WET

Tot wysiging van die Wysigingswet op Padverkeer, 1991, ten einde die inwerking-tredingsdatum van die bepalings met betrekking tot die verpligte hou en voorlegging van bestuurderslisensies in sekere omstandighede te skrap; en om voorsiening te maak vir aangeleenthede wat daarmee in verband staan.

DAAR WORD BEPAAL deur die Staatspresident en die Parlement van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, soos volg:—

Wysiging van artikel 30 van Wet 73 van 1991

1. Artikel 30 van die Wysigingswet op Padverkeer, 1991, word hierby gewysig—
 - (a) deur subartikel (1) deur die volgende subartikel te vervang: 5

“(1) Hierdie Wet heet die Wysigingswet op Padverkeer, 1991, en tree **[, behoudens subartikel (4),]** in werking op ’n datum wat die Staatspresident by proklamasie in die *Staatskoerant* bepaal.”; en
 - (b) deur subartikel (4) te skrap.

2. Hierdie Wet heet die Wysigingswet op Padverkeer, 1992, en tree in werking op ’n datum wat die Staatspresident by proklamasie in die *Staatskoerant* bepaal, welke datum nie later as 1 Januarie 1993 moet wees nie.

ACT

To amend the Road Traffic Amendment Act, 1991, so as to delete the commencement date of the provisions relating to the compulsory keeping and producing of drivers' licences in certain circumstances; and to provide for matters in connection therewith.

BE IT ENACTED by the State President and the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Amendment of section 30 of Act 73 of 1991

1. Section 30 of the Road Traffic Amendment Act, 1991, is hereby amended—
- 5 (a) by the substitution for subsection (1) of the following subsection:
- “(1) This Act shall be called the Road Traffic Amendment Act, 1991, and shall **[, subject to subsection (4),]** come into operation on a date fixed by the State President by proclamation in the *Gazette*.”; and
- 10 (b) by the deletion of subsection (4).

Short title and commencement

2. This Act shall be called the Road Traffic Amendment Act, 1992, and shall come into operation on a date fixed by the State President by proclamation in the *Gazette*, which date shall not be later than 1 January 1993.

ACT

B E IT ENACTED by the State President and the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Amendment of section 30 of Act 73 of 1991

“(1) This Act shall be called the Road Traffic Amendment Act, 1991, and shall, subject to subsection (4), come into operation on a date fixed by the State President by proclamation in the Gazette;” and
 - (b) by the deletion of subsection (4).

Short title and commencement

2. This Act shall be called the Road Traffic Amendment Act, 1992, and shall come into operation on a date fixed by the State President by proclamation in the Gazette, which date shall not be later than 1 January 1993.
