 - Portion 1 of the farm Groote Vlei No. 5112, in extent of 239, 8088 hectares, and
 - Portion 1 of the farm Balgownie No. 2972, in extent of 162, 6242 hectares, all in extent of 1677, 1998 hectares.
2. impose the following conditions for the use of the land so designated:
 - (i) The Qiniseka Communal Property Association (hereinafter to be referred as "Qiniseka CPA") yet to be registered in terms of the provisions of the Communal Property Association Act 28 of 1996 shall hold the land for the benefit of 14 households;
 - (ii) The provisions of the Agricultural Resources Act, 1983 (Act No.43 of 1983), will apply to the utilization of the land.
 - (iii) The Qiniseka CPA will ensure that no livestock is kept permanently within the settlement. Suitable camps must be erected and maintained in the identified area where it has been agreed that livestock may be kept.
 - (iv) The conditions of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No. 38 of 1998), will apply in order to prevent the pollution of public water.
 - (v) Any densification beyond the 14 households may only take place in accordance with the relevant and necessary upgrading and extension of the essential service infrastructure.

- (vi) The level of services infrastructure to be constructed, will be determined by the Umzinyathi District Municipality (DC24), in consultation with the Qiniseka CPA, taking financial constraints into account.
- (vii) The Umzinyathi District Municipality (DC24), in consultation with the Qiniseka CPA, shall determine appropriate conditions and regulations for settlement, with special reference to the following:
 - (a) the Integrated Development Plan;
 - (b) the Natal Town Planning Ordinance, 1949 (Ordinance No. 27 of 1949); and
 - (c) relevant municipal laws.

provides in depth detail on the selection, installation, operation and control methods for traffic signals.

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
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
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


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
