# ACT

To appropriate an additional sum of money for the requirements of the Department of Posts and Telecommunications in respect of the financial year ending 31 March 1989.

(Assented to 27 February 1989.)*

**B**E IT ENACTED by the State President and the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

## **Appropriation of additional moneys for requirements of Department**

1. Subject to the provisions of the Post Office Act, 1958 (Act No. 44 of 1958), there is hereby appropriated, as a charge to the Post Office Fund, for the requirements of the Department of Posts and Telecommunications in respect of the financial year ending 31 March 1989, an additional amount of R198 386 000 as more particularly specified in the Estimates of Additional Expenditure of that department for the said financial year, as submitted to and approved by Parliament. 5

## **Restriction on utilization of savings**

10

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 12F (3) and (4) of the Post Office Act, 1958 (Act No. 44 of 1958), no saving on an amount appropriated by this Act for any purpose may be utilized, otherwise than in accordance with an authority granted under section 12F (5) (a) of the said Act, for defraying excess expenditure on any amount appropriated by the Post Office Appropriation Act, 1988 (Act No. 34 of 1988), for any purpose mentioned in section 3 of the latter Act. 15

## **Short title**

3. This Act shall be called the Additional Post Office Appropriation Act, 1989.

## **Bewilliging van addisionele geld vir behoeftes van Departement**

1. Behoudens die bepalings van die Poswet, 1958 (Wet No. 44 van 1958), word 5 daar hierby bewillig, ten laste van die Poskantoorfonds, 'n addisionele bedrag van R198 386 000 vir die behoeftes van die Departement van Pos- en Telekommunikasiewese ten opsigte van die boekjaar wat op 31 Maart 1989 eindig, soos nader uiteengesit in die Begroting van Addisionele Uitgawe van daardie departement vir genoemde boekjaar, soos aan die Parlement voorgelê en deur hom goedgekeur.

## **10 Beperking op aanwending van besparings**

2. Ondanks die bepalings van artikel 12F (3) en (4) van die Poswet, 1958 (Wet No. 44 van 1958), mag geen besparing op 'n bedrag wat by hierdie Wet vir die een of ander doel bewillig is, anders as ooreenkomstig 'n magtiging kragtens artikel 12F (5) (a) van genoemde Wet verleen, aangewend word vir die bestryding van ooruitgawe 15 op 'n bedrag wat by die Poskantoorbegrotingswet, 1988 (Wet No. 34 van 1988), vir 'n doel in artikel 3 van laasgenoemde Wet vermeld, bewillig is nie.
