The 2nd Project – (Reitz / Petrus Steyn Road): The date of completion in Tau Pele's tender submission is indicated as 15 November 2009, which is incorrect. Reference is also made in both tables in its tender submission to a joint venture project. Tau Pele failed to disclose its portion of the JV, which is less than R130 million (30% of R188 million).  2. The 3rd Project – (Lichtenburg – Mafikeng Road): Tau Pele provided conflicting dates of completion for this project (29 October 2009 and 31 October 2010) in its tender submission. The latter date is also after the tender closing date.
			<ol> <li>The 5th Project – (t he Delmas – Ogies Road): The date of completion in both the flagship table and the completed project table in Tau Pele's tender submission is indicated as 30 September 2009. This date is incorrect, as at 29 January 2010 a completion certificate had not been issued yet.</li> </ol>
