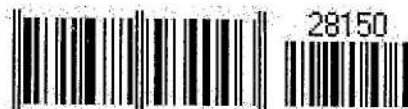

The use of live viral or bacterial agents (and possibly also plasmid DNA constructs) in immunocompromised individuals (infants) is of concern. In RSA, this issue is of more concern as a significant proportion of the population is reported to be HIV positive and may be in the process of developing AIDS. Most vaccines are used in infants, who are particularly vulnerable, with HIV testing of questionable value due to possible maternal antibodies and may progress to AIDS more quickly.

Registered vaccines of concern are oral polio, measles, mumps, rubella, varicella, yellow fever and BCG vaccines.

2. Information and documents required.

1. Applicants should provide information on:
 - 1.1. The potential of live viral or bacterial vaccines to give rise to adverse reactions or other harm, in HIV positive vaccines,
 - 1.2. The dangers of transmission of the vaccines agent to immunodeficient vaccinee contacts;
2. The interactions with other vaccines (live or other) or other diseases in such vaccines should also be clarified. This information should be reflected in the package insert and should be supported by pre-clinical and clinical studies.
3. All new applications for registration and applications to amend registered vaccines will be required to comply with this policy.

Each year the manufacturer changes the viral strain composition to conform to those deemed most likely to cause outbreaks during the next influenza season [May to October] in the Southern Hemisphere.

The WHO, via the International Influenza Centers assisted by National Laboratories, studies the isolates, incidence and virulence of influenza viral strain around the world and generate strain recommendations, prior to the influenza season for each hemisphere. The WHO recommendations are intended for worldwide use and therefore need to be adapted to the epidemiological situation of each country.

The influenza vaccine manufacturers obtain viral strains that conform to the characteristics of the strains recommended by the WHO and develop manufacturing processes to incorporate these into their respective products. These formulations are then submitted for approval from the regulatory authority to amend the formula, the manufacturing processes (where applicable), the package insert and the patient information leaflet.

This guideline outlines the process to be followed when submitting an annual viral strain change to ensure standardized and adequate evaluation for quality, safety and efficacy, and to expedite the approval process.

This process is solely for routine annual vaccine viral strain changes and any related safety information to be included in the package insert and the patient information leaflet. No other amendments can be included in the process.

The application must be submitted to the Medicines Control Council immediately after the WHO recommendation for the Southern Hemisphere has been released or published (usually around September).

The intention is to have routine annual vaccine strain changes approved by the end of December or early in January of the year prior to the relevant influenza season.

3. Information and documentation required.

The application to change viral strain involves changes to the Registration Certificate and therefore the relevant amendment fee should be paid and proof of such payments be included in the submission.

Unless otherwise stated, all administrative requirements should be in accordance with the Post Registration Amendment Guideline.

The following information and the relevant documents must be included:

1. Amendment schedule/Covering letter in accordance with section 6 of the Post-Registration Guideline. The code to be used for this amendment should be QSU (Q – for biological Medicines, S – strain, U – update) for administrative purposes.

Note viral strain changes are Type C amendments and therefore review of the documentation and prior approval is necessary before implementation.

2. Completed:

- 2.1. MRF1 part 1Ac): Amendment history;
- 2.2. Relevant front pages of the parts/sub-parts/MBR1 annexes in accordance with section 2.2 & 3 of the Post Registration Amendment Guideline;
- 2.3. Or declaration if information in 2.2 above is unchanged.
3. WHO recommended strain list for the relevant Hemisphere.
4. Manufacturer's choice of strains for inclusion.

 - 11.2 WHO recommended strains;
 - 11.3 A statement that the vaccine complies with WHO (Southern or Northern hemisphere) for the year/season must be included.
- 12 Copy of the approved Patient information Leaflet
- 13 Copy of the proposed Patient information leaflet indicating:
 - 13.1 The year/season for which the vaccine will be used;
 - 13.2 WHO recommended strains.
- 14 All labels, immediate and outer container, must indicate the year/season for which the vaccine will be used and a facsimile must be submitted as proof.
- 15 International core Data Sheet.

Approvals:

All amendments, including amendments to the package insert and the patient information leaflet, must be approved by the Medicines Control Council (MCC) before release of any batches of influenza vaccines.

Alternative approaches may be used but these should be scientifically and technically justified. The MCC is committed to ensure that all registered medicines will be of the required quality, safety and efficacy. It is important that applicants adhere to the administrative requirements to avoid delays in the processing and evaluation of applications. This guideline must be read in conjunction with the post registration amendment guideline, guideline on information of package inserts for human medicines (orthodox) and regulation 9 of Act 101, 1965, as amended.

Many vaccines contain endotoxins and pyrogenic materials, either as contaminants or as part of the normal constitution of the vaccine. Injected endotoxins cause fever and swelling and may, in larger doses, precipitate endotoxic shock that can be life threatening, particularly in infants. These endotoxins are probably responsible for the majority of adverse reactions seen with whole cell vaccines, such as adsorbed diphtheria, tetanus and pertusis vaccines. Endotoxins have an immunologically enhancing (adjuvant) effect and are important in the efficacy of some vaccine components. The British Pharmacopoeia (BP) and the European Pharmacopoeia (Ph Eur) have set limits for the endotoxin and or pyrogen content of certain vaccines, but not for others. The BP provides a formula for calculation of an Endotoxin Limit concentration per millilitre of any parenteral product. For a vaccine this would be about 15 IU per 0,5 ml dose. An infant may receive DTP, HiB and HepB simultaneously. Inactivated polio may also be given. Thus the cumulative dose should be less than 15 IU.

The requirements

1. All vaccines should be tested using LAL test for endotoxins or pyrogens in rabbits if LAL is inappropriate and a value in IU per dose established.
2. The endotoxin IU per dose must be included on the package insert under "Composition" for all Vaccines.
3. Infant vaccines that contain more than 5 IU per dose will be required to include a warning on the package insert that care must be exercised during simultaneous use or administration of the vaccine with other products containing endotoxins. The statement such as "the use of this vaccine at the same time as other medications that contain endotoxin may provoke a febrile reaction" should be included under the warnings section of the package insert.
4. All new applications for registration and applications to amend registered vaccines will be required to comply with this policy.

NOTICE 1913 OF 2005**INTERNATIONAL TRADE ADMINISTRATION COMMISSION****NOTICE OF INITIATION OF AN INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED DUMPING OF TYRES ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA (PRC).**

The International Trade Administration Commission (the Commission) accepted an application alleging that tyres originating in or imported from the People's Republic of China are being dumped on the Southern African Customs Union (SACU) market, causing material injury to the SACU industry concerned.

THE APPLICANT

The application was lodged by the South African Tyre Manufacturers Association, being the industrial organization representing the manufacturers of the product under investigation in the SACU. The Applicant alleges that it cannot compete with the low prices charged by the importers and that the allegedly dumped products are causing it material injury. The Applicant submitted sufficient evidence and established a *prima facie* case to enable the Commission to arrive at a reasonable conclusion that an investigation should be initiated on the basis of dumping, material injury and causality.

THE PRODUCT

The product allegedly being dumped is:

"New pneumatic tyres of rubber of a kind used on motor cars, classified under tariff subheading 4011.10.00, of a kind used on buses or lorries classified under tariff

subheading 4011.20.15, with a load index not exceeding 121 and with a load index exceeding 121, classified under tariff subheading 4011.20.25.

THE ALLEGATION OF DUMPING

The allegation of dumping is based on the comparison between the normal values and the export prices from the subject country. The normal values for the subject country was calculated using the price list obtained on a confidential basis. The export price was determined based on the official import statistics obtained from the South African Revenue Service. On this basis, the Commission found that there was *prima facie* proof of dumping.

THE ALLEGATION OF MATERIAL INJURY

The Applicant alleges and submitted sufficient evidence to show that there is price undercutting and that the imports in question are suppressing its selling prices. The Applicant's information indicated a decline in sales, profit margins, output, market share, productivity and capacity utilisation. It further indicated that there is a negative effect on cash flow, return on investment, wages, growth, the ability to raise capital and employment. It was also evident that the decrease in market share has been at the expense of a corresponding increase in the market share of the allegedly dumped goods. On this basis the Commission found that there was *prima facie* proof of material injury and causal link.

PERIOD OF INVESTIGATION

The period of investigation for purposes of determining the dumping margins in the respective exporting country or country of origin will be from 1 January 2004 to 31 March 2005. The period of investigation for purposes of determining injury will be from 1 January 2002 to 31 March 2005. If there are subsequent events that are relevant to injury the Commission may later request and consider further, more recent information.

PROCEDURAL FRAMEWORK

Having decided that there is sufficient evidence and a *prima facie* case to justify the initiation of an investigation, the Commission has begun an investigation in terms of section 16 of the International Trade Administration Act, 2002 (the ITA Act). The Commission will conduct its investigation in accordance with the relevant sections of the ITA Act, the World Trade Organisation Agreement on Implementation of Article VI of the GATT 1994 (the Anti-Dumping Agreement) and the Anti-Dumping Regulations of the International Trade Administration Commission of South Africa (ADR). Both the ITA Act and the ADR are available on the Commission's website (www.itac.org.za) or from the Trade Remedies section, on request.

In order to obtain the information it deems necessary for its investigation, the Commission will send non-confidential versions of the application and questionnaires to all known importers and exporters, and known representative associations. The trade representatives of the exporting countries have also been notified. Importers and other interested parties are invited to contact the Commission as soon as possible in order to determine whether they have been listed and were furnished with the relevant documentation. If not, they should immediately ensure that they are sent copies. The questionnaire has to be completed and any other representations must be made within the time limit set out below.

All responses, including non-confidential copies of the responses, should be received by the Director: Trade Remedies not later than 30 days from the date hereof, or from the date on which the letter accompanying the abovementioned questionnaire was received. The said letter shall be deemed to have been received seven days after the day of its dispatch.

A Guide to issues to be addressed in comments to the medicine Pricing Committee on an appropriate dispensing fee- 2005

The following highlights issues which are important to be included in the comments. Stakeholders are however allowed to add any other issues they consider relevant to the topic:

- 1) The Constitutional Court judgment of 30 September 2005 on the medicine pricing regulations suggests that the committee must consider dispensing in its broadest sense as defined in terms of the Pharmacy Act. Submissions should comment on how the dispensing fee regulations should be structured to include all dispensing activities.
- 2) Proposals on an appropriate dispensing fee must include a detailed report on the methods used in the determination of the fee. You should fully report on the underlying data, including information on the source of data and the un-analysed data. Also indicate whether any assumptions were made in your analysis, describing them explicitly and giving a detailed justification on their existence. It is important that your submission clearly explains why a particular method was chosen over the alternative methods.
- 3) The court judgment refers to due consideration being given to the viability of retail pharmacies. The profitability of the dispensary is a function of a number of variables that include the number of items dispensed; values of the items dispensed, dispensing fee, and dispensary related operating expenses and salaries for dispensary staff. Your submission should provide information on the source of data, include the underlying data, clearly indicate what assumptions have been made about these variables, and give a detailed justification of these assumptions.
- 4) The committee has to give consideration to rural and courier pharmacy. Input on what special considerations should be given to these pharmacies in coming up with an appropriate dispensing fee is requested. All factors and assumptions influencing the development of the suggested pricing model should be included.
- 5) Prior to the introduction of the pricing regulations retail pharmacists earned their income through mark-ups, discounts, rebates and other incentives. Your input should address the average and range of the rebates discounts and other incentives before the implementation of the regulations. A detailed report on such an analysis will be required.
- 6) The time required to dispense on a doctor's prescription (excluding compounding and admixing) depends upon whether the prescription is for a repeat medicine or a once-off medicine. Given these differences indicate the average time it takes to dispense an item. Also report on the average number of items dispensed per day.
- 7) Comment on a fee to be structured for over the counter medicines dispensed by a pharmacist. Clearly indicate how the price model was derived.
- 8) All relevant information relating to compounding and admixing must be furnished.
- 9) The South African Pharmacy Council published procedure codes related to the compounding and manipulation of medicines. Do these codes provide a reasonable description of the activities and time taken?

The constitutional court judgement of 30 September 2005 has set aside the 26%/R26 dispensing fee as prescribed in the medicines pricing regulations. (Regulations 10 and 11). The Pricing Committee hereby invites interested parties to provide input on an appropriate dispensing fee as envisaged in terms of section 22G of the Medicines and Related Substances Act, 101 of 1965.

Interested parties should provide input on all issues that are relevant to the determination of an appropriate dispensing fee. This includes the businesses models upon which any proposals for dispensing fees are based and also factors especially affecting rural and courier pharmacies. The issues on which the pricing committee is particularly interested in receiving comment may be found at www.doh.gov.za entitled "Issues to be addressed in submissions to the pricing committee". All interested parties are advised to read this document before making submissions to the committee.

The committee will make draft recommendations to the Minister of Health after due consideration of all submissions from interested parties.



The Financial Services Board referred to in section 2 of the Financial Services Board Act, 1990 (Act No. 97 of 1990), hereby under section 15A(1) of that Act amends Board Notice 42 of 2005 as set out in paragraph 1 of the Schedule, for the reason, and having the effect, set out in paragraphs 2 and 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

1. Amendment of Board Notice 42 of 2005

Board Notice 42 of 2005, setting out Levies on Financial Institutions, published in *Gazette* No. 27515 of 22 April 2005, is hereby amended by the repeal of item 19(3).

2. Reason for Amendment

Levies imposed in the past on financial institutions by the Financial Services Board were all inclusive of Value-added Tax (VAT), as also stated in item 19(3) of Board Notice 42 of 2005. By virtue of certain national legislative changes the Financial Services Board became no longer liable to register for VAT, reaching thereby the same legal status as other public authorities such as State Departments.

3. Effect of Amendment

As a result amounts of levies payable to the Financial Services Board need no longer include any VAT amount.

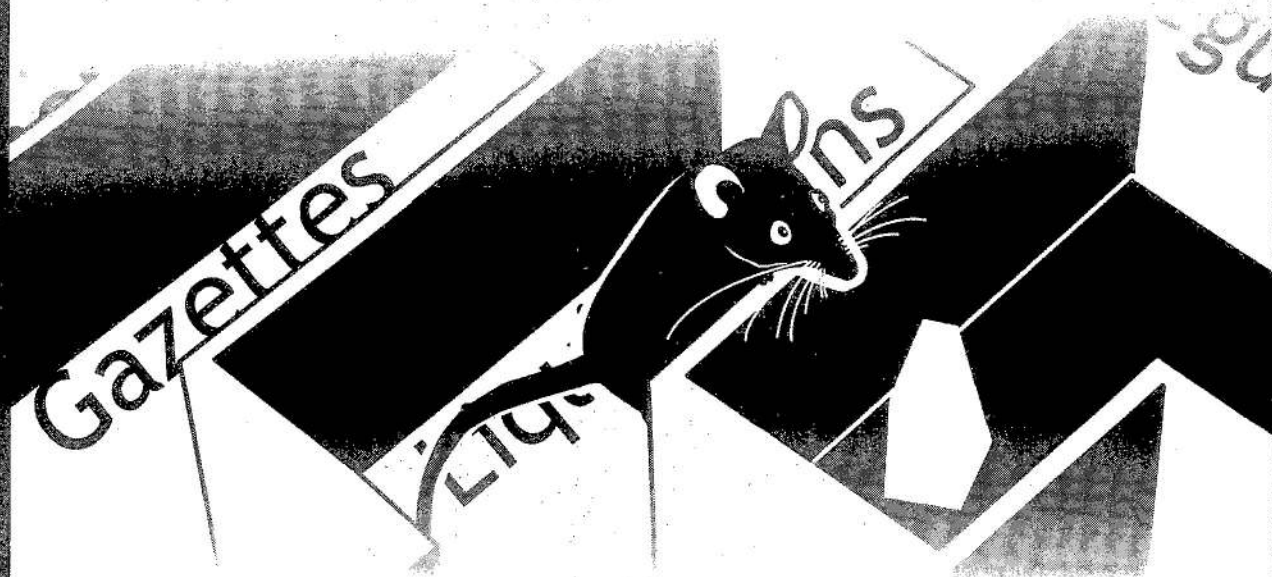
