Persons who lodge representations in terms hereof, shall at the time of lodgement furnish proof to the satisfaction of the Authority that a copy of the representation has been delivered by hand to Mr Lebelo Maleka, Station Manager, Soshanguve Community Radio, Shop No. 45, Nafcoc Shopping Centre, Mankutukutu Street, Soshanguve or sent by registered post to P.O Box 200, Soshanguve 0152 or faxed to (012) 799 8334.
- 6. Soshanguve Community Radio shall be entitled to respond in writing to written representations made by interested persons on the proposed renewal, and such written response must be lodged with the Authority within sixty (60) days of the date of publication of this notice in the *Government Gazette*. Soshanguve Community Radio must, at the time of lodging such written response, furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that it has delivered a
