- Licensees are requested to provide proof of such in the form of CIPRO documentation and/or a sworn affidavit.
- 4. The information is requested from the licensees to allow the Authority to update its database of existing and operational licensees, which in turn would enable the Authority to plan its monitoring activities going forward.
