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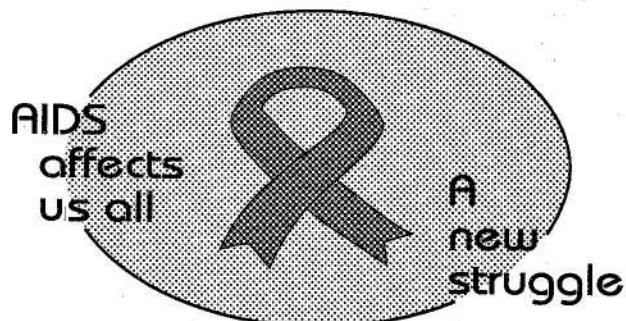

STATEMENT OF THE NATIONAL REVENUE, EXPENDITURE AND BORROWING AS AT 31 JULY 2000 ISSUED BY THE DIRECTOR-GENERAL: NATIONAL TREASURY

INTRODUCTION

Section 32 of the Public Finance Management Act (the Act) requires that National Treasury publish a statement of actual revenue, expenditure and borrowing with regard to:

1. The National Revenue Fund (the NRF) on a monthly basis; and
2. All Provincial Revenue Funds on a quarterly basis.

The consolidated National Revenue Fund statement is prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Act.

DISCLAIMER

Care should be exercised in using the difference between revenue and expenditure for the year to date to extrapolate a budget deficit for the year-end. Moreover, cognisance should be taken of the cyclical pattern of revenue and expenditure flows during the course of the fiscal year.

NATIONAL REVENUE FUND

The NRF schedules consist of:

Summary schedule

The summary schedule reflects total revenue received, expenditure classified as voted amounts, contingency reserve / unallocated amounts, statutory amounts and standing appropriations as well as total borrowings. The difference between revenue and expenditure taking into account extraordinary items results in the net borrowing requirement.

Revenue schedule (Schedule 1)

The revenue schedule has been compiled in accordance with the Government Financial Statistics (GFS) format adopted in the Budget Review. Under the Government Financial Statistics format, revenue is classified as direct and indirect taxes as opposed to the traditional Inland Revenue and Customs and Excise classification.

The total revenue received amounts to R18,878 billion for the month of July and R64,028 billion for the year to date. Direct taxation amounts to R10,188 billion and indirect taxes R8,582 billion for the month. Non tax revenue amounts to R108 million for the month and R1,354 billion for the year to date.

Total direct taxation for the year to date is R35,768 billion and total indirect taxation is R29,005 billion.

Expenditure (Schedule 2)

The Act requires the publication of actual expenditure as opposed to the traditional publication of funds (exchequer) requisitions.

Total expenditure for the month of July comprises of amounts classified as voted amounts of R7,127 billion and statutory amounts of R9,250 billion. For year to date the voted amounts are R30,688 billion and statutory amounts of R41,056 billion.

Extraordinary receipts / payments (Schedule 3)

This section consists of extraordinary receipts and payments. For the month the net receipts are R561 million and R650 million for the year to date.

Borrowing (Schedule 4)

Schedule 4 sets out financing for the month and year to date and distinguishes between domestic short and long term loans as well as foreign loans.

Net domestic short term borrowing for July amounts to R2,540 billion, while net domestic short term borrowing for the year to date amounts to R11,363 billion.

Net domestic long term loans for the month amounts to R1,185 billion while net domestic long term loans amounts to R1,688 billion for the year to date.

An amount of R129 million was drawn on The Defence Procurement Export Credit facilities for the month of July. Total foreign loans for the year to date amounts to R1,597 billion.

In July a change in cash balances of R6,916 billion is reflected, resulting in a net change in balances of R7,582 billion for the year to date.

Total net borrowing for the month amounts to R3,063 billion and R7,066 billion for the year to date.
