BIRTHS AND DEATHS REGISTRATION ACT, 1992 (ACT No. 51 OF 1992)

NOTICE OF CHANGE OF FEES PAYABLE

With reference to Government Notice No. 248 of 2000 which was published in *Government Gazette* No. 20987 of 14 March 2000, it is hereby announced that fees which are payable in terms of section 8 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1992 (Act No. 51 of 1992), for services rendered have been amended. The fees which are payable with effect from 1 April 2001 are the following:

- (a) Issuing of an abridged *computer printed* or *handwritten* birth or death certificate: Provided that no fees are payable for the issuing of the prescribed certificate on registration of a birth or death **R 6,00**
- (b) Issuing of an unabridged birth or death certificate, or a reproduction of the relevant register or a reproduction of any supporting documentation coupled to the register concerned, as well as verification of information from birth and death registers in regard to an individual: Provided that where the reproduction or verification is required for official purposes within the meaning of paragraph (h) below, it shall be free of charge **R 35,00**
- (c) Application for any amendment to the birth register of any person including the noting of the fact of adoption in the birth register of a person in terms of the Child Care Act, 1983, but excluding the re-registration of a birth in terms of section 11 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1992 (Act No. 51 of 1992), which is *free of charge* **R 35,00**
- (d) Application for any change of the forenames or surname of a minor (section 24 and 25 of Act No. 51 of 1992) **R 35,00**
- (e) Application for the changing of a major's forenames in the birth register (section 24 of Act No. 51 of 1992). The insertion of a major's forenames and surname in the birth register (section 23 of Act No. 51 of 1992), however, is *free of charge* if his or her identity document was issued with the forenames repeated as a surname **R 55,00**
- (f) Application by a major to assume a different surname (section 26 of Act No. 51 of 1992): Provided that, if the applicant is lawfully married, the amount of R180,00 shall include the application of his or her spouse, as well as those of any minor children, or if the applicant is divorced or a widow or a widower, shall also include the application of his or her minor children, if any **R180,00**
- (g) Issuing of a duplicate confirmation of the change of a major's forenames and/or surname **R 27,00**
- (h) Furnishing of information from the Population Register for official purposes to any departments of State, local authority or statutory body (section 29 of Act No. 51 of 1992): Provided that the prescribed fees for abridged or unabridged birth or death certificates shall be payable if such certificates are requested **Free**

BOARD ON TARIFFS AND TRADE

INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED DUMPING OF TUBES, PIPES AND HOLLOW PROFILES, WELDED AND GALVANISED, OF A CIRCULAR CROSS SECTION, OF IRON OR NON-ALLOY STEEL OF AN INSIDE DIAMETER ("NOMINAL BORE RANGE") OF BETWEEN 15 MM AND 150 MM AND COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS "WELDED GALVANISED STEEL PIPE", ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM INDIA

The Board on Tariffs and Trade (the Board) accepted a petition alleging that welded galvanised steel pipe originating in or imported from India is being dumped in the Southern African Customs Union (SACU) market, causing material injury to the SACU industry concerned.

THE PETITIONER

The petition was lodged by Robor Tube, A division of Robor Industrial (Pty) Ltd, representing the domestic manufacturers of the product under investigation in the SACU. The Petitioner alleges that it cannot compete with the low prices charged by the importers and that the allegedly dumped products are causing material injury. The Petitioner submitted sufficient evidence and established a *prima facie* case to enable the Board to arrive at a reasonable conclusion that an investigation should be initiated on the basis of dumping, material injury and causality.

THE PRODUCT

The product allegedly being exported at dumped prices is tubes, pipes and hollow profiles, welded and galvanised, of a circular cross section, of iron or non-alloy steel of an inside diameter ("nominal bore range") of between 15 mm and 150 mm and commonly referred to as "welded galvanised steel pipe", classifiable under tariff subheadings 7306.10; 7306.30; and 7306.90, originating in or imported from India.

THE ALLEGATION OF DUMPING

The allegation of dumping is based on the comparison between the normal value in and the export price from India. The normal value was determined based on quotes provided. The export prices were also determined on the basis of quotes. On this basis, the Board found that there was *prima facie* proof of dumping.

THE ALLEGATION OF MATERIAL INJURY AND CAUSAL LINK

The Petitioner alleges and submitted sufficient evidence to show that there is price undercutting and that the imports in question are suppressing its selling prices. The Petitioner's information indicated a decline in sales, profit margins, output, market share and capacity utilisation. On this basis the Board found that there was *prima facie* proof of material injury and causal link.

PERIOD OF INVESTIGATION

The period of investigation for purposes of determining the dumping margins in the exporting country or country of origin will be from October 1999 to September 2000. The period of investigation for purposes of determining injury will be from October 1996 to September 2000. If there are subsequent events that are relevant to injury the Board may later request and consider further, more recent information.

PROCEDURAL FRAMEWORK

Having decided that there is sufficient evidence and a *prima facie* case to justify the initiation of an investigation, the Board has begun an investigation in terms of section 4 of the Board on Tariffs and Trade Act, 1986 (the BTT Act). The Board will conduct its investigation in accordance with the BTT Act and the World Trade Organisation Agreement on Implementation of Article VI of the GATT (the Anti-Dumping Agreement). A copy of the Anti-Dumping Agreement is available from the Board's office on request. NOTICE 630 OF 2001

BOARD ON TARIFFS AND TRADE

INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED SUBSIDISED EXPORT OF TUBES, PIPES AND HOLLOW PROFILES, WELDED AND GALVANISED, OF A CIRCULAR CROSS SECTION, OF IRON OR NON-ALLOY STEEL OF AN INSIDE DIAMETER ("NOMINAL BORE RANGE") OF BETWEEN 15 MM AND 150 MM AND COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS "WELDED GALVANISED STEEL PIPE", ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM INDIA

The Board on Tariffs and Trade (the Board) accepted a petition alleging that welded galvanised steel pipe originating in or imported from India is being exported at subsidised prices to the Southern African Customs Union (SACU) market, causing material injury to the SACU industry concerned.

THE PETITIONER

The petition was lodged by Robor Tube, A division of Robor Industrial (Pty) Ltd, representing the domestic manufacturers of the product under investigation in the SACU. The Petitioner alleges that it cannot compete with the low prices charged by the importers and that the allegedly subsidised exported products are causing material injury. The Petitioner submitted sufficient evidence and established a *prima facie* case to enable the Board to arrive at a reasonable conclusion that an investigation should be initiated on the basis of subsidised export, material injury and causality.

THE PRODUCT

The product allegedly being exported at subsidised prices is tubes, pipes and hollow profiles, welded and galvanised, of a circular cross section, of iron or non-alloy steel of an inside diameter ("nominal bore range") of between 15 mm and 150 mm and commonly referred to as "welded galvanised steel pipe", classifiable under tariff

subheadings 7306.10; 7306.30; and 7306.90, originating in or imported from India.

THE ALLEGATION OF SUBSIDISED EXPORT

The Petitioner submitted information on certain subsidy programmes and on that basis, the Board decided to investigate the following subsidy programmes:

Income Tax Exemption Scheme (ITES) (Export profits exempt from income tax):

The Board found that there was prima facie evidence that the ITES constitutes a subsidy in terms of Article 1(a)(1)(ii) of the SCM Agreement, and that the ITES is countervailable in terms of Article 3.1(a) of the SCM Agreement. The amount of the subsidy is estimated to be 10 per cent.

Duty Entitlement Passbook Scheme (DEPB)

The Board decided both the DEPB on pre-export basis and the DEPB on post-export basis will be investigated. The amount of the subsidy is estimated to be 10 per cent. The Board found that there was prima facie evidence that the DEPB constitutes a subsidy in terms of Article 1(a)(1)(ii) of the SCM Agreement, and that the DEPB is countervailable in terms of Article 3.1(a) of the SCM Agreement.

Waste factor

The Board found that there was prima facie evidence that the waste factor allowance constitutes a subsidy in terms of Article 1(a)(1)(ii) of the SCM Agreement, and that the ITES is countervailable in terms of Article 3.1(a) of the SCM Agreement. The amount of the subsidy is estimated to be 10 per cent.

Export credit guarantee system (ECGS)

The Board found that there was prima facie evidence that the ECGS constitutes a subsidy in terms of Article 1(a)(1)(ii) of the SCM Agreement, and that the ITES is

countervailable in terms of Article 3.1(a) of the SCM Agreement. The amount of the subsidy is estimated to be 0,5 per cent.

ECGS where the Government bears the risk

The Board found that there was prima facie evidence that the ECGS where the Government bears the risk constitutes a subsidy in terms of Article 1(a)(1)(ii) of the SCM Agreement, and that the ITES is countervailable in terms of Article 3.1(a) of the SCM Agreement. The amount of the subsidy is estimated to be 0,5 per cent.

Assistance in the form of a subsidy on electricity and capacity costs

The Board found that there was prima facie evidence that the assistance in the form of a subsidy on electrical and capacity costs constitutes a subsidy in terms of Article 1(a)(1)(ii) of the SCM Agreement, and that the ITES is countervailable in terms of Article 3.1(a) of the SCM Agreement. The amount of the subsidy is estimated to be 1,0 per cent.

THE ALLEGATION OF MATERIAL INJURY AND CAUSAL LINK

The Petitioner alleges and submitted sufficient evidence to show that there is price undercutting and that the imports in question are suppressing its selling prices. The Petitioner's information indicated a decline in sales, profit margins, output, market share and capacity utilisation. On this basis the Board found that there was *prima facie* proof of material injury and causal link.

PERIOD OF INVESTIGATION

The period of investigation for purposes of determining the subsidised export margins in the exporting country of origin will be from 1 October 1999 to 30 September 2000. The period of investigation for purposes of determining injury will be from 1 October 1996 to 30 September 2000. If there are subsequent events that are relevant to injury the Board may later request and consider further, more recent information.

PROCEDURAL FRAMEWORK

Having decided that there is sufficient evidence and a *prima facie* case to justify the initiation of an investigation, the Board has begun an investigation in terms of section 4 of the Board on Tariffs and Trade Act, 1986 (the BTT Act). The Board will conduct its investigation in accordance with the BTT Act and the Agreement on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures (SCM Agreement). Copies of the SCM Agreement are available from the Board's office on request.
