MINIMUM MARKET ACCESS: PROCEDURES FOR THE APPLICATION, ADMINISTRATION AND ALLOCATION OF PERMITS

In order to fulfil South Africa's commitment under the World Trade Organisation; Marrakesh Agreement, regarding minimum market access, rebate permits will be issued for the access quantities and at the reduced levels of duty as specified in the table below. Permits will be issued only to importers in South Africa for imporation into the Republic.

When applications for rebate permits are submitted the following details must be provided:

- (I) Name and address of firm and individual.
- (II) Tariff heading and product.
- (III) Quantity.
- (IV) Purpose of importation.
- (V) Country of origin.
- (VI) Telephone and fax number.

The applications must be addressed to the Director-General: Agriculture, Private Bag X250, PRETORIA, 0001, Attention: Mr Deon Kamfer, Deputy Director: Marketing Administration.

The Department awaits applications for rebate permits as follows:

- (a) For permits issued on a quarterly basis, applications must be submitted as follows:
 - ▶ 2–31 December 1996—for the first quarter of the quota-valid for importation during the period January to April 1997.
 - ▶ 3-31 March 1997—for the second quarter of the quota-valid for importation during the period April to July 1997.
 - 2-30 June—for the third quarter of the quota-valid for importation during the period July to October 1997.
 - ► 1–30 September 1997—for the last quarter of the quota-valid for importation during the period October to January 1998.

- (b) For permits issued on an annual basis applications must be submitted by 31 December 1996.
- (c) For tobacco permits applications must be submitted during the period 17 February to 14 March 1997.

It is important to note that any application delivered by hand or faxed will only be accepted during the Department's official hours, that is, 07:30 to 16:00
