I, Derek André Hanekom, Minister of Land Affairs, under the powers vested in me by sections 2 (1) (c) and 2 (3) of the Provision of Land and Assistance Act, 1993 (Act No. 126 of 1993), hereby designate for the purposes of settlement:

1. Subdivision 41 (of 28) of the farm Chantilly 1804; and

2. A certain unregistered portion of land, indicated on a plan available for inspection at the Provincial Office of the Department of Land Affairs at Pietermaritzburg, consisting of—
 an approximate 4,3 ha parcel of Subdivision 78 of the farm Chantilly 1804;
 an approximate 4,4 ha parcel of Subdivision 79 of the farm Chantilly 1804; and
 an approximate 3,3 ha parcel of Subdivision 80 of the farm Chantilly 1804,

situated in the District of Lower Tugela, Province of KwaZulu-Natal and impose the following conditions for the use of the land so designated:

- (i) The Inqaba Community Trust (registration number IT1844/98) (hereinafter called the "Trust") must hold the land for the benefit of 100 beneficiary households.
- (ii) Densification beyond the 100 beneficiary household units must not take place. No further sites will be allocated to any person, family or household unit outside the beneficiary community without the permission of the Ilembe Regional Council. If a need for further densification should arise in future, additional land needs to be identified and purchased by the Trust.
- (iii) No settlement must occur before the planning of the settlement has been completed. Settlement must take place in a phased and orderly manner and in accordance with the conditions and parameters established by the Trust and the Ilembe Regional Council.
- (iv) The Conservation of Agricultural Resources Act, 1983 (Act No. 43 of 1983), will apply to the utilisation of the land.
- (v) Grazing rights for present cattle stock of the beneficiary community must be negotiated with neighbouring landowners.
- (vi) The conditions of the Water Act, 1956 (Act No. 54 of 1956), will apply in order to prevent the pollution of public water, especially that of the Nonoti River.
- (vii) The level of service infrastructure to be constructed will be determined by the Ilembe Regional Council in consultation with the Trust and neighbouring landowners, taking financial constraints into account.
- (viii) The Ilembe Regional Council, in consultation with the Trust, shall determine appropriate conditions and regulations for settlement in relation to—
 the KwaZulu-Natal Planning and Development Act, No. 5 of 1998; and
 relevant municipal bylaws.

Ek, Derek André Hanekom, Minister van Grondsake, kragtens die bevoegdhede aan my verleen by artikels 2 (1) (c) en 2 (3) van die Wet op die Beskikbaarstelling van Grond en Bystand, 1993 (Wet No. 126 van 1993), wys hierby—

1. Onderverdeling 41 (van 28) van die plaas Chantilly 1804; en
2. 'n Sekere ongeregistreerde stuk grond, aangedui op 'n plan wat beskikbaar is vir inspeksie by die Proviniale Kantoor van die Departement van Grondsake te Pietermaritzburg, bestaande uit:
 'n gedeelte van ongeveer 4,3 ha van Onderverdeling 78 van die plaas Chantilly 1804;
 'n gedeelte van ongeveer 4,4 ha van Onderverdeling 79 van die plaas Chantilly 1804; en
 'n gedeelte van ongeveer 3,3 ha van Onderverdeling 80 van die plaas Chantilly 1804,

geleë in die distrik Laer Tugela, provinsie KwaZulu-Natal, vir die doeleindes van vestiging aan en lê hierby die volgende voorwaardes vir die gebruik van die aangewese grond op:

- (i) Die Inqaba Community Trust (registrasienummer IT1844/98) (hierna die "Trust" genoem), moet die grond tot voordeel van 100 bevoordeelde huishoudings hou.
- (ii) Verdigtig bo en behalwe die 100 bevoordeelde huishoudings mag nie toegelaat word nie. Geen verdere erwe mag aan enige persoon, familie of huishouding buite die geïdentifiseerde bevoordeelde gemeenskap sonder die toestemming van die Ilembe Streeksraad toegeken word nie. Indien 'n behoefté aan verdere verdigtig in die toekoms ontstaan, moet bykomende grond deur die Trust geïdentifiseer en aangekoop word.

- (iii) Geen vestiging mag plaasvind alvorens die beplanning van die nedersetting voltooi is nie. Vestiging moet in fases en in 'n geordende wyse plaasvind, asook in ooreenstemming met die voorwaardes en bepalings soos deur die Trust en die iLembe Streeksraad neergelê.
- (iv) Die Wet op die Bewaring van Landbouhulpbronne, 1983 (Wet No. 43 van 1983), is op die benutting van die grond van toepassing.
- (v) Weidingsregte vir die huidige beeskudde van die bevoordeelde gemeenskap moet met aanliggende eienaars onderhandel word.
- (vi) Die bepalings van die Waterwet, 1956 (Wet No. 54 van 1956) sal van toepassing wees om die besoedeling van openbare water, veral die van die Nonotirivier, te voorkom.
- (vii) Die vlak van infrastruktuur wat aangelê moet word vir die voorsiening van basiese dienste moet deur die iLembe Streeksraad bepaal word, in oorleg met die Trust en aanliggende eienaars, finansiële beperkinge inaggenome.
- (viii) Die iLembe Streeksraad, in oorleg met die Trust, moet toepaslike voorwaardes en regulasies vir vestiging neerlê, met spesiale verwysing na die volgende—
die KwaZulu-Natal Beplanning en Ontwikkelingswet, 1998 (Wet No. 5 van 1998); en
toepaslike munisipale wette.

SCHEDULE ON PROPOSED GENERAL AUTHORISATIONS

1. TAKING OF WATER FROM A WATER RESOURCE AND STORAGE OF WATER

[Sections 21(a) and (b)]

Purpose of this authorisation

1.1. The authorisation permitted in terms of this Schedule replaces the need for a water user to apply for a licence in terms of the National Water Act for the abstraction or storage of water from a water resource provided that the abstraction or storage is within the limits and conditions set out in this authorisation.

Exclusion

1.2.(1) This authorisation does not:-

- (a) apply to any water use taken under Schedule 1;
- (b) replace any existing authorisation that is recognised under the National Water Act;
- (c) apply to any determination as regards abstraction and storage in respect of a government water control area, a government water work, a catchment control area or an irrigation district as defined in the Water Act, 1956 (Act No 54 of 1956);
- (d) apply to any person who does not have lawful access to any waterwork or water resource; or
- (e) apply to wetlands.

(2) In the case of abstraction of water for industrial purposes the provision of section 7 of the Water Services Act, 1997 (Act No 108 of 1997) must be met.

Compliance with National Water Act and other laws

1.3.(1) This authorisation does not exempt a person who uses water from compliance with any provision of the National Water Act, unless stated otherwise or any other applicable law, regulation, ordinance or by-law.

(2) A person who uses water in terms of this authorisation is exempt from compliance with section 22(2)(e) of the National Water Act.

Area of applicability

1.4 This authorisation is applicable throughout the Republic of South Africa, except for the areas set out in:-

- (a) Table 1.1 and illustrated in Map 1, for surface water abstraction; and
- (b) Table 1.2 and illustrated in Map 2, for groundwater abstraction.

Duration of authorisation

1.5. This authorisation will be for a period of 5 years from 1 April 1999 unless:

- (a) amended or withdrawn;
- (b) the time period is extended by a further notice in the Gazette; or

- (c) the water user is instructed to apply for a licence in terms of sections 41 or 43 of the National Water Act and a licence is issued thereunder.

Definitions

1.6. In this authorisation unless the context indicates otherwise, any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in terms of the National Water Act shall have that meaning, and:-

- (i) "**abstraction**" means taking water from a water resource;
- (ii) "**high flow**" means the surplus flow that occurs during the rainy season when the river level rises to approximately 75% or more of the height of its banks;
- (iii) "**monitoring programme**" means a programme for taking regular measurements of the quantity and/or quality of a water resource, waste or wastewater discharge, at specified intervals, and at specified locations, for determining the chemical, physical and biological nature of the water resource, waste or wastewater discharge; and
- (iv) "**storage**" means storing water, not containing waste, in a watercourse or off-channel storage.

Abstraction and storage

1.7.(1) A person who owns property registered in the Deeds Office or lawfully occupies property or land outside the areas set out in Table 1.1 and Table 1.2 may on that property or land:-

- (a) abstract groundwater as set out in Table 1.3 and indicated on Map 2;
- (b) abstract surface water at a rate of up to 25 litres per second:-
 - (i) for irrigation of up to 25 hectares of land, at 5 000 cubic metres per hectare per annum; or
 - (ii) for purposes other than irrigation of up to 100 cubic metres on any given day;
- (c) abstract surface water at a rate of up to 110 litres per second under high flow conditions from the:-
 - (i) Sand River and all its tributaries up to the confluence with the Kruis River;
 - (ii) Kruis River and all its tributaries; and
 - (iii) Riet River and all its tributaries upstream of the Hydrological Gauging Weir E2M08;
- (d) abstract surface water at a rate of up to 140 litres per second under high flow conditions from the Breede River downstream of the Zanddrift Weir; and
- (e) store up to 50 000 cubic metres of water in a single dam.

Registration of water use

1.8.(1) A person who uses water in terms of this authorisation must submit an application form obtainable from the Responsible Authority for registration of the water use before commencement of:-

- (a) abstracting or storing of water for irrigation purposes; or
- (b) abstracting more than 50 cubic metres from surface water or 10 cubic metres from groundwater on any given day, or storing more than 10 000 cubic metres of water, for purposes other than irrigation.

(2) On receipt of the application form by the Responsible Authority the person will be regarded as a registered water user.

Precautionary practices

1.9.(1) The registered user must ensure that any dam complies with section 120 of the National Water Act if the dam is classified as a dam with a safety risk under section 118 of the aforementioned Act.

(2) The registered user must follow acceptable construction, maintenance and operational practices to ensure the consistent, effective and safe performance of the abstraction and storage of water.

(3) Where water is stored in a watercourse, the registered user must take all reasonable measures to ensure the movement of aquatic species is not prevented, including those species which normally migrate through the watercourse.

Monitoring requirements

1.10.(1) The registered user must ensure the establishment of monitoring programmes for monitoring the quantity of water abstracted and/or stored prior to commencement of the abstraction and/or storage, as follows:-

(a) the quantity of groundwater or surface water abstracted must be:-

(i) metered and the total recorded monthly; or

(ii) gauged where no meter is used, and the total recorded weekly; and

(b) the quantity of water stored must be recorded monthly.

(2) Where it is deemed necessary, or upon the written request of the Responsible Authority, the registered user must ensure the establishment of any additional monitoring programmes.

(3) Upon the written request of the Responsible Authority the registered user must appoint an external auditor to assess the water use in terms of this General Authorisation, and to submit the findings to the Responsible Authority for evaluation.

Record keeping and disclosure of information

1.11. The registered user must keep a record of all taking and storage of surface or groundwater, which information must be made available upon request to the Responsible Authority.

Inspections

1.12. Any property or land in respect of which a water use has been authorised in terms of this Notice must be made available for inspection by an authorised person in terms of section 125 of the National Water Act.

Offence

1.13. Any person who contravenes any provision of this authorisation is guilty of an offence and is subject to the penalty set out in section 151(2) of the National Water Act.

THROUGH ANY INDUSTRIAL ACTIVITY OR BY A WATERWORK**

[Section 21(e)]

Purpose of this authorisation

2.1. The authorisation permitted in terms of this Schedule replaces the need for a water user to apply for a licence in terms of the National Water Act provided that the irrigation is within the limits and conditions set out in this authorisation.

Exclusion

2.2. This authorisation does not:-

- (a) replace any existing authorisation that is recognised under the National Water Act; or
- (b) apply to a person who is not the owner or lawful occupier of the land on which the wastewater irrigation takes place.

Compliance with National Water Act and other laws

2.3.(1) This authorisation does not exempt a person who uses water from compliance with any provision of the National Water Act unless stated otherwise, or any other applicable law, regulation, ordinance or by-law.

(2) A person who uses water in terms of this authorisation is exempt from compliance with section 22(2)(e) of the National Water Act.

Area of applicability

2.4 This authorisation is applicable throughout the Republic of South Africa, except for any subterranean government water control area as defined in the Water Act, 1956 (Act No 54 of 1956) and set out in Table 2.1 and illustrated in Map 2.

Duration of authorisation

2.5. This authorisation will be applicable for a time period of 3 years from 1 April 1999 unless:

- (a) amended or withdrawn;
- (b) the time period is extended by a further notice in the Gazette; or
- (c) the water user is instructed to apply for a license in terms of sections 41 or 43 of the National Water Act and a licence is issued thereunder.

Definitions

2.6. In this authorisation, unless the context indicates otherwise, any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in terms of the National Water Act shall have that meaning, and:-

- (i) "**biodegradable Industrial wastewater**" means wastewater that contains a high concentration of organic waste arising from industrial activities and premises including:
 - (a) milk processing;
 - (b) manufacture of fruit and vegetable products;
 - (c) sugar mills;
 - (d) manufacture and bottling of soft drinks;
 - (e) water bottling;
 - (f) production of alcohol and alcoholic beverages in breweries, wineries or malt houses;
 - (g) manufacture of animal feed from plant or animal products;
 - (h) manufacture of gelatine and of glue from hides, skin and bones;
 - (i) abattoirs;
 - (j) fish processing; and
 - (k) feedlots.
- (ii) "**commercial activity**" means those activities identified in the Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (5th Edition), published by Central Statistics Service, 1993, as amended and supplemented, under the following categories:-
 - a) 6: wholesale and retail trade,
 - b) 7: transport, storage and communication,
 - c) 8: business services,
 - d) 9: community services,
 - e) 0: personal and other services.
- (iii) "**domestic wastewater discharge**" means a wastewater discharge consisting of approximately 90% or more wastewater, by volume, arising from domestic and commercial activities and premises, that is collected and treated, and subsequently disposed of;
- (iv) "**major aquifer**" means a highly permeable geological formation, which contains groundwater that is potentially available for abstraction and use. Identification of a major aquifer will be provided by the Responsible Authority upon request;
- (v) "**monitoring programme**" means a programme for taking regular measurements of the quantity and/or quality of a water resource, waste or wastewater discharge, at specified intervals, and at specified locations, for determining the chemical, physical and biological nature of the water

resource, waste or wastewater discharge;

- (vi) "**organic waste**" means waste of non-anthropogenic origin that is readily biodegradable in the environment and does not contain any substances that may accumulate in the environment;
- (vii) "**primary treatment**" means treatment of wastewater by a physical process, which may involve maceration, sedimentation, screening and grit removal;
- (viii) "**secondary treatment**" means treatment of wastewater by a biological process, through solar and other energy, bacteria, algae and a variety of aquatic biota to remove organic matter;
- (ix) "**wastewater**" means water containing waste, or water that has been in contact with waste material;
- (x) "**wastewater limit value**" means the mass, expressed in terms of the concentration and/or level of a substance, which may not be exceeded, at any time. Wastewater Limit Values shall apply at the last point where the discharge of wastewater enters into a water resource, dilution being disregarded when determining compliance with the Wastewater Limit Values. Where discharge of wastewater does not directly enter a water resource, the Wastewater Limit Values shall apply at the last point where the wastewater leaves the premises of collection and treatment;
- (xi) "**wastewater pond system**" means a dam or system of dams designed to collect wastewater, conduct primary and secondary treatment, and from which treated wastewater is disposed of.

Irrigation with wastewater

2.7.(1) A person who owns property registered in the Deeds Office or lawfully occupies property or land outside the areas set out in Table 2.1 may on that property or land irrigate with up to 1 000 cubic meters of domestic or biodegradable industrial wastewater on any given day, if the:-

- (a) Electrical conductivity does not exceed 200 millisiemens per meter (mS/m);
- (b) pH is not less than 6 or more than 9 pH units;
- (c) Chemical Oxygen Demand (COD) does not exceed 5 000 mg/l for wastewater from wineries;
- (d) Chemical Oxygen Demand (COD) does not exceed 200 mg/l for wastewater other than from wineries;
- (e) for biodegradable industrial wastewater the Sodium Adsorption Ratio (SAR) does not exceed 7; and
- (f) for domestic wastewater the faecal coliforms do not exceed 1 000 per 100 ml.

Registration of irrigation with wastewater

2.8.(1) A person who irrigates with wastewater in terms of this authorisation must submit an application form obtainable from the Responsible Authority for registration of the water use before commencement of irrigation if more than 50 cubic metres of wastewater are irrigated on any given day.

(2) On receipt of the application form by the Responsible Authority the person will be regarded as a registered water user.

Location of irrigation with wastewater

2.9. Wastewater irrigation in terms of this authorisation is only permitted if:-

- (a) the irrigation takes place above the 100 year flood line, or alternatively, more than 100 metres from a water resource or a borehole which is utilised for drinking water or stock watering; and

- (b) on land that is not or does not overlie a Major Aquifer.

Monitoring requirements

2.10.(1) The registered user must ensure the establishment of monitoring programmes for monitoring the quantity and quality of the wastewater to be irrigated prior to commencement of irrigation, as follows:-

- (a) the quantity must be metered and the total recorded weekly; and
- (b) the quality must be monitored monthly, by grab sampling, at the point at which the wastewater enters the irrigation system for all parameters listed in subparagraph 2.7.(1).

(2) Where it is deemed necessary, or upon the written request of the Responsible Authority, the registered user must ensure the establishment of any additional monitoring programmes.

(3) Upon the written request of the Responsible Authority the registered user must appoint an external auditor to assess the water use in terms of this General Authorisation, and to submit the findings to the Responsible Authority for evaluation.

(4) The methods for determining the concentration of a specific substance in any wastewater, must be carried out:-

- (i) by a laboratory that has been accredited under the South African National Laboratory Accreditation System in terms of SABS Code 0259 for that method; or
- (ii) as approved in writing by the Minister.

Precautionary practices

2.11.(1) The registered user must follow acceptable construction, maintenance and operational practices to ensure the consistent, effective and safe performance of the wastewater irrigation system, including prevention of:-

- (a) irrigation with wastewater containing gross solids exceeding 2 mm linear dimension;
- (b) waterlogging of the soil and pooling of wastewater on the surface of the soil;
- (c) nuisance conditions such as flies or mosquitoes, odour or secondary pollution;
- (d) waste, or wastewater, entering any surface or groundwater resource; and
- (e) the unreasonable chemical or physical deterioration of, or any other damage to, the soil of the irrigation site.

(2) Measures must be taken for storage of the wastewater used for irrigation, when irrigation cannot be undertaken.

(3) Sewage sludge must be removed from any wastewater, and disposed of according to the requirements of any relevant laws and regulations.

(4) Reasonable measures must be taken to provide for mechanical, electrical, operational, or process failures and malfunctions of the wastewater irrigation system.

(5) Reasonable measures must be taken to collect stormwater runoff containing waste or wastewater emanating from the wastewater irrigation system and retain it for disposal.

Record keeping and disclosure of information

2.12.(1) The registered user must keep records of all wastewater irrigation and related activities, including:

- (a) the location and extent of the area under irrigation, demarcated on a 1:50 000 topographic map;
- (b) the irrigation management techniques being practised;
- (c) quantity of wastewater irrigated;
- (d) quality of wastewater irrigated;
- (e) details of the monitoring programme;
- (f) details of failure and malfunctions in the irrigation system,

and make the information available upon request to the Responsible Authority.

(2) Any information on occurrence of any incident which causes, or may cause, detrimental impacts on the water resource quality must be provided to the Responsible Authority in terms of section 20 of the National Water Act.

Inspections

2.13. Any property or land in respect of which a water use has been authorised in terms of this Notice must be made available for inspection by an authorised person in terms of section 125 of the National Water Act.

Offence

2.14. Any person who contravenes any provision of this authorisation is guilty of an offence and is subject to the penalty set out in section 151(2) of the National Water Act.

Purpose of this authorisation

3.1. The authorisation permitted in terms of this Schedule replaces the need for a water user to apply for a licence in terms of the National Water Act provided that the discharge is within the limits and conditions set out in this authorisation.

Exclusion

3.2. This authorisation does not:-

- (a) replace any existing authorisation that is recognised under the National Water Act; or
- (b) apply to a person who discharges any wastewater through sea outfalls, or to an aquifer, or any other groundwater resource.

Compliance with National Water Act and other laws

3.3.(1) This authorisation does not :-

- (a) apply to a discharge into a conduit or canal as provided for under Schedule 1 of the National Water Act;
- (b) exempt a person from compliance with section 7(2) of the Water Service Act, 1997 (Act No 108 of 1997); or
- (c) exempt a person who uses water from compliance with any provision of the National Water Act, unless stated otherwise or any other applicable law, regulation, ordinance or by-law.

(2) A person who uses water in terms of this authorisation is exempt from compliance with section 22(2)(e) of the National Water Act.

Area of applicability

3.4 This authorisation is applicable throughout the Republic of South Africa, except for the areas set out in Table 3.1.

- (b) the specified time period is extended by a further notice in the Gazette; or
- (c) the water user is instructed to apply for a license in terms of sections 41 or 43 of the National Water Act and a licence is issued thereunder.

Definitions

3.6. In this authorisation unless the context indicates otherwise, any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in terms of the National Water Act shall have that meaning, and:-

- (i) "**commercial activity**" means those activities identified in the Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (5th Edition), published by Central Statistics Service, 1993, as amended and supplemented, under the following categories:-
 - a) 6: wholesale and retail trade,
 - b) 7: transport, storage and communication,
 - c) 8: business services,
 - d) 9: community services,
 - e) 0: personal and other services.
- (ii) "**complex industrial wastewater**" means wastewater arising from industrial activities and premises, that contains:
 - a) a complex mixture of substances that are difficult or impractical to chemically characterise and quantify, or
 - b) one or more substances, for which a Wastewater Limit Value has not been specified, and which may be harmful or potentially harmful to human health, or to the water resource;
- (iii) "**domestic wastewater**" means wastewater arising from domestic and commercial activities and premises, and may contain sewage;
- (iv) "**domestic wastewater discharge**" means a wastewater discharge consisting of approximately 90% or more wastewater, by volume, arising from domestic and commercial activities and premises, that is collected and treated, and subsequently disposed of;
- (v) "**industrial activity**" means those activities identified in the Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (5th Edition), published by Central Statistics Service, 1993, as amended and supplemented, under the following categories:-
 - a) 2: mining and quarrying,
 - b) 3: manufacturing,
 - c) 4: electricity, gas and water supply,
 - d) 5: construction.
- (vi) "**industrial wastewater discharge**" means a wastewater discharge consisting of approximately 10% or more wastewater, by volume, arising from industrial activities and premises, that is collected and treated, and subsequently disposed of;
- (vii) "**intake**" is water taken from a water resource, and excludes water taken from any source that is not a water resource;
- (viii) "**monitoring programme**" means a programme for taking regular measurements of the quantity and/or quality of a water resource, waste or wastewater discharge at specified intervals and at specified locations, for determining the chemical, physical and biological nature of the water resource, waste or wastewater discharge;
- (ix) "**listed water resources**" are those water resources listed in Table 3.3, and include any tributary of a listed water resource, and any water resource draining the catchment area of a listed water resource;
- (x) "**wastewater**" means water containing waste, or water that has been in contact with waste material;

- (xi) "wastewater limit value" means the mass, expressed in terms of the concentration and/or level of a substance, which may not be exceeded, at any time. Wastewater Limit Values shall apply at the last point where the discharge of wastewater enters into a water resource, dilution being disregarded when determining compliance with the Wastewater Limit Values. Where discharge of wastewater does not directly enter a water resource, the Wastewater Limit Values shall apply at the last point where the wastewater leaves the premises of collection and treatment;

Discharging of domestic and industrial wastewater into water resources

3.7.(1) A person may discharge up to 2 000 cubic metres of wastewater on any given day into a water resource that is not referred to in Table 3.3, provided:-

- (a) the discharge complies with the General Limit Values set out in Table 3.2;
- (b) the discharge does not alter the ambient water temperature of the receiving water resource by more than 5 degrees Celsius; and
- (c) the discharge is not a Complex Industrial Wastewater.

(2) A person may discharge up to 2 000 cubic metres of wastewater on any given day into a water resource referred to in Table 3.3, provided:-

- (a) the discharge complies with the Special Limit Values set out in Table 3.2;
- (b) the discharge does not alter the ambient water temperature of the receiving water resource by more than 2 degrees Celsius; and
- (c) the discharge is not a Complex Industrial Wastewater.

(3) The maximum concentration of soluble Ortho-Phosphate, measured as phosphorous, in the wastewater referred to in paragraph 3.7(1), may not exceed 1 milligram per litre (mg/l), in any one of the following water resources, or any tributary thereof:-

- (a) Vaal River upstream and inclusive of the Bloemhof Dam;
- (b) Pienaars and Crocodile Rivers upstream of their confluence;
- (c) Olifants River upstream and inclusive of the Loskop Dam;
- (d) Umgeni River upstream and inclusive of the Inanda Dam;
- (e) Umlaas River upstream and inclusive of the Shongwene Dam;
- (f) Umfolozi River upstream and inclusive of the Klipfontein Dam;
- (g) Buffels River upstream and inclusive of the Bridle Drift Dam;
- (h) Berg River upstream of the influence of tidal water; and
- (i) Sonderend and Du Toits Rivers upstream and inclusive of Theewaterskloof Dam.

(4) A person may discharge stormwater runoff from any activity or premises, not containing waste or wastewater emanating from industrial activities and premises, into a water resource.

Registration of discharges into water resources

3.8. A person who discharges wastewater into a water resource in terms of this authorisation must submit an application form obtainable from the Responsible Authority for registration of the water use before commencement of the discharge.

(2) On receipt of the application form by the Responsible Authority the person will be regarded as a registered water user.

Monitoring of wastewater

3.9.(1) The registered user must ensure the establishment of monitoring programmes for monitoring the quantity and quality of the discharge prior to the commencement of the discharge, as follows:-

(a) the quantity of the discharge must be metered and the total recorded weekly; and

- (b) the quality of domestic wastewater discharges must be monitored monthly by grab sampling as set out in Table 3.4.
 - (c) the quality of industrial wastewater discharges must be monitored weekly by grab sampling:-
 - (i) for all substances which have been added to the wastewater through any industrial activity;
 - (ii) for all substances which have been concentrated in the wastewater through any industrial activity;
 - (iii) for all substances which may be harmful or potentially harmful to human health or to the water resource quality; and
 - (iv) as set out in sub-section 3.9(1)(b) if the waste water contains any domestic wastewater.
 - (d) The methods for determining the concentration of a specific substance in any wastewater must be carried out:-
 - (i) by a laboratory that has been accredited under the South African National Laboratory Accreditation System in terms of SABS Code 0259 for that method; or
 - (ii) as approved in writing by the Minister.
- (2) Where it is deemed necessary, or upon the written request of the Responsible Authority, the registered user must ensure the establishment of any additional monitoring programmes.
- (3) Upon the written request of the Responsible Authority the registered user must appoint an external auditor to assess the water use in terms of this General Authorisation, and to submit the findings to the Responsible Authority for evaluation.

Precautionary practices

- 3.10.(1) The registered user must follow acceptable construction, maintenance and operational practices to ensure the consistent, effective and safe performance of the discharge; and
- (2) All reasonable measures must be taken to provide for mechanical, electrical, operational, or process failures and malfunctions of the discharge system.

Record keeping and disclosure of information

3.11.(1) The registered user must keep a record of all discharges and related activities, including:

- (a) quantity of wastewater discharged,
- (b) quality of wastewater discharged,
- (c) details of the monitoring programme;
- (a) details of failures and malfunctions in the discharge system,

and make the information available upon request to the Responsible Authority.

(2) Any information on occurrence of any incident which causes, or may cause, detrimental impacts on the water resource quality must be provided to the Responsible Authority, in terms of section 20 of the National Water Act.

Inspections

3.12. Any property or land in respect of which a water use has been authorised in terms of this Notice must be made available for inspection by an authorised person in terms of section 125 of the National Water Act.

Offence

3.13. Any person who contravenes any provision of this authorisation is guilty of an offence and is subject to the penalty set out in section 151(2) of the National Water Act.

4 DISPOSING OF WASTE IN A MANNER WHICH MAY DETRIMENTALLY IMPACT ON A WATER RESOURCE**[Sections 21(g)]****Purpose of this authorisation**

4.1. The authorisation permitted in terms of this Schedule replaces the need for a water user to apply for a licence in terms of the National Water Act for the disposal of waste, provided that the disposal is within the limits and conditions set out in this authorisation.

Exclusion

4.2. This authorisation does not:-

- (a) replace any existing authorisation that is recognised under the National Water Act; or
- (b) apply to a person who is not the owner or lawful occupier of the land on which the disposal takes place.

Compliance with National Water Act and other laws

4.3.(1) This authorisation does not:-

- (a) exempt a person from compliance with section 7(2) of the Water Services Act, 1997 (Act No 108 of 1997);
- (b) exempt a person from compliance with the provisions of the National Building Regulations and Building Standards Act, 1977 (Act No 103 of 1977) for construction, operation and maintenance of any structure used for the collection, treatment or disposal of waste; or

(c) exempt a person who uses water from compliance with any provision of the National Water Act, unless stated otherwise or any other applicable law, regulation, ordinance or by-law.

(2) A person who uses water in terms of this authorisation is exempt from compliance with section 22(2)(e) of the National Water Act.

Area of applicability

4.4 This authorisation is applicable throughout the Republic of South Africa, except for any subterranean government water control area as defined in the Water Act, 1956 (Act No 54 of 1956) and set out in Table 4.1 and illustrated in Map 2.

Duration of authorisation

4.5. This authorisation will be applicable for a time period of 5 years from 1 April 1999 unless:-

- (a) amended or withdrawn;
- (b) the time period is extended by a further notice in the Gazette; or
- (c) the water user is instructed to apply for a license in terms of sections 41 or 43 of the National Water Act and a licence is issued thereunder.

Definitions

4.6. In this authorisation, unless the context otherwise indicates, any expression to which a meaning has been assigned in terms of the National Water Act shall have that meaning, and:-

- (i) "**biodegradable industrial wastewater**" means wastewater that contains a high concentration of organic waste arising from industrial activities and premises including:
 - (a) milk processing;
 - (b) manufacture of fruit and vegetable products;
 - (c) sugar mills;
 - (d) manufacture and bottling of soft drinks;
 - (e) water bottling;
 - (f) production of alcohol and alcoholic beverages in breweries, wineries or malt houses;
 - (g) manufacture of animal feed from plant or animal products;
 - (h) manufacture of gelatine and of glue from hides, skin and bones;
 - (i) abattoirs;
 - (j) fish processing; and
 - (k) feedlots.
- (ii) "**category A mine**" means:
 - (a) any gold or coal mine;
 - (b) any mine with an extractive metallurgical process, including heap leaching; or
 - (c) any mine where sulphate producing or acid generating material occurs in the mineral deposit.
- (iii) "**complex industrial wastewater**" means wastewater arising from industrial activities and premises, that contains:
 - a) a complex mixture of substances that are difficult or impractical to chemically characterise and quantify, or
 - b) one or more substances, for which a wastewater limit value has not been specified, and which may be harmful or potentially harmful to human health, or to the water resource;
- (iv) "**domestic wastewater**" means wastewater arising from domestic and commercial activities and premises, and may contain sewage;

- (v) "**evaporation pond**" means a dam designed to collect and dispose of wastewater through evaporation, and any concentrated waste or sludge must be removed and disposed of according to the requirements of any relevant laws and regulations;
- (vi) "**grey water**" refers to wastewater generated through domestic or household activities, including washing, bathing, and food preparation, but does not contain sewage;
- (vii) "**major aquifer**" means a highly permeable geological formation, which contains groundwater that is potentially available for abstraction and use. Identification of a Major Aquifer will be provided by the Responsible Authority, on request;
- (viii) "**monitoring programme**" means a programme for taking regular measurements of the quantity and/or quality of a water resource, waste or wastewater discharge, at specified intervals, and at specified locations, for determining the chemical, physical and biological nature of the water resource, waste or wastewater discharge;
- (ix) "**organic waste**" means waste of non-anthropogenic origin that is readily biodegradable in the environment and does not contain any substances that may accumulate in the environment;
- (x) "**on-site disposal**" refers to disposal of wastewater on individual properties not permanently linked to a central waste collection, treatment and disposal system, such as septic tank systems, conservancy tank systems, soakaway systems including onto ground, French Drains and pit latrines;
- (xi) "**primary treatment**" means treatment of wastewater by a physical process, which may involve maceration, sedimentation, screening and grit removal;
- (xii) "**secondary treatment**" means treatment of wastewater by a biological process, through solar energy, bacteria, algae and a variety of aquatic biota to remove organic matter;
- (xiii) "**wastewater**" means water containing waste, or water that has been in contact with waste material;
- (xiv) "**wastewater pond system**" means a dam or system of dams designed to collect wastewater, conduct primary and secondary treatment, and from which treated wastewater is disposed of.

Storage of wastewater for the purpose of disposal

4.7. A person who owns property registered in the Deeds Office, or lawfully occupies property or land outside the areas set out in Table 4.1 may store wastewater for the purpose of disposal of up to 10 000 cubic meters in a single dam, or up to 50 000 cubic meters in a wastewater pond system, on that property or land.

Storage of wastewater for the purpose of re-use

4.8. A person who owns property registered in the Deeds Office, or lawfully occupies property or land outside the areas set out in Table 4.1 may store wastewater for the purpose of re-use of up to 5 000 cubic metres in a single dam on that property or land.

Disposal of wastewater

4.9.(1) A person who owns property registered in the Deeds Office, or lawfully occupies property or land outside the areas set out in Table 4.1, may on that property or land, dispose of:-

- (a) domestic wastewater, or biodegradable industrial wastewater of up to 1 000 cubic metres, on any given day:-
 - (i) into a wastewater pond system; or

- (ii) into an evaporation pond system;
- (b) domestic wastewater or biodegradable wastewater into a wastewater irrigation system as set out under General Authorisation 2;
- (c) wastewater to an on-site disposal facility for:-
 - (i) grey water generated by a single household;
 - (ii) up to 1 cubic metre of biodegradable industrial wastewater, on any given day; and
 - (iii) domestic wastewater to a communal septic tank serving no more than 50 households;
- (d) domestic wastewater generated by a single household not permanently linked to a central waste collection, treatment and disposal system, to an on-site disposal facility excluding onto ground; and
- (e) stormwater runoff from any activity or premises, not containing waste or wastewater from industrial activities and premises.

Disposal of mine waste or residue

4.10. A person may dispose of mine residue into mine residue deposits if:-

- (a) the mine residue is not from a Category A mine;
- (b) the disposal is in accordance with Regulation No. R1499 dated 27 November 1998; and
- (c) the disposal is in accordance with SABS Code 0286.

Registration of wastewater storage

4.11.(1) A person who stores wastewater in terms of this authorisation must submit an application form obtainable from the Responsible Authority for registration of the water use before commencement of storage if more than 1 000 cubic metres are stored for disposal, or more than 500 cubic metres are stored for re-use.

(2) On receipt of the application form by the Responsible Authority the person will be regarded as a registered water user.

Registration of wastewater disposal

4.12.(1) A person who disposes of wastewater in terms of this authorisation must submit an application form obtainable from the Responsible Authority for registration of the water use before the commencement of the disposal if more than 50 cubic metres of domestic wastewater or biodegradable industrial wastewater is disposed of on any given day.

(2) The responsible local authority must submit an application form obtainable from the Responsible Authority to register water use for disposal of domestic wastewater in:-

- (a) areas where more than 5 000 households are served by on-site disposal sites;
- (b) areas where density of on-site disposal sites exceeds 10 per hectare; or
- (c) areas served by communal septic tanks.

(3) On receipt of the application form by the Responsible Authority the person will be regarded as a registered water user.

Location of wastewater storage dams and wastewater disposal sites

4.13.(1) Wastewater storage and wastewater disposal sites must be located:-

- (a) outside of a watercourse;
- (b) above the 100 year flood line or more than 100 metres from a water resource, or a borehole which is utilised for drinking water, or stock watering; and
- (c) on land that is not, or does not overlie, a Major Aquifer.

Monitoring requirements for storage and disposal of wastewater

4.14.(1) The registered user must ensure the establishment of monitoring programmes for monitoring the quantity and quality of the wastewater, prior to storage or disposal, as follows:-

- (a) for storage of wastewater, the quantity must be gauged and recorded monthly; or
- (b) for disposal of wastewater, the quantity must be metered and recorded monthly.

(2) Where it is deemed necessary, or upon the written request of the Responsible Authority, the registered user must ensure the establishment of any additional monitoring programmes.

(3) Upon the written request of the Responsible Authority the registered user must appoint an external auditor to assess the water use in terms of this General Authorisation, and to submit the findings to the Responsible Authority for evaluation.

Precautionary practices

4.15.(1) The registered user must follow acceptable construction, maintenance and operational practices to ensure the consistent, effective and safe performance of any wastewater disposal system or wastewater storage dam.

(2) All reasonable measures must be taken to prevent wastewater overflowing from any wastewater disposal system or wastewater storage dam.

(3) All reasonable measures must be taken to provide for mechanical, electrical or operational failures and malfunctions of any wastewater disposal system or wastewater storage dam.

(4) Sewage sludge must be removed from any wastewater, and disposed of according to the requirements of any relevant laws and regulations.

Record keeping and disclosure of information

4.16.(1) The registered user must keep records of all wastewater storage or wastewater disposal, and related activities, including:-

- (a) the location of storage dam or wastewater disposal site,
- (b) quantity of wastewater stored or disposed,
- (c) quality of wastewater stored or disposed, where applicable,
- (d) details of the monitoring programme;
- (e) details of failures and malfunctions of any wastewater disposal system or wastewater storage dam that the registered user is responsible for,

and make the information available upon request to the Responsible Authority.

(2) Any information on occurrence of any incident which causes, or may cause, detrimental impacts on the water resource quality, must be provided to the Responsible Authority in terms of section 20 of the National Water Act.

Inspections


4.17. Any property or land in respect of which a water use has been authorised in terms of this Notice must be made available for inspection by an authorised person in terms of section 125 of the National Water Act.

Offence



The paper relates to the Commission's investigation into the adoption of an Administrative Justice Act, to give effect to the provisions of section 33 of the Constitution of 1996.

The project is an urgent one. The Constitution requires an Administrative Justice Act to be in place before 4 February 2000.

The Discussion Paper contains the following main recommendations:

- The key concept "administrative action" in the draft Bill determines its application. The intention is a wide application to public powers. The only proposed exclusions are the actions of Parliament and the provincial legislatures and the local government functions listed in section 160(2) of the Constitution, namely the passing of by-laws, the approval of budgets, the imposition of rates and taxes and the raising of loans. Administrative action by natural or juristic persons contemplated in section 8(2) of the Constitution and exercising a public power or performing a public function (e.g. non-statutory bodies controlling national sports codes), is included. (In what follows natural and juristic persons of this sort will be referred to as "section 8(2) persons").
- It is recommended that the Bill applies to all "organs of state" and to all section 8(2) persons, and that its provisions prevail over the provisions of any other law other than the Constitution and any provincial Constitution.
- The imposition of a duty on all organs of state to give effect to the rights in section 33(1) and (2) of the Constitution and provision for the review of administrative action by the courts, are recommended.

- It is recommended that the Magistrates' Courts power of review be extended. Until now, that power has been the preserve of the High Courts.
- The Bill sets out the grounds on which a court may review administrative action and the procedure for written reasons for administrative action. It tries to do so in wide and plain terms. It deals with the authorisation of the organ of state or section 8(2) person to take administrative action, the procedure followed, the reasoning process leading to the administrative action and the lawfulness, attributes and impact of the administrative action itself.
- Consecutive periods of 90 days during which a person adversely affected by administrative action may apply for written reasons and the duty of an organ of state or section 8(2) person to furnish those reasons are recommended as well as remedies for non-compliance with the duty to furnish reasons.
- A period of 90 days during which proceedings for review must be instituted is recommended and provision is made for the adoption and implementation of new rules for applications for review.
- Courts in proceedings for review are required to grant appropriate relief, and provision is made for an "open list" of the remedies in proceedings for review, the aim of which is to structure the way in which reviewing courts approach the question of remedies.
- The parties are allowed (by agreement) and the courts (on application) to extend the 90-day periods during which reasons must be sought and supplied and proceedings for review may be instituted.
- The Bill provides procedures in terms of which organs of state make "rules" and "standards". "Rules" are defined to mean statements designed to have the force of law, and include subordinate legislation. "Standards" are defined to mean norms, guidelines, policies, general instructions or other similar statements about the way in which a public power or public function should be interpreted or exercised or performed.
- Provision is made for two types of registers of rules and standards, namely registers to be held and kept up to date by all organs of state regarding the rules and standards under their aegis and a central register to be held and kept up to

date by the Administrative Review Council. The aim of these registers is to improve access to the many rules and standards made and administered by organs of state.

- The establishment of a Central Drafting Office within the Department of Justice is recommended, the main task of which will be to consider and approve the text of rules (but not standards) which organs of state intend making, to compile and establish protocols for the drafting of rules and standards and, in conjunction with the Administrative Review Council, to provide training to the drafters of rules and standards. The aim of these provisions is to improve and standardise the drafting of rules and standards.
- A notice-and-comment procedure for the making of rules which impose material burdens or disadvantages or confer material benefits on any person or group is laid down. Departures from the prescribed procedure are permitted in emergencies.
- Provision is made for the publication in newspapers of a concise description of the contents of a rule and a statement of the reasons for it.
- The Bill is designed to ensure that published rules and standards are up to date and hence, it contains two "sunsetting provisions". The first provides for the automatic lapsing of all rules and standards in force on the date of commencement of the draft Bill, five years after that date. The second compels all organs of state periodically to review the rules and standards under their aegis, by providing that all rules and standards made after the commencement of the draft Bill will be valid for at most 10 years and must reflect the date on which they will lapse.
- Two special administrative procedures, namely public enquiries and administrative investigations are recommended. In terms of the Bill, public enquiries must be held by organs of state or section 8(2) persons which intend to take administrative action the object of which is to determine a matter of wide public interest and consequences and in respect of which they have a wide discretion. Administrative investigations must be held whenever an organ of state is required to take administrative action the object of which is to determine

the status, rights or duties of a person. An investigation need not be formal, but the organ of state or section 8(2) person must afford the person concerned proper notice and a proper opportunity to be heard. The reasons for the administrative action and details of any right of appeal and of the right to apply for review must also be given.

- The establishment of the Administrative Review Council is recommended. The composition of the Council is recommended as follows, namely a Chairperson nominated by the Chief Justice; officials in the Department of Justice and Department for Public Service and Administration nominated by the relevant Ministers; the Public Protector or a member of his or her staff; and between three and nine other persons appointed by the President, after consultation with the National Council of Provinces.
- The functions of the Council are recommended as follows, namely
 - ▶ to investigate and report on review of administrative action and any improvements in the law, rules and standards for administrative action that might be made to ensure that it is efficient and conforms to the Constitution;
 - ▶ to investigate the viability of independent review tribunals and the efficacy of administrative appeals, including the possibility of specialised administrative appeals tribunals; and
 - ▶ to initiate, conduct and co-ordinate programmes for educating the public at large and the members and employees of organs of state or section 8(2) persons regarding the contents of the Bill and the provisions of the Constitution relevant to administrative action.
- Consequential matters arising from the establishment of the Council are also dealt with, such as the meetings, committees and staff of the Council, the engagement of persons to perform services in specific areas, and expenditure and reporting by the Council.

The Commission invites the comments of all parties who feel that they have an interest in the topic. Individuals, organisations and institutions should participate in this debate and are invited

to indicate what their concerns are and what solutions they are able to propose. Based on the outcome of these comments and discussions, a report containing the Commission's final recommendations and an amendment Bill will be prepared and presented to the Minister of Justice. Written comments or suggestions must reach the Commission by 31 March 1999 at the address given below.

Terms of Reference for investigation into racism in the media****A Definitions:**

"Act" refers to the Human Rights Commission Act, 1994 (Act No 54 of 1994);
"Constitution" refers to the Republic of South Africa Constitution Act, 1996 (Act No 108 of 1996);
"Chairperson" refers to the Chairperson of the South African Human Rights Commission or a person designated by the Chairperson.

B Terms of Reference:

1. To investigate the handling of race and possible incidence of racism in the products of the media and whether such racism as may be manifested in these products constitutes a violation of fundamental human rights as set out in the Constitution.
2. To establish the underlying causes and examine the impact on society of racism in the media if such racism is found to be manifested in the product of the media.
3. To make findings and recommendations as appropriate.

C Procedure:

1. The investigation will be conducted in terms of the procedure published in Government Gazette Number 17457 published in Government Notice 1465 dated 4th October 1996, read with special procedure set out below.
2. Within 14 days of the publication of this Notice, the Commission will cause to be published in any manner that the Commission may deem necessary, invitations for submissions from any interested parties including institutions, organisations and individuals.

Invitation for Public Submissions

3. The submissions should be in writing and must disclose the name, address and other contact details of the deponent. Anonymous submissions will not be entertained. Where, however, the deponent does not wish to have her/his name published, the Commission will respect that wish. Confidential submissions, however, having regard to the rules of natural justice, may not necessarily be accorded the same weight as public submissions. Submissions must be submitted within 30 days of publication of the invitation referred to in Paragraph C2 above.
4. In order to make the process as inclusive as possible, members of the public may request to make their submissions to the Commission under oath in camera.

Commissioned Research

5. The Commission may undertake or commission research, which may assist in providing information or data, social analysis or methodology for the investigation.

Analysis and Evaluation

6. The Commission will analyse the submissions and the research in order to determine trends and any *prima facie* allegations of violations of fundamental human rights. Note will be taken of proposals for the further conduct of the investigation and suggestions about how best South Africa can achieve the elimination of all forms of racism and racial discrimination.

7. An interim report on the research, submissions and evaluation and analysis of the information and data submitted, as well as the data themselves, will be made available upon request. Those institutions, corporate bodies, organisations and individuals who may have an interest in responding to any part of the interim report will be offered an opportunity to do so in writing. Responses must be received within 30 days of the release of the report.
8. The Commission will thereafter evaluate the responses and invite specific individuals, corporations or institutions to make oral submissions and give testimony at Public Hearings.
9. The time and place of these Public Hearings will be published in the Government Gazette

The Panel

10. Pursuant to the provisions of the Act, a panel will preside over the Public Hearings. The Chairperson of the Human Rights Commission, or a person designated by the Chairperson, will chair the panel. The panel will consist of at least three persons. Among the panelists, the Chairperson may invite one or two persons with expertise in racism and/or the media.
11. All submissions before the panel will be made under oath or affirmation. The rules of natural justice will apply. Witnesses will be entitled to legal representation. Argument on points of law or of fact may be addressed to the panel.
12. In conducting the inquiry, the Commission will have recourse to the provisions of Sections 9 and 10 of the Act.

The Report

13. The Chairperson and members of the panel will prepare a final report on the Inquiry in terms of Section 15 of the Act. The report will take due notice of all submission, allegations, responses, and points of law and of fact. Following an analysis of the evidence submitted, the panel would make Findings and Recommendations.
14. The final Report of the Inquiry and the findings and recommendations will be made public.
