**NOTICE 1573 OF 2005**

**DEPARTMENT OF LABOUR**

**LABOUR RELATIONS ACT, 1995**

### **ESTABLISHMENT OF STATUTORY COUNCIL**

I, Johannes Theodorus Crouse, Registrar of Labour Relations, hereby, in terms of section 40(1) of the Labour Relations Act, 1995, establish the Statutory Council for the Squid and Related Fisheries of South Africa.

Character of sector:

The sector is defined as follows:

Squid fishing by means of handline jigging method from fishing vessels at sea

Which include –

- The maintenance personnel who are responsible for keeping the vessels and ancillary equipment in a sea going and serviceable condition
- The administrative (office) personnel who are responsible for the administrative function (the paper work) that inevitably goes with the employment of personnel; and

The factory based personnel who are responsible for the handling of the Squid on land in the land.

Area:

Eastern Cape and Western Cape Province

All registered trade unions and registered employers' organisations engaged in the sector are invited to attend a meeting on **22 September 2005 at 13:00**

All interested parties in the above-mentioned sector and area are invited to nominate representatives for the statutory council meeting and to inform, by latest 15 September 2005, the Commissioner who will chair the meeting.

The Commission for Conciliation, Mediation and Arbitration has appointed Mr. Luvuyo Bono to chair the meeting and to facilitate the conclusion of an agreement on –

- (i) the registered trade unions and registered employers' organisations to be parties to the Council; and
- (ii) (ii) a constitution that meets the requirements of section 30 of the Act, read with the changes required by the context.
