VIOLENCE

BLASPHEMY (B), defined as offensive, insensitive or irreverent expressions on any religion (not cults or Satanism) and not amounting to the advocacy of hatred or incitement to cause harm, should not be treated as a classifiable element but as a matter for consumer advice. A classifiable element impacts directly on the determination of an appropriate age-restriction on a film. Blasphemy, per se, should not affect age-restrictions but may be given as consumer advice even where a film is rated A. However, blasphemy amounting to the advocacy of hatred and constituting incitement to cause harm would be a classifiable element in terms of Schedule 10.
