#### **NOTICE 2457 OF 2004**

#### DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

#### APPLICATION FOR MARKET ACCESS PERMITS FOR AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS

In order to fulfil South Africa's commitment under the World Trade Organisation: Marrakesh Agreement regarding market access, it is hereby made known that market access permits will be issued for the products specified in the Table of Import Arrangements and under the conditions set out in the Schedule.

Permits will be issued only to importers in South Africa for importation into the Republic for the quantities and at the reduced levels of duty as specified in the Table.

#### SCHEDULE

#### 1. Application for market access permits

- 1.1 Permits will be issued only to importers registered at DTI and SARS of which proof is required as stipulated in par. 6 and 7 of the Annexure to the Schedule.
- 1.2 Any person interested in importing any of the products specified in the Table must apply therefor on a copy of the application form attached as an Annexure.
- 1.3 The application form is available electronically on request from <a href="mailto:casg@nda.agric.za">casg@nda.agric.za</a>.
- 1.4 An application form will only be accepted if duly completed.
- 1.5 An applicant bears the responsibility to ensure that
  - the application form reflects the correct information as requested for the product concerned;
  - (b) the application is submitted timeously within the time period contemplated in paragraph 4.1 to 4.3; and
  - (c) the application (whether faxed or posted) has been received by the Manager: Marketing Administration.

#### 2. Conditions for the issuing of permits

- 2.1 Permits for the products specified in the Table, will be allocated on the basis of the following categories, unless specified differently in the Table:
  - (a) 10% to importers who did not import the product applied for during the past three years, referred to as new importers.

- (b) 10% to importers that are Small, Medium and Micro Enterprises, referred to as SMME importers.
- 80% to importers who imported the product applied for during the past (c) three years, referred to as historical importers.
- 2.2 The allocation of quotas for permits will be done as follows:
  - (a) new importers on an equal basis:
  - SMME importers either on an equal basis or as a historical importer, (b) whichever will enhance government policy for SMME development; and
  - historical importers in proportion to the average quantity of the product (c) concerned, imported by the applicant during the past three years (submitted for each year as from 1 November to 31 October) or the period stipulated for the product in column 5 of the Table.
- The quantity imported by a historical importer will be calculated on the basis of a detailed list of bills of entry for the product concerned submitted together with the application form, for the period stipulated for the product in column 5 of the Table.
- 2.4 (a) If the allocation for a particular category is not fully utilised, the balance may be re-allocated to the other categories, or may be held over for the particular category for the following application period stipulated for the year under consideration.
  - In order to enhance government policy on new importers and SMME's, (b) quotas for new importers and SMME's can be combined to ensure the most beneficial allocation.
- The provisions of this section shall apply subject to the conditions specified in 2.5 the Table.

An application transmitted by facsimile must be followed up by forwarding the original application (do not include copies of the bills of entry unless specifically stipulated so in column 5 of the Table) to the address contemplated in paragraph (a) or (b) to reach the Department within 14 days of the facsimile transmission.

3.2 Applications delivered by hand will only be accepted during the Department's official hours of 07:30 to 16:00.

#### 4. Time periods for applications

- 4.1 Applications for market access permits issued on a quarterly basis must be submitted during the following time periods:
  - (a) For the first quarter of the quota valid for importation during the period 1 January 2005 to 30 April 2005: Within four weeks from the date of publication of this Notice.
  - (b) For the second quarter of the quota valid for importation during the period 1 April 2005 to 31 July 2005: 1 to 31 March 2005.
  - (c) For the third quarter of the quota valid for importation during the period 1 July 2005 to 31 October 2005: 1 to 30 June 2005.
  - (d) For the last quarter of the quota valid for importation during the period 1 October 2005 to 31 December 2005: 1 to 30 September 2005.
- 4.2 Applications for market access permits issued on a half-yearly basis must be submitted during the following periods:
  - (a) For the first half of the quota valid for importation during the period 1 January 2005 to 30 June 2005: Within four weeks from the date of publication of this Notice.
  - (b) For the second half of the quota valid for importation during the period 1 July 2005 to 31 December 2005: 1 to 31 May 2005.
- 4.3 Applications for market access permits issued on an annual basis for the period valid from 1 January 2005 to 31 December 2005 must be submitted within four weeks from the date of publication of this Notice.

#### General

- 5.1 Applicants must return all expired permits within 30 days after the date of expiry thereof. Applicants who do not return their expired permits timeously will not be considered for the granting of permits.
- 5.2 This notice replaces all previous notices regarding procedures for the application, administration and allocation of market access permits under the World Trade Organisation: Marrakesh Agreement regarding market access.




