ORDERS BY THE DIVISIONAL COMMISSIONER OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN POLICE FOR THE NORTHERN ORANGE FREE STATE DIVISION

In terms of the powers vested in me by regulation 7 (1) of the Regulations promulgated under the Public Safety Act, 1953 (Act 3 of 1953), by Proclamation R. 109 of 12 June 1986, I, Johan Swart, Divisional Commissioner of the South African Police for the Northern Orange Free State Division, hereby issue with reference to the areas as set out in Schedule A in the Magisterial Districts of Welkom, Theunissen, Bothaville, Bultfontein, Odendaalsrus, Viljoenskroon, Kroonstad, Heilbron, Koppies, Parys and Sasolburg, the orders set out in Schedule B.

Beheer oor skoolboikotte

1. (1) Geen ingeskrewe leerling van enige skool in 'n gebied in Bylae A vermeld, mag op enige skooldag waarop hy hom op die skoolterrein van daardie skool bevind gedurende die ure waartydens normaalweg aan daardie skool onderrig verleen word, buite 'n klaskamer van die skool wees nie, behalwe gedurende 'n voorgeskrewe pouse, of gedurende die tydperk vandat hy die skoolterrein betree totdat met die skoolprogram 'n aanvang geneem word, of behalwe vir die doel om 'n kleedkamer te besoek of van klasse te verwissel.
- (2) Geen ingeskrewe leerling van enige skool in 'n gebied in Bylae A vermeld mag op enige skooldag waarop hy hom op die skoolterrein van die betrokke skool bevind, aan enige aktiwiteite deelneem wat nie onder die toesig van 'n personeellid van sodanige skool staan nie en wat nie direkte verband hou met sy skoolonderrig aan die skool nie.
- (3) Behoudens die bepalinge van paragraaf (1) mag geen leerling op enige skooldag gedurende die ure waartydens normaalweg onderrig verleen word aan 'n skool in 'n gebied in Bylae A vermeld, waar hy as leerling ingeskryf is, buite die grense van 'n perseel wat normaalweg gebruik word as woonplek vir mense, wees nie: Met dien verstande dat die bepalinge van hierdie paragraaf nie van toepassing is nie ten opsigte van 'n leerling wat onderweg is na of van die skool waar hy as leerling ingeskryf is.
- (4) Geen persoon wat nie 'n leerling is van, of wat nie in diens is by 'n skool in 'n gebied in Bylae A vermeld nie, mag te eniger tyd die perseel of geboue van daardie skool betree of daarop of daarin aanwesig wees nie.
- (5) 'n Lid van 'n Mag kan te eniger tyd ten opsigte van 'n bepaalde persoon, skool of geval skriftelik vrystelling van enige van die bogenoemde bevele verleen.

Beheer oor nie-inwoners van 'n gebied

2. Geen persoon wat nie in 'n gebied soos omskryf in Bylae A woonagtig is nie of tot bevrediging van 'n lid van 'n Mag kan bewys dat hy aldus woonagtig is nie, mag so 'n gebied binnegaan of daarbinne bly nie sonder

SCHEDULE B

Orders

Control of school boycotts

1. (1) No registered pupil in any school in an area mentioned in Schedule A shall on any school day whilst being on the school premises during the hours during which tuition is normally given, be outside a classroom of such school, unless it is during a prescribed break, or during the period from entering the school premises until the commencement of the school programme, or except for the purpose of visiting the dressing room or to change classes.
- (2) No registered pupil of any school in an area mentioned in Schedule A shall on any school day, whilst being on the premises of such a school, partake in any activities which are not supervised or ordered by a member of the personnel of such a school, and which do not have direct bearing on his tuition at such a school.
- (3) Subject to the provision of paragraph (1), no pupil shall on any school day during the hours during which tuition is normally given at the school where he is registered as a pupil, in an area mentioned in Schedule A be outside the boundaries of premises normally used for human habitation: Provided that the provisions of this paragraph are not applicable to a pupil en route to or from the school where he is registered as a pupil.
- (4) No person who is not a pupil at, or is not employed at a school in an area mentioned in Schedule A, shall at any time enter upon or be on the premises or in the buildings of such a school.
- (5) A member of a Force may at any time, with regard to a certain person, school or matter, grant written exemption from any of the abovenamed orders.

Control over non-residents of an area

2. No person who is not resident in an area as described in Schedule A, or who cannot prove to the satisfaction of a member of a Force that he is so resident, may enter or

4. Geen persoon mag—
 - (a) enige toestel waarmee 'n klip of enige ander projektiel gewerp kan word;
 - (b) enige nagmaakte vuurwapen of enige ander voorwerp wat 'n afbeelding is van of lyk na 'n vuurwapen, handgranaat of ander ploftoestel; of
 - (c) enige uniform, uniformstuk, T-hemp, vlag, banier of wimpel waarop die naam, wapen of embleem van enige organisasie genoem in Bylae C uitgebeeld word,
 in sy besit hê nie.

Voorwaardes ten opsigte van sekere begrafnisse in die gebiede vermeld in Bylae B

5. Enige begrafnisseremonie, met inbegrip van enige roudiens, gedenkdiens, begrafnisstoet of teraardebestelling, ten opsigte van enige persoon wat oënskynlik aan onnatuurlike oorsake gesterf het, wat gehou word in 'n gebied in Bylae B vermeld, vind plaas onderhewig aan die volgende beperkings:
 - (1) Geen sodanige begrafnisseremonie mag gedurende naweke of openbare vakansiedae gehou word nie.
 - (2) Geen roudiens of gedenkdiens wat verband hou met 'n begrafnis van 'n oorledene soos hierbo bedoel, word in die opelug gehou nie.
 - (3) Slegs 'n geordende leraar van 'n godsdienstige denominasie of organisasie mag as spreker tydens enige verrigtinge by so 'n begrafnisseremonie optree.
 - (4) Die begrafnisgangers wat sodanige begrafnis bywoon, moet per voertuig vanaf die plek waar die roudiens of gedenkdiens plaasgevind het na die plek waar die oorledene teraardebestel word, beweeg en wel langs 'n roete wat die gemelde Afdelingskommissaris van die Suid-Afrikaanse Polisie bepaal.
 - (5) Geen vlage, baniere, plakkaat, pamflette of aanplakbiljette mag by of tydens sodanige begrafnisseremonie vertoon of versprei word nie.
 - (6) Geen luidsprekerstelsel mag by of tydens sodanige begrafnisseremonie gebruik word nie.
 - (7) Sodanige begrafnisseremonie word nie met betrekking tot meer as een oorledene gehou nie en geen sodanige seremonie word bygewoon deur meer as 200 persone nie.
 - (8) Geen sodanige begrafnisseremonie mag langer as vier uur duur nie.
 - (9) Die gemelde Afdelingskommissaris van die Suid-Afrikaanse Polisie kan, op skriftelike aansoek en onderworpe aan die voorwaardes, as daar is, wat hy goedvind, vrystelling van enige of al die bogenoemde beperkings verleen.

be in such area without the written permission of a member of a Force and subject to such conditions as such a member may deem necessary or expedient and specify in such written permission.

Prohibition on the movement of persons

3. No person shall from 22h00 (10 p.m.) of any day to 04h00 (4 a.m.) of the following day be in any street or other public place in the areas mentioned, except with the prior written permission of a member of a Force and subject to such conditions, as such a member may deem necessary or expedient and specify in such written permission.

Prohibition on possession of certain articles or objects

4. No person shall be in possession of—
 - (a) any device with which a stone or any other projectile can be cast;
 - (b) any simulated fire-arm or any other object which is a copy of or which resembles any fire-arm, hand-grenade or other explosive device;
 - (c) any uniform, part of a uniform, T-shirt, flag, banner or pennant on which the name, badge or emblem of any organisation mentioned in Schedule C is depicted.

Conditions in respect of certain funeral ceremonies in the areas mentioned in Schedule B

5. Any funeral ceremony, including any memorial service, commemorative service, funeral procession or burial in respect of any person who has apparently died as a result of unnatural causes, which is being held in an area mentioned in Schedule B, shall be held subject to the following restrictions:
 - (1) No such funeral ceremonies may take place during weekends or on public holidays.
 - (2) No memorial or commemorative service in connection with a funeral of a deceased person referred to above, shall be held out of doors.
 - (3) Only an ordained minister of a religious denomination or organization may act as a speaker during any proceedings at any such funeral ceremony.
 - (4) Persons attending such funeral shall only travel by vehicle from the place where the memorial or commemorative service has taken place to the place where the deceased is to be buried, and along a route determined by the mentioned Divisional Commissioner of the South African Police.
 - (5) No flags, banners, placards, pamphlets, or posters shall be displayed or distributed at or during such funeral ceremony.
 - (6) No public address system shall be used at or during such funeral ceremony.
 - (7) A particular funeral ceremony shall not be held with regard to more than one such deceased person and no such ceremony shall be attended by more than 200 persons.
 - (8) A particular funeral ceremony of such a deceased person shall not last for more than four hours.
 - (9) The said Divisional Commissioner of the South African Police may, on written application and subject to such conditions, if any, as he may deem fit, grant exemption from any or all of the above-mentioned restrictions.

- (4) Persons attending such funeral shall only travel by vehicle from the place where the memorial or commemorative service has taken place to the place where the deceased is to be buried, and along a route determined by the mentioned Divisional Commissioner of the South African Police.
- (5) No flags, banners, placards, pamphlets, or posters shall be displayed or distributed at or during such funeral ceremony.
- (6) No public address system shall be used at or during such funeral ceremony.
- (7) A particular funeral ceremony shall not be held with regard to more than one such deceased person and no such ceremony shall be attended by more than 200 persons.
- (8) A particular funeral ceremony of such a deceased person shall not last for more than four hours.
2. The said Divisional Commissioner of the South African Police may, on written application and subject to such conditions, if any, as he may deem fit, grant exemption from any or all of the above-mentioned restrictions.
