NOTICE 157 OF 2005 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

GENERAL AND FURTHER EDUCATION AND TRAINING QUALITY ASSURANCE ACT, 2001 (ACT NO. 58 OF 2001)

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS TO FILL TWO VACANCIES IN THE GENERAL AND FURTHER EDUCATION AND TRAINING QUALITY ASSURANCE (COUNCIL) UMALUSI

1. I, Ms Grace Naledi Mandisa Pandor, Minister of Education, hereby in terms of *Section 6(4) and 6(5) of the General and Further Education and Training Quality Assurance Act, 2001 (Act No. 58 of 2001)*, invites nominations from persons, role-players or organisations active or involved in general and further education and training for the filling of two vacancies in the General and Further Education and Training Quality Assurance Council (commonly referred to as Umalusi), hereafter referred to as "the Council".
2. *Section 6(1)(a) of the General and Further Education and Training Quality Assurance Act, 2001 (Act No. 58 of 2001)*, makes provision for the establishment of a Council comprising 15 members appointed by the Minister.
3. In terms of *Section 6(3)(a) of the said Act*, membership must:
 - (i) be broadly representative of the general and further education and training sectors and related interest;
 - (ii) have thorough knowledge and understanding of general and further education and training;
 - (iii) appreciate the role of the general and further education and training system in reconstruction and development;
 - (iv) have known and attested commitment to the interest of general and further

education and training;

(v) have knowledge and understanding of accreditation, assessment and certification of general and further education and training programmes;

(vi) has experience in statistics; and

(vii) has experience in the financial sector.

4. Any member appointed as a member of the Council:

(a) holds office for a period not exceeding four years; and

(b) may be reappointed at the expiry of his or her term of office, but may not serve for more than two consecutive terms of office.

5. Nominations should be accompanied by a *curriculum vitae* of the nominee, and a letter/s of consent to serve as a member of the Council.

6. Nominations marked "filling of vacancies in the General and Further Education and Training Quality Assurance Council", should be received at the address given in paragraph 7 below by 25 February 2005.
