**WET**

**Tot wysiging van die Polisiewet, 1958, ten einde lede van die Reserwepolisiemag slegs terwyl hulle in die Mag dien, te verbied om deel te neem aan bedrywighede van politieke partye of enige ander bewegings, organisasies, liggome of verenigings met politieke oogmerke, en om 'n lid van die Parlement te verbied om in die Mag diens te verrig as 'n lid van die Reserwepolisiemag of Polisiereserve; en om voorsiening te maak vir aangeleenthede wat daarmee in verband staan.**

**D**AAR WORD BEPAAL deur die Staatspresident en die Parlement van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, soos volg:—

**Wysiging van artikel 35 van Wet 7 van 1958, soos ingevoeg deur artikel 2 van Wet 55 van 1991**

**1. Artikel 35 van die Polisiewet, 1958, word hierby gewysig deur subartikel (1) deur die volgende subartikel te vervang:** 5

"(1) (a) Geen lid van die Mag, [inclusyf] uitgesonderd 'n lid [van die Reserwepolisiemag het sy terwyl hy in die Mag dien of nie, maar nie ook 'n lid] bedoel in paragraaf (b) [nie], mag 'n lid wees van of deelneem aan die bedrywighede van 'n politieke party (het sy geregistreer of nie) of enige ander beweging, organisasie, liggam of vereniging met politieke oogmerke, of hom verkiesbaar stel as lid van, of dien op, 'n instelling, raad of liggam bedoel in artikel 84(1)(f) van die Wet op Provinciale Bestuur, 1961 (Wet No. 32 van 1961) (in hierdie artikel 'n plaaslike bestuur genoem), nie. 10

(b) Geen lid van die Reserwepolisiemag of Polisiereserve mag, terwyl hy in die Mag [dien] diens verrig, deelneem aan die bedrywighede van so 'n politieke party of enige ander beweging, organisasie, liggam of vereniging met politieke oogmerke, of terwyl hy 'n lid van die Parlement is in die Mag diens verrig nie." 15

**2. Hierdie Wet heet die Tweede Polisiewysigingswet, 1992, en tree in werking op 'n datum wat die Staatspresident by proklamasie in die *Staatskoerant* bepaal.**

**ACT**

**To amend the Police Act, 1958, so as to prohibit members of the Reserve Police Force, only while serving in the Force, to take part in the activities of political parties or any other movements, organizations, bodies or associations with political objects, and to prohibit a member of Parliament from performing service in the Force as a member of the Reserve Police Force or Police Reserve; and to provide for matters connected therewith.**

**B**E IT ENACTED by the State President and the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

**Amendment of section 35 of Act 7 of 1958, as inserted by section 2 of Act 55 of 1991**

5    1. Section 35 of the Police Act, 1958, is hereby amended by the substitution for subsection (1) of the following subsection:

10    “(1) (a) No member of the Force, **[including]** excluding a member **[of the Reserve Police Force whether or not while serving in the Force, but excluding a member]** referred to in paragraph (b), may be a member of or take part in the activities of a political party (whether or not it is registered) or any other movement, organization, body or association with political objects, or stand for election as a member of, or serve on, an institution, council or body referred to in section 84(1)(f) of the Provincial Government Act, 1961 (Act No. 32 of 1961) (in this section referred to as a local authority).

15    (b) No member of the **Reserve Police Force or Police Reserve** may, while **[serving]** performing service in the Force, take part in the activities of such political party or any other movement, organization, body or association with political objects, **or while he is a member of Parliament perform service in the Force.”.**

20 **Short title and commencement**

2. This Act shall be called the Police Second Amendment Act, 1992, and shall come into operation on a date fixed by the State President by proclamation in the *Gazette*.
