THE DEVELOPMENT OF A NATIONAL CURRICULUM STATEMENT GRADES 10 – 12 (GENERAL) – SECOND PHASE: CALL FOR WRITTEN SUBMISSIONS FROM STAKEHOLDER BODIES AND MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC

1. INTRODUCTION

On 3 March 2004 the names of the appointed members to serve on various curriculum development structures of the Second Phase of the development of a National Curriculum Statement Grades 10-12 (General) were published by means of a Government Notice No. 285 in the Government Gazette Vol. 465, No. 26119. The aim of the second curriculum development phase is the development of two (2) additional subjects and the alignment of the already developed technical subjects with the newly developed subject, Civil Technology for inclusion in the National Curriculum Statement Grades 10 - 12 (General). The Government Notice listed the members of the following curriculum development structures and their terms of reference:

- A Ministerial Project Committee;
- 1 Reference Group;
- 5 Subject Working Groups;
- Department of Education Co-ordinators; and
- Administrative component.

In this spirit, I Grace Naledi Mandisa Pandor, Minister of Education, invite stakeholder bodies and members of the public with an interest in Further Education and Training, in terms of Section 3(4)(1) of the National Education Policy Act, 1996 (Act No. 27 of 1996) to comment on the National Curriculum Statement Grades 10 – 12 (General).
