# GENERAL NOTICE

#### NOTICE 2228 OF 2001

#### **ELECTORAL COMMISSSION**

### **ELECTION TIMETABLE**

The Electoral Commission hereby gives notice that it has in terms of section 11 of the Local Government: Municipal Electoral Act, 2000, compiled the election timetable set out below to apply to the municipal by-election to be held on 28 November 201 in respect of Wards 1, 6 and 5 of KZ232 - Emnambithi [Ladysmith], KZ272 Jozini [Mkuze] and KZ293 Ndwedwe Municipalities respectively, as called in terms of Provincial Notices numbers 412, 413 and 414 published in the Provincial Gazette Extraordinary No. 1370 of the Province of KwaZulu-Natal on 1 November 2001. A reference to "section" in this election timetable is a reference to that section in the Local Government: Municipal Electoral Act, 2000.

# Cut-off time for act to be performed

An act required in terms of this Act to be performed by not later than a date in the election timetable must be performed before 17:00 on that date, unless otherwise specified.

#### Certification of the voters'roll

By 8 November 2001 the chief electoral officer must certify the segments of the voters' roll for the voting districts to be used in the by-elections in terms of section 6(2) (a).

# Notice that lists of addresses of voting stations are available for inspection

By 9 November 2001 the chief electoral officer must give notice that copies of a list of voting stations and their addresses will be available for inspection at the office of the Commission's local representative in terms of section 19(5).

# Notice of route of mobile voting stations

If the Commission decides to use mobile voting stations in the byelections, the Commission must by 9 November 2001 give notice of the route, including the locations and estimated times of stopping of each mobile voting station in terms of section 22(1).

### Cut -off date for nomination of ward candidates to contest an election

By not later than 15 November 2001, the nomination of a person to contest the by-election in a municipality as a ward candidate, must be submitted to the Commission's local representative on a prescribed form and in the prescribed manner in terms of section 17 (1).

# Cut - off date for compilation and certification of ward candidate lists

6 By 16 November 2001 the Commission must compile for each ward a list of ward candidates, certify those lists for that by-election, and keep copies of the lists available at the office of the Commission's local representative in terms of section 18 (1).

# Cut-off date for issuing certificates

7 By 16 November 2001 the Commission must issue to each ward candidate contesting the by-election, a prescribed certificate in terms of section 18(1)(d).
