## Explanatory Memorandum to the Allocations set out in the attached Schedule

This *Gazette* is published in terms Section 25(3)(c) of the Division of Revenue Act, 2013 (Act No. 2 of 2013), therefore schedule 7B makes special provisions for the immediate release of funds to provinces and municipalities following declared disasters.

A portion of an unallocated amount of Municipal Disaster Grant was transferred to municipalities in Kwa-Zulu Natal and Limpopo province during the month of May 2013 following the damage caused by heavy rains.
