ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS ACT, 2005 (ACT NO. 36 OF 2005)

APPLICATION FOR THE AMENDMENT OF A CLASS COMMUNITY SOUND BROADCASTING SERVICE LICENCE: RADIO PULPIT

- 1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice in terms of Regulation 14 of the Processes and Procedures Regulations for Class Licences of 2010, that it has received an application from Radio Pulpit, for an amendment of its Class Community Sound Broadcasting Service Licence ("Service Licence") lodged in terms of regulation 8 of the Processes and Procedures Regulations for Class Licences of 2010.
- 2. Radio Pulpit seeks the approval from the Authority to amend clause 4.1.4 of its service licence which provides that "the languages of broadcast are (a) 20% Sesotho, Sepedi and Setswana; (b) 22% English; (c) 30% isiZulu, isiXhosa, isiNdebele and siSwati; (d) 5% Xitsonga; (e) 3% Tshivenda; and (f) 20% Afrikaans." The Licensee seeks the Authority's approval to amend clause 4.1.4 of its Service Licence to exclude Xitsonga and Tshivenda from its languages of broadcast. The Licensee further seeks the approval of the Authority to reduce and increase the percentages of the remaining languages as follows: (a) English 35%; (b) Afrikaans 35%; (c) isiZulu, isiXhosa, isiNdebele, siSwati 20%; and Sesotho, Setswana, Sepedi 10%.
- 3. The applications, relevant schedules and any representations received pursuant thereto would be made available and open for inspection by interested parties at the Authority's library during the Authority's normal office hours.

4. Interested parties are invited to lodge written representations in relation to the application within twenty (20) days of the date of publication of this notice. Persons who lodge representations must also indicate whether they wish to make oral submissions should the

Authority decide to hold a public hearing in respect of the application.

7. Radio Pulpit shall be entitled to respond in writing to written representations made by

interested persons on the proposed amendment, and such written response must be

lodged with the Authority within forty (40) days of the date of publication of this notice in the

Government Gazette. Radio Pulpit must, at the time of lodging such written response,

furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that it has delivered a copy of such response by

hand, or has sent a copy of such response by registered mail or by facsimile or by email to

the relevant person having made such written representations.
