (1), such person shall, pending the decision of the Attorney-General, not be released on bail or otherwise: Provided that, if no such order is issued within the period of fourteen days immediately following upon the date on which such court is so informed, such person may again apply to be released on bail or otherwise and may, subject to the provisions of any other law, be so released.
- (4) The Attorney-General may at any time before its expiration rescind any order issued in terms of subsection (1).
- (5) The Attorney-General may act in terms of subsection (1) without prior notice to, and without hearing, the person concerned."

Short title

2. This Act shall be called the National Security Second Amendment Act, 1985.
