INDEPENDENT COMMUNICATIONS AUTHORITY OF SOUTH AFRICA

NOTICE WITH RESPECT TO 112 EMERGENCY CALLS FROM SIMLESS PHONES

The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa (ICASA) hereby gives notice in terms of the provisions of the Telecommunications Act No. 103 of 1996 as amended, to the public and to the Cellular Telecommunication Services operators that all calls from simless phones or phones with inactive sims to the 112 public emergency number shall be barred permanently with effect from the 10th of June 2004.

This decision was adopted by the Council of ICASA on the 10th of June 2004, based on the statistics provided by the operators over a test period of six (6) months.
