PUBLICATION OF EXPLANATORY SUMMARY OF CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA AMENDMENT BILL

Minister of Defence intends introducing the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa Amendment Bill in the National Assembly in 2000. The explanatory summary of the Bill is hereby published in accordance with Rule 258(2) of the Rules of the National Assembly.

The Bill provides for:

The deletion of section 236(8)(d) of the repealed Constitution of South Africa, 1993 (Act No. 200 of 1993), which remains in force by virtue of item 24(1)(b) of Schedule 6 to the Constitution (Act 108 1996). Such deletion will remove the right of a member of APLA and MK to conclude agreements of appointment with the SANDF if his or her name and further particulars appears in the certified personnel register or personnel list. Interested persons and institutions are invited to submit written representation of the draft constitutional amendment.

PUBLICATION OF EXPLANATORY SUMMARY OF TERMINATION OF INTEGRATION INTAKE BILL

The Minister of Defence intends introducing Termination of Integration Intake Bill in the National Assembly in 2000. The explanatory summary of the Bill is hereby published in accordance with Rule 241(c) of the Rules of the National Assembly.

The Bill provides for:

For the termination of the intake of members of APLA and MK for integration purpose. Members who are eligible to conclude agreement should do so before 31 March 2001. The Bill makes provision for the members of APLA and MK whose names appear in the certified personnel register and personnel list and who are likely to be granted amnesty in terms of the Promotion of National Unity and Reconciliation Act, 1995 after 31 March 2001.

PUBLICATION OF EXPLANATORY SUMMARY OF DEMOBILISATION AMENDMENT BILLL

The Minister of Defence intends introducing the Demobilisation Amendment Act in the National Assembly early in the year 2000. The explanatory summary of the Bill is hereby published in accordance with Rule 241(c) of the Rules of the National Assembly.

The Bill provides for:

Amendment of the definition of "closing date" in the Demobilisation Act, 1996, (Act 99 of 1996) so as to make it possible to demobilise members of APLA and MK who are unable to conclude agreements of appointment with the SANDF on account of them not satisfying the terms and conditions of service of the SANDF. Unlike the principal Act, the Bill does not designate a particular date as the "closing date", such date will be determined by the Minister by notice in the Government Gazette.
